RULES & REGULATIONS

SECTION I

BY COMMISSION

These rules and regulations are made by the Boone County Water District and approved by the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and no official or employee of the Boone County Water District has any power or authority to alter or change the same. No agent or employee of the district shall have authority to bind it by any promise, agreement, or representation in violation of these rules and regulations.

SECTION II

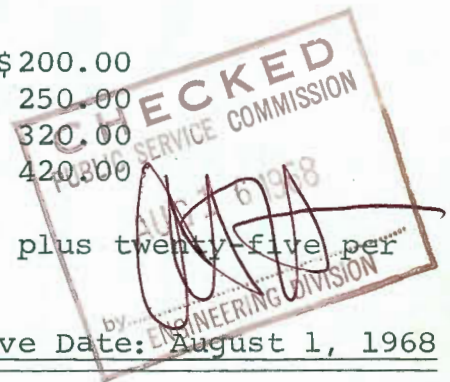
SERVICE INSTALLATIONS

(a) Any property owner, or his duly authorized agent, desiring water service shall apply at the district office. The owner shall, in signing the application agree to be bound by all of the provisions of these rules and regulations, including any amendment thereto. No service branch shall be installed to serve property which does not abut the street or road along which the service main is located without specific approval of the district. Every building wherein water is used shall have a separate service branch and meter provided, however, that the district may waive this requirement for good cause shown. The district reserves the right to specify the size service branch for each installation. When application for a service branch installation is made a tapping fee shall be paid according to the following schedule:

3/4"	\$ 200.00
1"	250.00
1 1/2"	320.00
2"	420.00

All services over 2" at actual cost plus twenty-five per cent.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

APPLICABLE: Entire service area of Boone County.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE: All Customers.

RATES: Schedule "A" applies to all customers except multiple occupancy buildings and mobile home parks and water used for irrigation. Schedule "B" applies only to multiple occupancy buildings and mobile home parks. Schedule "C" applies only when the water purchased is used exclusively for irrigation.

TANK WAGON SALES:

Tank wagon sales are made only to approved water haulers who have executed separate agreements with the district. The rate under these agreements is \$1.50 per 1000 gallons hauled from any of the districts loading stations.

SURCHARGE:

By order of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky dated December 17, 1970, there is to be added to each monthly bill a surcharge of \$1.50 which shall be collected by the district for three and one-half years or until the sum of \$106,884 has been collected. These funds are held in escrow and may be disbursed only on order of the Public Service Commission.
