

WITNESSETH THAT for and in consideration of the provision of water service by the District,
the customer hereby agrees to contract with the District as follows:

The customer hereby agrees to pay the District a tap fee connecting to the District Water System,
the sum of money checked in the following schedule for each tap requested, simultaneously with signing:

of \$ _____, subject to review as approved by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

It is understood and agreed that the District reserves the right to determine the size of service
connection to be used to supply water to customer. A 5/8" meter will be used unless the customer
contracts for a larger meter. A separate meter shall be installed for each residence, mobile home,

apartment units, businesses, or family unit residing in a duplex or family unit residing in other multiple units. The District reserves the right to disconnect the water service in accordance with the regulations of the Public Service Commission for noncompliance with the District's rule and regulations for non-payment of bills or for fraudulent or illegal use of service and shall not reconnect the service until the cause for disconnection has been corrected and the reconnection fee paid. (A copy of the District's Rules and Regulations and the Public Service Commission's regulations are available at the District's office upon request.)

The customer agrees not to resell or give away water purchased hereunder.

The signing to this Contract by a Commissioner of the District is by authority of the Board of Commissioners and the signing hereof is in his official capacity only, and said commissioner(s) shall not be personally liable on this contract.

This contract may be assigned to the successors and assigns of the District.

NOTICE TO NEW CUSTOMERS OF THE BRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

Bracken County Water District has been subject to a tap-on ban since April 25, 1991. The ban prevented any new customers from being added to the system. Bracken County Water District recently entered into an agreed order to correct the iron and manganese problem, the basis for the tap-on ban. The agreed order sets forth an enforceable schedule for correction of the iron and manganese problem. Thus, the tap-on ban was lifted as of June 5, 1992. This will allow new customers to be added to existing water lines.

The purpose of this notice is to advise future customers that during the interim period, while the corrective action is being taken, that they will continue to experience problems relative to iron and manganese. While iron and manganese does not pose a threat to the health of humans or animals, it can cause taste and odor problems, staining of porcelain fixtures and discoloration of laundry.
