CONNECTION FEES:

Applicants for permission to connect to the facilities of the district shall tender in cash to the Treasurer of the district along with the application, connection charges, as follows:

Service connections greater than 2 inches when permitted shall be provided at actual cost plus twenty-five per cent.

SPECIAL CONTRACTS:

The district has a contract with the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, under the terms of which said city agrees to purchase a minimum of 750,000 gallons of water each month. The rate agreed upon is 45 cents per 1,000 gallons for the first 500,000 gallons and 40 cents per 1,000 gallons for the water purchased in excess of 500,000 gallons.

TANK WAGON SALES:

Tank wagon sales are made to the general public by means of coin operated devices at several loading stations maintained by the district. These devices are activated by depositing a 25 cent coin and discharges approximately 125 gallons of water for each coin deposited.

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
