These Rules and Regulations govern the furnishing of water service by the East Logan Water District hereinafter feferred to as the District and apply to all service received from the District. No employee or individual Commissioner of the District is permitted to make an exception to these Rates, Rules, or Regulations. These Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with the Kentucky Public Service Commission's Rules and Regulations (807 KAR 5:001-5:076). The District is subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Kentucky Public Service Commission even though not contained herein.

1. Scope

East Logan Water District -

This Schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the District, and applies to all service received from the District whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. A copy of this schedule, together with a copy of the District's Schedule of Rates and Charges shall be kept open to inspection at the office of the District. The rules are promulgated under direction and authority granted pursuant to Chapter 5 of Kentucky Administrative Regulations (897, 647, 647, 520) The aforesaid rules and regulations are hereby adopted and included the same as if herein written.

2. Revisions

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended from time to time by revised of the two (2) following methods:

The minimum size of the line shall not be less than three-fourths (3/4) inch nominal diameter. A larger size may be needed if the customer's point of use is at a higher elevation or long distance from the meter.

- All service lines shall be laid at a depth sufficient to prevent freezing during the coldest weather normally experienced. For the East Logan Water District this shall be a minimum of twenty four (24) inches.
- All service lines shall have a cut-off valve installed between the meter and the customers point of use. It is illegal for the customer to cut off water at the meter unless an emergency occurs. (Example- A leak in the service line between the meter and the customer's cut-off valve)

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8. Ownership of Mains, Services & Appurtenances

All mains, fire hydrants, valves, crossings and other appurtenances are and shall remain the property of the District, whether installed by the District or the customer.

All service lines from main to meter with appurtenances shall be and remain the property of the District, whether installed by the District or the customer.

The customer shall install, own and maintain his service line from meter and/or point of delivery as defined herein.

9. Discontinuance of Service by the District

Water service may be discontinued by the District for any violation of any rule or regulation listed herein and particularly for any of the following.

A. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.

B. Resale of water.

10. Billing

13. Deposit

The District reserves the right to require that a nominal amount be placed on deposit with the district for the purpose of insuring the payment of bills. The deposit will not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the customer's estimated annual bill. Upon payment of deposit, the district shall issue to the customer a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, and the date and amount of the deposit. The district will pay interest on the customer's deposit at the

rate it receives until the date of its refund to the customer. Interest will be refunded or credited to the customer's bill annually.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of services changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

14. Adjustment Relative to Erroneous Meter

If a meter is inaccurate in excess of +-2%, whether upon periodic testing or upon requested testing, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter, and the adjustments shall be made in the customer's water bills as follows:

A. If the result of such test shows an average error greater than 2% fast, the customer's bill for the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. If the result of tests on a customer's meter shows an average error greater than two (2) percent slow, then the customer's bill, for the period during which the meter error is knows to have existed, may be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. In addition, upon written request of any customer, the meter servicing such customer shall be tested by the District, pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:006 Section 20.

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APPENDIX I Rules and Regulations of the East Logan Water District

CHAPTER 5

807 KAR 5:066. Water

East Logan Water District

Section 12. Extension of Service.

(1) Normal extension:

An extension of fifty (50) feet or less shall be made by a utility to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one (1) year or more and provides a guarantee for such service.

(2) Other extensions:

(a) When an extension of the utility's main to serve **SERVICE COMMISSION** applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty (50) feet per applicant, the utility may if not inconsistent with its filed tartff require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty (50) feet per customer to be deposited with the utility by the applicant or the applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension.

period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of this rule shall be the refund period, the utility shall refund to the customer or customers who paid for the excessive footage the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the utility. After the end of the refund period, no refund will be required to be made.

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(3) An applicant desiring an extension to a proposed real estate subdivision may be required to pay the entire cost of the extension. Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years the utility shall refund to the applicant who paid for the extension a sum equal to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected furing the year but in no case shall he total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the utility. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension ine refund will be required to be made. MAY 0 1 2011

(4) Nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibitcktheusuc utility from making extensions under different arrangements () and sion such arrangements have been approved by the Commission.

(5) Nothing contained herein shall be construed as to prohibit a utility from making at its expense greater extensions than herein prescribed, should its judgement so dictate, provided like freesion extensions are made to other customers under similar conditions.

(6) Upon complaint to and investigation by the commission, a utility may be required to construct extensions greater than fifty (50) feet upon a finding by the commission that such Jenters for is reasonable.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12 month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.

2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customer's, no further review will be done.

3. If meter reader notes that water usage is more than the monthly range of usage, as noted by the computer on the meter reading worksheet, they will notify the customer by placing a doorknocker at the residence in service.

4. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained , the company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.

5. The company will notify the customer's of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to it's attention as a result of its on going meter reading or billing processes or customer inquiry.
