DEPOSITS

All customers will pay equal deposits in the amount of \$40.00. This amount does not exceed the average bill of residential customers served by the district and is less than 2/12ths of the average annual bill. Interest on deposits will be calculated according to KRS 74.050 and will be paid annually either by check or credit to the customer's bill. However, no check or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

Deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, another deposit may then be required. Upon termination of service, any deposit and interest owed to the customer will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

LEAK ADJUSTMENTS

If a customer has a leak, the district will adjust their bill by charging the tariffed rate for the amount equal to their average usage and charging the rate the district pays its supplier for the amount of usage in excess of their average bill. This will only be done ONCE per year per customer.
