#### RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. No free use of the services and facilities of the System shall be granted or permitted to any user thereof, including the District itself. All service shall be furnished through individual meters provided and installed by the District; and each dwelling unit in a duplex, apartment house, or other multi-unit establishment shall be deemed to be a separate unit and shall have a separate meter.
- 2. Bills will be sent monthly to customers and shall be payable within fifteen (15) days after rendition. If not paid as aforesaid within such fifteen day period, a penalty equal to ten (10) percent of the face amount of the bill shall become due and payable; provided, however, that if the fifteenth day should fall on a Sunday or a legal holiday, then the face amount of the bill may be paid on the next secular day which is not a holiday. If any such bill, together with said penalty of ten percent thereof, shall remain unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days after rendition, the water service connection to the premises shall be disconnected. If any such delinquent customer shall, thereafter, desire re-connection, a charge in the sum of \$1.50 is hereby fixed to cover the expense thereof; and prior to such re-connection, the customer shall be required to pay the delinquent bill, the

ten percent penalty, interest on both bill and penalty, and the charge for re-connection. Interest on delinquent bills (and on penalties) shall accrue at the rate of six (6) percent per annum from the thirtieth day after rendition, and such interest, if any, shall be collected when the bill is paid. Whether or not any premises are disconnected because of such delinquency, the Attorney for the District is authorized to enforce and collect the amount of any bills remaining delinquent for thirty (30) days (including penalty, interest and court costs) by suit in any court of competent jurisdiction.

3. The water service of the System shall be provided to any prospective user only upon submission to the District, and approval by such officer or agent as the District may from time to time designate, of a signed, written application therefor in such form as the District may from time to time prescribe, accompanied (when applicable) by tender of a Security Deposit, and, in the case of a new connection installation, accompanied by a tender of the connection or "tap-in" charge. Bills shall be rendered to the person whose signature appears upon the application, at the address designated in the application; unless the application shall contain the name and address of an agent designated by the applicant for that purpose, in which event bills shall be rendered to such designated agent.

Except in the case of those original customers of the District who signed applications or agreements with the District and deposited the prescribed original connection charge prior to December 31, 1959, each customer shall deposit with the District Treasurer the sum of \$10.00 at the time of application for service, such deposits to be held for assurance of the payment of the bills for service supplied by said System, and to be subject to application upon such bills in the event of delinquency, any amount so applied to delinquent bills to be restored by the depositor within ten (10) days after notice by the District Treasurer to do so, upon penalty of disconnection of service to the premises. The District Treasurer shall keep a true accounting of all sums so deposited, and interest shall accrue thereon at the rate of six (6) percent per annum to be credited to the depositor on the books of the District by the Treasurer annually. Any customer of said System, who shall have made such deposit with the District Treasurer, may obtain a refund thereof, including interest accrued to the date of such refund, by furnishing to the District Treasurer satisfactory evidence that all charges for water service, including any tap-in charges, connection charges, penalties, interest etc have been paid in full, and that the customer will no longer avail himself of water service.

- 5. Exempted from the requirement that all applicants who sign written applications or agreements with the District after December 31, 1959, shall pay the increased connection charges (see Rates, this Tariff) are those applicants who apply to connect with facilities of the District's System that were or are constructed by developers under Resolution #24 of this District, which facilities have been or shall be transferred to the District in accordance with said Resolution. These exempted applicants shall pay to the District the actual cost (material plus labor) incurred by the District in making said applicant's connection to said facilities, unless otherwise directed by the Board of Commissioners of this District.
- 6. Nothing set forth in these Rules and Regulations shall be construed in such manner as to conflict with the requirements set forth in Sections 96.360 to 96.510, inclusive, of the Kentucky Revised Statutes (as made applicable to Water Districts by Section 74.370 thereof).
- 7. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

# CONTRACT

This contract made and entered into this the 31 day of December, 1958 by and between the Bullock Pen Water District of Grant County, Kentucky, hereinafter for convenience called "THE DISTRICT" and the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, a municipal corporation of the 5th class, acting by and through its city council hereinafter for convenience called "THE CITY".

# WITNESSTH

WHEREAS the District is proposing to build, own and operate a water distribution system and contemplates having surplus water for sale and

WHEREAS the City is desirous of purchasing water from said District. NOW THEREFORE the said District for and in consideration of the promises and agreements of the City hereinafter set forth does by these presents bind itself, its successors, and assigns to furnish water to the City and its successors or assigns for a period beginning on the date that said District has its water distribution system in operation and continuing from a period of 30 years from said date.

In consideration whereof the City hereby agrees and binds itself to purchase from said District at least 500,000 gallons of water each month for the sum of 45¢ per 1,000 gallons and to purchase such additional water from said District as it may, in the discretion of its waterworks commission and city council, require and said District hereby binds itself to sell to said City such additional water at the rate of 40¢ per 1,000 gallons actually delivered to said City under the terms of this contract. It being expressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto that the said City is to buy and pay for a minimum of 500,000 gallons per month.

It is further hereby expressly understood and agreed by and between the public service community parties hereto that the said District is to install at its expense a meter at the present north limits of the said City and is to deliver said water to said

meter in such quantity and of such quality as the said City may, in the discretion of its waterworks commission and city council, require.

It is further hereby expressly understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the City will have the duty of constructing and maintaining a line from the aforesaid meter to its present distribution system and the District has the responsibility and duty of constructing a line to said meter and maintaining same.

It is further hereby expressly understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that in the event the City should legally extend its corporate limits so that any part of the District water line and/or customers would thereafter be included within the corporate limits of said City then the District agrees to sell and the City agrees to buy said portion of the line at a price to be fixed by three competent appraisers: One to be selected by the District; one to selected by the City; and the remaining one to be selected by these two, it being understood and agreed however, that the watertower or standpipe of the District will in no event be included in any such sale.

It is further hereby understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that this contract shall be null and void and not binding on either party if the said District fails to get its distribution system in effective operation within a period of 2 years from the date hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the City hereby affixes its signature, by and through its mayor and city council and the District affixes its signature by and through its chairman and members this the 31 day of December, 1958.
