The following rules and regulations are hereby adopted, subject to change by the Water District Commission at any time, subject to approval of the Public Service Commission through the filing of revised tariff sheets with the PSC. These rules and regulations are intended to supplement the Rate Resolution and the By-Laws.

A. All taps and connections to the mains of the District shall be made by and/or under the direction and supervision of District personnel.

B. Water service may be discontinued by the District for, upon 10 days' written notice (except that in the event of a violation under Item 7 below, water service may be terminated immediately), for any viola GANCELLED of any rule, regulation, or condition, and especially for any of the JAN 0 1 2010 following reasons:

- 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the properties COMMISSION or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
- 2. Failure to report to the District additions to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
- 3. Resale of water.

Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$35.00 will be made for reconnection of water service, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the District have been paid.

Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within 12 months preceding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$15.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy with the test of 2%. 12 months; provided, however, that if time for the periodic test has overrun to the extent that  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the time elapsed since the last previous test exceeds 12 months, the refund shall be for the 12 months specified above, plus those months exceeding the periodic test period; provided, further, that such refund may be limited to the 12 month period if failure to make the periodic test was due to causes beyond the control of the District.

2. Customers having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the stream line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.
- N. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.
- 0. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.
- P. 1. An extension of fifty (50) feet or less to the District's distribution main shall be made without charge (other than the prescribed standard Annaection charge) for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contractor district service for one (1) year or more and who provides a guaranteestor distribution service.
  - 2. For each extension to the District's distribution main in excess of fifty (50) feet, the District shall require the customer to whose premises such extension is made to deposit with the District the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty (50) feet, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. Such deposit may be refundable to the customer in certain instances, in accordance with Title 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12 (2) (b).
- Q. If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent, or employee, as determined by a court of law having jurisdiction over the parties, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District, and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.
- R. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell the water to any other person.

All customers shall grant or convey, or shall cause to be granted or conveyed, to the District a perpetual easement and right of way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easment or right of way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish service to the customer. T. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system whose decision may be appealed to the Commission of the District within ten days; otherwise, the operator's decision will be final. The District shall not participate in any kind of fire protection. The District U. does not guarantee pressure for fire hydrants. #### 1. INSTALLATION OF METERS AND WATERLINES WITHIN MOBILE HOME PARKS

(a) All Mobile Home Parks ("MOBILE HOME PARKS") located within the Bullock Pen Water District ("DISTRICT") shall install an individual residential water meter for each mobile home unit located within the MOBILE HOME PARK. The MOBILE HOME PARK owners shall install up to the mobile home living unit waterlines for the purpose of making a water meter connection. All such installation of waterlines within the MOBILE HOME PARK shall be done at the owner's expense. Testing shall be effected within ten (10) days after the completion of all waterline installation or at the earliest possible date, weather conditions and other appropriate circumstances permitting. The DISTRICT shall supervise and/or apply any and all tests to the lines installed in any MOBILE HOME PARK as the DISTRICT may deem appropriate. All waterline installation shall be in compliance with the rules, regulations and specifications of the DISTRICT prior to acceptance thereof by the DISTRICT.

(e) The MOBILE HOME PARK developer/owner shall install a meter frequency meter crock and meter lid suitable for meter installation for each mobile

home lot/pad at the developer's/owner's cost and expense. The DISTRICT shall be responsible for the installation of a meter at each mobile home lot/pad when requested by the developer/owner or the mobile home owner/occupant. For each initial water meter installation at each mobile home lot/pad, the DISTRICT shall, upon receipt of the \$475.00 connection fee as provided for in this Tariff, pay to the MOBILE HOME PARK developer/owner the sum of \$275.00.

#### 2. REIMBURSEMENT FOR MASTER METERS NOW SERVING MOBILE HOME PARKS

MOBILE HOME PARKS served by master meters (as of the date this Ammended Tariff is approved) which were installed and paid for by the owner thereof, shall receive reimbursement for the cost of such installation from the DISTRICT in the event that the MOBILE HOME PARK owner should decide and elect to install individual water meters for each mobile home unit within that given MOBILE HOME PARK. Any MOBILE HOME PARK owner who elects to convert from a master meter to individual water meters for each mobile home unit thall be responsible for the installation of all waterlines throughout the MOBILE HOME PARK subject to the terms and conditions of paragraph 1 above.

