RULES AND REGULATIONS

Deposit for All Larger Meters: A 1 inch, 1 1/2 inch or 2 inch meter tap will require a deposit of \$1,000.00, a 4 inch meter tap will require a deposit of \$5,000.00 from the customer at the time a request is made for service. The amount charged for the meter tap will be the actual cost incurred by the district. If the costs incurred by the district are less than the deposit, the customer will have the difference refunded. If the costs incurred by the district exceed the deposit, the customer will owe the difference to the utility. The deposit is for installation of service and will be in addition to the customer deposit that is collected that insures payment for water usage.

Field Collection Charge: A Field Collection Charge be assessed when a utility representative visits the premises of the service connection to terminate service, and the customer is on-site and pays the bill to avoid termination of service. This fee may only be charged once per billing period.

Meter Lock Damage: A Meter Lock Damage Fee will be assessed against any account for damaged, cut, missing or exchanged lock on water district meters. Authorities will be notified.

Moving a Meter: When a customer requests his meter be relocated on the same property, they must reimburse the utility for the actual costs incurred, including but not limited to appropriate legal, administrative, engineering, overhead, or other related costs.

Reconnection of Service Fee: A Reconnection Charge will be charged to existing customers whose service has been voluntarily turned off or service terminated for non-payment. The district will restore service as soon as possible, within 24 hours of payment. Customers requesting service be restored other than during normal working will be charged an additional fee.

Service Call/Investigation Charge: a Service Call/Investigation Charge will be assessed when a customer requests the onsite presence of utility personnel to investigate a service problem and the problem is a result of the customer's own plumbing facilities, beyond the utility's delivery point, or not caused by failure of utility facilities. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond the utility's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.

Landlord Agreement Policy

(T)

1. Landlord will have on account with the water office a meter deposit. This deposit will be held until the landlord requests the deposit to be refunded. In such case, the deposit will have to be paid again to restart the landlord agreement.
2. Landlord will inform the water office of approval for renter to put service in their name.
3. Renter will pay a meter deposit and a connection/turn-on charge (if service is locked up). Renter will fill out contract and will be responsible for the bill.
4. When renter leaves, landlord will be called to determine if service will be put back into their name.
 - a. If Landlord DOES want service back in their name, a bill will be created from that point. Even a minimum bill will be generated if no water goes through meter.
 - b. If Landlord DOES NOT want service back in their name, a lock will be placed on the meter. The next person who puts that service in their name will pay a connection/turn-on charge (even if landlord) and a meter deposit (unless deposit held on account).

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS – These Rules and Regulations are in addition to the state statutes and administrative regulations applicable to water districts operating in Kentucky.
2. PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS – The principal place of business of the District will be at 4789 Main Street in Bremen, Muhlenberg County, Kentucky.
3. BUSINESS HOURS – The office hours of the District are 7:30am to 4:00pm Monday through Friday. The office will be closed on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.
4. BILLING – Meters will be read monthly between the 10th and 25th of each month. Bills will be mailed on the last working day of each month and shall be due and payable when rendered. If not paid by the 10th of the month following the date rendered, the bill shall be delinquent, and a penalty as set out in the schedule of Special Non-Recurring Charges shall be due and payable; provided, however, that if the 10th day shall fall upon a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, then the face amount of the bill may be paid on the next working day of the District. If the entire bill for water service, together with said penalty is not paid by the 20th of the month after the original bill is mailed, and upon at least five (5) days written notice, then the water service connection shall be disconnected. All disconnections for non-payment shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006. A copy of the billing form to be used is attached. The District will bill the customer for one full month of minimum service if the customer has had water service for 16 days or more with a zero to 2,000 usage.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

5. GENERAL – No free use of services and facilities of the District shall be granted or permitted to any user, except fire departments for fire protection and periodic drill purposes only.
6. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE – Each prospective customer desiring water service is required to sign the District's Standard Contract for water service before service is supplied by the District. The form of this contract is filed with and made a part of these Rules and Regulations. Meters may be installed without special permission on the property to be served. A meter connection charge as provided for in the schedule for Special Non-Recurring Charges must be paid on all new connections. Applications for service connection installation will not be processed if the applicant is indebted to the District on a past due account, bad debt, or in any other fashion whatsoever. Extensions to the utility's main shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066 Section 12.
7. POINT OF DELIVERY – The point of delivery is the point where the meter is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer.

8. DELINQUENT HOUSEHOLD – The District may deny service to an applicant who is a member of a delinquent household where the prior customer continues to reside in the household and uses the service.
9. RELOCATION OF WATER FACILITIES – District may, at the request of the customer, relocate or change existing District-owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse the District for such changes at rates provided for in the utility's schedule for Special Non-Recurring Charges.
10. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY DISTRICT – District may refuse to connect or may discontinue service for the violation of any of its Rules and Regulations, or for violation of any of the provisions of the Schedules or Rates and Charges, or of the customer service contract. District may discontinue service to customer for theft of water or the appearance of water theft devices on premises of the customer. The District shall not be required to restore service until the customer has complied with all Rules and Regulations of the Commission and the District has been reimbursed for the estimated amount of the service rendered and for any cost incurred by reason of the fraudulent use. All discontinuance of services is subject to the Notice Requirements of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.

