days from the past due date), the water supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice; provided, however, if prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to the District, or to its employee empowered to discontinue service, a written certificate signed by a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer that, in the opinion of the certifier, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until ten (10) days elapse from the time of the District's receipt of said certification, whichever occurs first.

Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$25.00 will be made for reconnection of water service, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the District have been paid. Water service larger than 5/8" x 3/4" will require \$25 reconnection charge.

The District reserves the right to require that a nominal amount be placed on deposit with the District for the purpose of establishing or maintaining any customer's credit. Such amount not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION annual bill of such customer. Upon payment of deposit, the District shall issue a certificate of deposit showing the name of customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, the date and amount of the deposit. JAN 01 1987 The District will hold each deposit for 18 months or until such customer moves outside the District. At that time, the URSUANT TO 807 KAR5:011, deposit plus 6 percent annual interest will be credited to customer's account or reimbursed. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District, and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used. The District requires a \$15.00 non-refundable connection fee to customers where water taps already exist, but service has been disconnected at the previous customer's request.
