**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

These Rules and Regulations govern the furnishing of water service by the East Logan Water District hereinafter referred to as the District and apply to all service received from the District. No employee or individual Commissioner of the District is permitted to make an exception to these Rates, Rules, or Regulations. These Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with the Kentucky Public Service Commission's Rules and Regulations (807 KAR 5:001-5:076). The District is subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Kentucky Public Service Commission even though not contained herein.

**1. Scope**

This Schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the District, and applies to all service received from the District whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. A copy of this schedule, together with a copy of the District's Schedule of Rates and Charges shall be kept open to inspection at the office of the District. The rules are promulgated under direction and authority granted pursuant to Chapter 5 of Kentucky Administrative Regulations (807 KAR 5). The aforesaid rules and regulations are hereby adopted and included the same as if herein written.

**2. Revisions**

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from time to time by either of the two (2) following methods:

- A. By order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission upon formal application by the District, and after hearing as provided by Commission Regulation set forth in 807 KAR 5:011.
- B. By issuing and filing on at least thirty (30) days notice to the Kentucky Public Service Commission and the public all proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations, as provided by Commission Regulations set forth in 807KAR 5:011.

3. Conflict

In case of conflict between any provisions of any rate schedule and the schedule of rules and regulations, the rate schedule shall apply. Also, should the rules contained herein conflict with rules in effect under 807 KAR 5, the provisions of 807KAR 5 shall take precedence over those contained herein.

4. Application for Service

Any person, firm, agency or governmental entity within the current boundary of the District may request service. Applications for service must be in writing on a form approved by the District.

Each applicant for service shall be required to execute and sign the District's standard application for water service before service is supplied by the District. Under Kentucky Public Service Commission Order, dated September 1, 1981, Case No. 8248, a 5/8" X 3/4" meter shall be the standard customer service meter and should be installed at all points

of service unless the customer provides sufficient justification for the installation of a larger meter.

**5. Non-Standard Service**

Each prospective customer requiring a non-standard service (that is, other than a 5/8" X 3/4" meter) shall present to the District sufficient justification for same. The size and type of service will be determined by the District based upon the needs of the customer and the capabilities of the utility. The customer shall pay all additional costs of any special installations above that of a standard service.

**6. Point of Delivery**

The point of delivery is the point where the meter or vault is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing, and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer. The District reserves the right to determine the point of delivery with full regard to those wishes of the prospective customer.

**7. Customer's Service Line**

A. All service lines beyond the metering point shall be installed of material consisting of copper, galvanized, PVC or PE with a rating of not less than 160 psi.

- B. The minimum size of the line shall not be less than three-fourths (3/4) inch nominal diameter. A larger size may be needed if the customer's point of use is at a higher elevation or long distance from the meter.
- C. All service lines shall be laid at a depth sufficient to prevent freezing during the coldest weather normally experienced. For the East Logan Water District this shall be a minimum of twenty four (24) inches.
- D. All service lines shall have a cut-off valve installed between the meter and the customers point of use. It is illegal for the customer to cut off water at the meter unless an emergency occurs. (Example- A leak in the service line between the meter and the customer's cut-off valve)
- E. Inspection of service line. In the installation of a service line, the customer shall leave the trench open and pipe uncovered until it is inspected by the utility and shown to be free from any tee, branch connection, irregularity or defect and of proper depth.
- F. All water used through the metering equipment shall be the responsibility of the customer. No adjustment will be made for water loss due to leak in customer's service line.

**8. Ownership of Mains, Services & Appurtenances**

All mains, fire hydrants, valves, crossings and other appurtenances are and shall remain the property of the District, whether installed by the District or the customer.

All service lines from main to meter with appurtenances shall be and remain the property of the District, whether installed by the District or the customer.

The customer shall install, own and maintain his service line from meter and/or point of delivery as defined herein.

**9. Discontinuance of Service by the District**

Water service may be discontinued by the District for any violation of any rule or regulation listed herein and particularly for any of the following.

- A. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
- B. Resale of water.
- C. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep such pipes in a suitable state of repair.

- D. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves, or permitting such tampering by others.
- E. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separate water supply to premises which receive water from the District.
- F. Non-payment of bills.
- G. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, with reference to the continuation of water service, water service shall be cut off without notice or shall be refused, provided the District shall notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be restored.

10. Billing

Bills and notices relating to the conduct or the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the "User's Agreement" unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.