11. DEPOSIT – All customers will pay equal deposits in the amount listed in the rates and charges section of this tariff. The amount does not exceed 2/12ths of the average annual bill of residential customers served by the District.

12. INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE – The District will use reasonable diligence in supplying water service and shall make effort to notify affected customers in the event of a service interruption and approximate time of service restoration. The District shall not be liable for breach of contract in the event of, or for loss, injury, or damage to persons or property resulting from interruptions in service, excessive or inadequate water pressure, or otherwise unsatisfactory service, whether or not caused by negligence.

13. NOTICE OF TROUBLE – Customer shall notify the District immediately should the service be unsatisfactory for any reason, or should there be any defects, trouble or accidents affecting the supply of water. Such notices, if verbal, should be confirmed in writing. Complaints may be made to the operator of the System and may be appealed to the District's Commission within 10 days.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

15. WATER FAILURE – The District is responsible for water failure only when in control of the District's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the District or its employees.
16. PROTECTION BY CONSUMER – Consumer shall protect the equipment of the District on his premises and shall not interfere with District's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the District.
17. AVAILABILITY – Water service is available to any domestic, commercial, or industrial consumer within the District's area.
18. REVISIONS – These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Kentucky Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.
19. DISTRICT'S LIABILITY – The District shall not be liable for damage of any kind whatsoever resulting from water or the use of water on the customer's premises, unless such damage results directly from negligence on the part of the District. The District shall not be responsible for any damage done by or resulting from any defects in piping, fixtures, or appliances on the Customer's premises. The District shall not be responsible for negligence of third persons, or forces beyond the control of the District resulting in any interruption of service.

20. FIRE HYDRANT AREAS – The District's water system is primarily designed and constructed to provide only domestic water service to rural residences and businesses. The District does not generally provide fire protection to its customer or to others. Fire hydrants may, however, be installed in areas of the system which can provide adequate pressure, flow rate, and duration of flow as determined by the District.

21. FIRE HYDRANTS OUTSIDE FIRE HYDRANT AREAS – The fire hydrants installed on the distribution lines of this District outside of the fire hydrant areas referred to herein are for the sole purpose of flushing the lines, or other uses by the District necessary for proper maintenance of the lines. The District is not responsible for, nor does it guarantee, any minimum pressure or flow at these hydrants, other than the minimum required by the Public Service Commission for distribution lines. If these fire hydrants are used by fire protection units in the performance of their duty, any damage to the distribution lines resulting from excessive pumping pressure will be the liability of that unit. New hydrants will not be installed in areas which are not capable of providing fire flows.

FIRE DEPARTMENTS – Any fire department which does not receive public funds from the Commonwealth of Kentucky, or any political subdivision thereof, for the purpose of offsetting fifty percent (50%) or more of its operational expenses may withdraw water from Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 facilities at no charge to extinguish fires or for firefighting training. A fire department making such withdrawals from Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 facilities shall provide an estimate of its withdrawals to Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 at the end of each month.~~

23. MULTIPLE USERS ON ONE METER – With the exception of connections that existed before March 1, 2001, each district meter shall serve only one residence or mobile home. Multiple user meter connections that existed before March 1, 2001, where two or more residences, apartment units, mobile homes, businesses, or family units residing in a duplex or other multi-unit premise being served by a single meter will be allowed to continue until such time as the District directs otherwise. Customers will be required to purchase their own individual meter when property covered by this exemption changes ownership.

CREDIT /DEBIT CARDS:

All customers may pay their bill by credit or debit card. This method of payment may be made in person at the utility office or by telephone.

If on the bill due date an attempt to pay the credit card or debit card is made and the card is declined for any reason, payment is still due in full on that date and will be considered late after that date. All late charges and penalties will be applied. If a customer is paying on our disconnect day and the card is denied, the same rules as above apply, in addition to service being disconnected.

When a customer makes a payment by credit card, the utility will assess a fee equal to that charged to the utility by the credit or debit card processing company to process the transaction. This fee is generally calculated using a formula applied to the balance of the amount charged to the credit or debit account but may be a flat fee per transaction. RULES & REGULATIONS

DENIAL OF ACCESS CHARGE:

A customer must provide meter access to district employees for meter reading purposes.

If the district cannot read a customer's meter due to a lack of reasonable or unobstructed access, the district will contact the customer and negotiate corrective action and an agreed date and time for the meter to be read by the district.

At the agreed upon date and time, the customer shall provide access to the meter by moving any obstruction, restraining any animal, or removing anything that prevents access to the meter.

