ADDENDUM TO WATER PURCHASE CONTRACT

This Addendum to Water Purchase Contract is made and entered into by and between the City of Hopkinsville, Kentucky, acting by and through its duly authorized agency, the Hopkinsville Sewerage and Water Works Commission (hereinafter the Commission), and the Christian County Water District (hereinafter County District).

WHEREAS both parties entered into a Water Purchase Contract dated June 28, 1973, which Contract has been extended by subsequent Agreements in 1979, 1982, 1988, and 1990 so that the Contract is extended to expire on December 31, 2030; and

WHEREAS the original Water Purchase Contract provided for four Metering Points for the County District and provided for maximum purchases not to exceed seven million gallons of water per month; and

WHEREAS, due to growth of the County Dist**FUELC SERVICE COMMISSION** OF KENTUCKY present and future needs of the County District; SLF 2 2 1994

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 5.011, 1. <u>QUANTITY OF WATER</u>. The Commission agrees (1) BY: applicable regulatory purity standards in such quantity as may be required by the County District not to exceed thirty million gallons per month. However, in the event of severe drought or disaster, it is understood that the County 7. <u>CONTINUATION OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN COMMISSION</u> <u>AND COUNTY DISTRICT</u>. The Agreement dated the 28th day of June, 1973, between the Commission and the County District for the providing of water and tap-ons to the County District by the Commission shall continue in effect. Toward that end, both parties agree that an agreement for additional tap-ons and water usage will be negotiated and memorialized by separate Agreement.