Bills shall be rendered monthly and shall be paid within ten (10) days from date of bill at the office of District. Any bill not paid within this allotted time (10 days) shall be deemed delinquent. There shall be a late payment penalty charge of ten percent (10%) on all delinquent bills. When a bill has been delinquent for a period of ten (10) days, the District shall serve the delinquent customer a written final notice of said delinquency, and of the intent of the District to discontinue service five days after the date of such notice unless such bill is paid prior to the expiration of such five days. If a delinquent bill is not paid within five days after date of such final notice, the water supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice.

11. Discontinuance of Service by Customer

Any customer having fulfilled their contract terms and desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing at the business office of the District at least three (3) days prior to the date on which the customer desires to discontinue service. If such notice, in writing, is not given, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered to his premises by the District until said notice is received by the District.

12. Reconnection Fee

Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$15.00 will be made for reconnection of water service, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the District have been paid.

13. Deposit

The District reserves the right to require that a nominal amount be placed on deposit with the district for the purpose of insuring the payment of bills. The deposit will not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the customer's estimated annual bill. Upon payment of deposit, the district shall issue to the customer a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, and the date and amount of the deposit. The district will pay interest on the customer's deposit at the rate it receives until the date of its refund to the customer. Interest will be refunded or credited to the customer's bill annually.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of services changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

14. Adjustment Relative to Erroneous Meter

If a meter is inaccurate in excess of +-2%, whether upon periodic testing or upon requested testing, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter, and the adjustments shall be made in the customer's water bills as follows:

A. If the result of such test shows an average error greater than 2% fast, the customer's bill for the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. In the event the period during which the meter error existed is unknown, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one half of the elapsed time since the last test, or for the last twelve month period, whichever is less.

- B. If the result of tests on a customer's meter shows an average error greater than two (2) percent slow, then the customer's bill, for the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, may be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. In the event the period during which the meter error existed is unknown, then the customer's bill may be recomputed for one-half (1/2) of the elapsed time since the last previous test but in no case to exceed twelve (12) months.
- C. If the result of such tests necessitates making a refund or back billing a customer, the customer shall be notified in writing of the percentage of error, fast or slow, the date(s) of testing, and the amount of charge or credit to be shown on the next bill of the customer.

15. Meters

All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District, and the District reserves the right to approve the size and type of meter used. It shall be the policy of the District to test each water meter pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066 Section 16. In addition, upon written request of any customer, the meter servicing such customer shall be tested by the District, pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 20.

16. Failure of Water Meter

Where a meter is found to be in error, the customer's bill will be adjusted in accordance with Section 14 herein per Kentucky Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 9. Where a meter has ceased to register, the District will estimate the monthly bill of the customer for the month

that the meter is replaced. The estimated bill will be based upon the previous six month's usage.

**17. Right of Access**

The customer must agree to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, or remove it's water lines that are located on the customer's property with the right of ingress-and-egress over customer's property. The District's duly authorized representative and/or other duly authorized employee of the State Health Department bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to enter upon all properties for the purpose of inspection, observation, measurement, sampling and testing in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations.

**18. Interruption of Service**

The District will use reasonable diligence in supplying water service, but shall not be liable for loss, injury, or damage to persons or property resulting from interruptions in service, excessive or inadequate water pressure. The District does hereby explicitly state that it's system is one for rural domestic consumption and that it's allowance of connections to it's system for fire protection whether by design or implication is only for such benefit as a customer may be able to derive from such connection.

The District's system is not designed nor intended for use for fire protection in any manner whatsoever. Any customer using same for fire protection does so at their own full and sole responsibility.

Under no circumstances shall the District be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the District may be deemed necessary.

The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruptions occur will endeavor to restore service with the shortest possible delay. When the service is interrupted, all customers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.

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**19. Boilers and/or Pressure Vessels**

Customers having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the stream line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice. It is the responsibility of the customer to make provisions for protection of his equipment in case of interrupted on intermittant service.

**20. Backflow Preventors**

Special services and fire connections shall have backflow preventors of a type approved by the District, installed at the cost of the customer or applicant for service.

**21. Cross- Connection**

Kentucky Department of Health, Kentucky Public Service Commission and these Rules and Regulations do hereby explicitly state that cross-connection of the District's system with any other source is hereby prohibited.

**22. Relocation of Water Facility**

District may, at the request of a customer or other person relocate, change or modify existing District owned equipment, mains or appurtenances. Same shall reimburse District for such changes at actual cost including appropriate legal, administrative, engineering and overhead cost.