#### 3. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF METERS AND WATERLINES

Following approval by the DISTRICT of waterlines installed in a MOBILE HOME PARK, and for a period of not less than one year thereafter, the owner shall bear the responsibility for all maintenance and repair to all lines and water meters installed within a MOBILE HOME PARK until the date of written acceptance of said lines and meters by the DISTRICT. Upon the expiration of said one year period and upon acceptance by the DISTRICT, all responsibility for all such waterlines and meters shall be assumed and discharged by the DISTRICT and the owner shall no longer have any responsibility maintenance and repair.

### 4. METER READING AND BILLING

In the event that the total number of gallons consumed exceeds the product of the number of mobile home living units serviced by such meter times the minimum gallon usage set by the Rate Schedule of the DISTRICT, all water used in excess of the minimum gallon usage shall be billed per the Rate Schedule of the DISTRICT then in effect.

(c) Responsibility for payment of water bills from any respective mobile home living unit shall be the responsibility of that individual in whose name the water meter is installed or the individuals name in which that particular account is registered with the DISTRICT.

#### DISCONNECTIONS AND RECONNECTIONS

Charges for disconnection and/or reconnection fees shall be the same for MOBILE HOME PARKS as are set forth in this Tariff for other Customers.

Deposits for Customers within MOBILE HOME PARKS shall be the same as those currently in effect as set forth in the Tariff.

The following amended rules and regulations are hereby adopted, subject to change by the BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT COMMISSION at any time, subject to approval of the Public Service Commission through the filing of revised tariff sheets with the PSC. These amended rules and regulations are intended to supplement and amend the existing Rate Resolution; By-Laws; and the existing Rules and Regulations. All other provisions contained in the previously approved Tariff not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and affect.

- I. Paragraph G of the existing RULES AND REGULATIONS effective June 2, 1987 is hereby deleted.
- II. Paragraph Z.6 <u>Deposits</u> of the existing RULES AND REGULATIONS effective June 2, 1987 is hereby deleted.
- III. The following provisions shall be incorporated ANC THELED existing RULES AND REGULATIONS as follows:
  - AA. DEPOSITS

The Bullock Pen Water District may require a minimum cash deposit or other guarantee to secure payment of bills. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest as prescribed by KRS 74.050 will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer showing of satisfactory credit or payment history and required deposits will be returned after One (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. The company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

- 1. Previous payment history of the company. If the customer has no previous history with the company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc., may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.

The TARIFF RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS of the BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT are hereby amended to include the following provisions. All other provisions of the TARIFF RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS of the BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT shall remain in full force and effect as currently approved by the PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, provided however that existing SECTION AA: <u>RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FURNISHING WATER TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS WITHIN THE BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT BOUNDARIES</u> shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION AA: RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FURNISHING WATER TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS WITHIN THE BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

A. Any Fire Department operating within the Boundaries of the BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT may withdraw reasonable quantities of water from the DISTRICT which are reasonably necessary for fire protection purposes whether from a fire hydrant, flush hydrant or water loading station, without cost to the Fire Department. No charges shall be made for all reasonable amounts of water used or consumed by the respective Fire Department whether such water is utilized during a fire fighting procedure; fire fighting trial; simulation or drill.

B. Each Fire Department receiving water from the DISTRICT shall on the 15th day of January, April, July and October of each year submit to the DISTRICT a WATER USAGE REPORT identifying to the DISTRICT the total number of gallons used by that respective Fire Department during the preceding Quarter. The WATER USAGE REPORT shall include the dates and amounts of water utilized by that

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respective Fire Department. In the event that a reporting Fire Department is unable to determine the exact number of gallons of water used, the Fire Department should, as is most reasonably practicable under the circumstances, give a good faith estimate of the total number of gallons utilized by the Fire Department and dates thereof.

This Section shall supersede and amend the C. previously adopted and approved Section AA which was effective February 25, 1996.

To the extent that water consumed by a Fire D. Department through the Fire Department's regular metered source at its Headquarter is not utilized for fire fighting purposes or fire fighting training procedures, such water shall not be regulated pursuant to this Section. All such water consumed by a Fire Department through its regular metered sources at its Headquarter shall billed as a regular customer of the DISTRICT.

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
