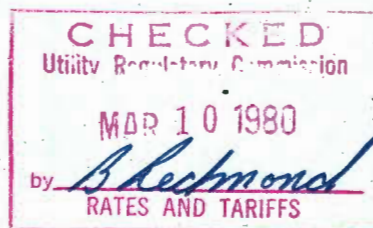

RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY THE HYDEN-LESLIE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS AT ANY TIME SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION:

1. Water meters are read each month starting on the twentieth (20th). By Hyden-Leslie County Water District Personnel.
2. All bills are in the mail by the Fifth (5th) of each month.
3. All Bills are due by the last day of the month, bills paid after the last day of the month will show up on the next month's bill and will be subject to a penalty.
4. A 10% penalty will be added to past due amounts.
5. Delinquent notices will be sent out once a month to customers who are two (2) months or more behind on their bill. The customer will be given seven (7) days to pay the balance owed. If the customer has not payed by the end of the seventh (7th) day, service to the customer will be discontinued.
6. If water service is discontinued for non-payment the customer will be required to pay the past due bill plus a \$15.00 servie charge before water service can be restored.
7. A minimum charge is billed to the customer each month as long as the water meter is installed, whether any water is used or not.
8. The water meter may be removed upon request to avoid the monthly minimum charge and upon request will be re-installed for an installation charge of \$7.00.
9. Adjustments for water bills will be made in accordance with 807 KAR 25:020, Section 9.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 10. A Twenty-Five (\$25.00) deposit is required for all new transfers, new customers, and new hook-ups. This deposit will be refunded to the customer whenever they wish to discontinue service, and their account is paid in full. Interest is paid on the deposit yearly and credited to the customers' account.
- 11. The customer is responsible for all leaks, breaks, etc., beyond the water meter. Hyden-Leslie County Water District is responsible up to and through the meter.
- 12. There will be no multiple hook-ups, each family/resident will have an individual meter.
- 13. There will be a \$300.00 fee for all new tap-on /meter installation for a 3/4" meter; \$420.00 for 1" meter; \$565.00 for 1 1/2" meter; and \$750.00 for a 2" meter.
- 14. The principle place of business is at the Water District Office on Wendover Road, on Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (closed for lunch 12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m.)