**23. Damage to DISTRICT'S Water System**

No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the District's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to immediate arrest and/or discontinuation of water service and shall pay the cost of repairing or replacing the pipe or appurtenance.

Any person, firm or organization involved in work around or near District's distribution mains or appurtenances may request the District to indicate location of same. However, indication by District of same does not relieve such person of complete responsibility and liability for any and all damages, liability and loss resulting from any act of such person or his assigns and/or agent.

**24. Additional Load**

The service connection supplied by the District for each customer has a definite capacity, and no addition to the equipment or load connected thereto will be allowed except by the consent of the District. Failure to give notice of additions or changes in load, and to obtain the District's consent for same, shall render the customer liable for any damage to any of the District's lines or equipment caused by the additional or changed installation.

**25. Notice of Trouble**

The customer shall notify the District immediately should the service be unsatisfactory for any reason, or should there be any defects, trouble or accidents affecting the supply of water.

**26. Water Main Extensions**

Any person desiring an extension to District system shall request in writing, in a form approved by the District, for such an extension. Any requested extension may be provided under one of the following options:

**OPTION II** - Applicant may construct and donate to District, the extension, as a contribution in aid of construction, meeting all District's specifications and approval. District reserves right to stipulate applicable engineering, legal and administrative factors. Applicant shall pay all cost of District as a contribution in aid of construction. Any extension made under this option shall not be eligible for refund.

**SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL SERVICE CHARGES**

The following charges for special services shall be made:

1. New Service Inspection: A charge of \$ ~~15.00~~ <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup> shall be assessed all new customers for the inspection of the service line from the meter to the customer's point of use. This shall be payed at the time customer makes application for service.
2. Service Reconnection Charge: A charge of \$ ~~15.00~~ <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup> shall be made for all service reconnections made during regular working hours, except that there shall be no connection charges made for service on the original installation of facilities. If service is reconnected other than during regular working hours, the charge shall be \$ ~~30.00~~ <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup>.
3. Meter Reading Recheck Charge: A charge of \$ ~~15.00~~ <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup> shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for accorrect reading and the meter was not misread. <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup>
4. Meter Test: Upon request and payment of \$ ~~25.00~~ <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup>, a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more frequent than once each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent fast, a refund of the \$ ~~25.00~~ <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup> charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly. If the periodic testing requirement of 807 KAR 5:066 (17) has not been met for the meter tested, no charge will be made for the test regardless of the results of the test. <sup>C 3/13/2007</sup>

CHAPTER 5

807 KAR 5:066. Water

Section 12. Extension of Service.

(1) Normal extension:

An extension of fifty (50) feet or less shall be made by a utility to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one (1) year or more and provides a guarantee for such service.

(2) Other extensions:

(a) When an extension of the utility's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty (50) feet per applicant, the utility may if not inconsistent with its filed tariff require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty (50) feet per customer to be deposited with the utility by the applicant or the applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension.

(b) Each customer receiving service under such extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a

period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of this rule shall be the refund period, the utility shall refund to the customer or customers who paid for the excessive footage the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the utility. After the end of the refund period, no refund will be required to be made.

(3) An applicant desiring an extension to a proposed real estate subdivision may be required to pay the entire cost of the extension. Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years the utility shall refund to the applicant who paid for the extension a sum equal to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected during the year but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the utility. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension, no refund will be required to be made.

(4) Nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit the utility from making extensions under different arrangements provided such arrangements have been approved by the Commission.

(5) Nothing contained herein shall be construed as to prohibit a utility from making at its expense greater extensions than herein prescribed, should its judgement so dictate, provided like free extensions are made to other customers under similar conditions.

(6) Upon complaint to and investigation by the commission, a utility may be required to construct extensions greater than fifty (50) feet upon a finding by the commission that such extension is reasonable.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12 month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.

2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customer's, no further review will be done.

3. If meter reader notes that water usage is more than the monthly range of usage, as noted by the computer on the meter reading worksheet, they will notify the customer by placing a doorknocker at the residence in service.

4. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.

5. The company will notify the customer's of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to it's attention as a result of its on going meter reading or billing processes or customer inquiry.

WATER LEAK ADJUSTMENT

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If a customer has a leak, the district will adjust their bill by charging the tariffed rate for the amount equal to their average usage and charging the rate the district pays its supplier plus pumping cost for the amount of usage in excess of their average bill. The customer will be required to sign a one time leak adjustment and will not be allowed any future adjustment. Average usage will be calculated based on the customers actual usage over the past 12 months prior to discovering the leak.