If the customer fails to provide meter access at the agreed upon date and time, the district shall assess the customer a denial of access charge of \$25.00 to recover the cost of providing the special service.

The customer bill will be estimated and the \$25.00 denial of access charge will be placed on the next bill as a separate line item.

The utility shall negotiate and accept reasonable partial payment plans at the request of residential customers who have received a termination notice for failure to pay, except that a utility is not required to negotiate a partial payment plan with a customer who is delinquent under a previous partial payment plan. Partial payment plans must be mutually agreed upon. Plans which extend for a period longer than thirty (30) days will be in writing and will advise customers that service may be terminated without additional notice if the customer fails to meet the obligations of the plan.

The customer is required to pay a minimum of \$15 towards the delinquent bill and must sign a form stating when the remainder will be paid. The customer will receive a copy of this agreement to keep for their records. If remainder payment has not been met by date indicated on agreement, then service will be terminated and a reconnect fee will be charged along with remainder to restore service. Once service has been turned off, no partial payment plan will be considered. The whole delinquent amount and reconnect fee will be due for restoration of service. Once the field operators have left the office to start cutoffs, no payment plans will be accepted.

This installment amount will be in addition to the customer's regular monthly water bill. If payment is not received by cutoff and no arrangements have been made, service will be disconnected. The reconnect fee will be charged to restore service. No more than two installment payment plans will be accepted at the same time.

In light of Ordinance Number 08132020-01 found in the Office of the Muhlenberg County Clerk, pertaining to fees collected by Water Utilities in order to fund County E-911, passed by the Muhlenberg Fiscal Court on September 10, 2020, MWCD#3 adopts the following:

There shall be added to the customer's bill, listed as a separate line item, an amount equal to any fee, tax, assessment, etc., now or hereafter imposed by local legislative authorities, whether by ordinance, franchise or other means. Such amount shall be added exclusively to bills of customers receiving service within the territorial limits of the authority imposing the fee.

Where more than one such fee is imposed, each of the charges applicable to each customer shall be added to the customer's bill and listed as separate line items.

Where the local legislative authority imposes a flat, fixed amount on the active customers of the Muhlenberg County Water Dist. #3; the fee applied to the bills of active customers receiving service within the territorial boundaries of that authority, shall be in the form of a flat dollar amount. Muhlenberg County Water District #3 is just to act as a collection agent between the Muhlenberg County Fiscal Court and the active water customers.

The amount of such fee added to the customer's bill shall be determined in accordance with the terms of the ordinance, franchise or other directive agreed to by Muhlenberg County Water District #3.

A customer's payment will be applied in the following order of priority: amounts owed for current billing period; unpaid balance for water service provided in prior billing periods; and fees or taxes collected for other entities.



Fire Departments: Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.

Any User that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water. A User shall submit a monthly report even if it withdraws no water for fire protection or training purposes.

A Non-reporting User's usage shall be presumed to be 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting User may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and shall adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting User shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting User shall also be assessed a penalty of \$10.00 for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.

party of the SECOND PART.

WITNESSETH THAT for and in consideration of the efforts of the party of the SECOND PART, acting through Water District Commissioners, Robert Woodburn, Raymond Ellison and J. E. Rhoades, the party of the FIRST PART agrees to pay the following: Service Charge-\$ _____, Meter Deposit-\$ _____, Tap-in fee-\$ _____, at the time of signing this contract to connect to the water system and to pay at least a minimum bill monthly thereafter as soon as the meter is installed by the District and water is made available to the meter, regardless of whether the party of the FIRST PART connects to the system.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the SECOND PART reserves the right to determine the size of service connection to be used to supply water to the party of the FIRST PART. A 3/4" x 5/8" meter will be used unless the party of the FIRST PART contracts for a larger meter. All other meters will be actual cost.

A separate meter must be installed for each residence. The party of the FIRST PART agrees not to resell water purchased hereunder.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on customer's property to be designated by the District for each signed connection with the right of ingress and egress on property, and to grant an easement for installation of water lines where required.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees that no other present or future source of water will be connected to any waterlines served by the District's waterlines and will disconnect from his present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the District's system and shall eliminate their present or future cross-connections in his system.

The party of the FIRST PART shall install and maintain at his own expense a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the District now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended or changed. The District may terminate service to any customer for violating a District Regulation.

Deposits to insure payment of monthly water bills and penalties on delinquent water accounts shall be as the party of the SECOND PART may hereafter prescribe.

The failure of the party of the FIRST PART to pay water charges duly imposed, shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

- A. Non-payment by the 10th of the month will be subject to a penalty of ten percent of the delinquent account.
- B. Non-payment by the 20th of the month will result in the water being shut off from the party of the FIRST PART'S property.
- C. In the event it becomes necessary for the party of the SECOND PART to shut off the water, a fee of \$25.00 will be charged for reconnection of the service. The party of the FIRST PART will also be required to pay all delinquent accounts and pay the minimum water bill for the time the meter was disconnected, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.
