14. SERVICE DEPOSITS

- (T) (a) The Company may request a cash deposit or other suitable guarantee of any Customer or Applicant to secure the payment of bills as rendered. The amount of cash deposit shall be 1-1/3 times the estimated average water bill where bills are rendered quarterly and 2 times the estimated average water bill where bills are rendered monthly.
- (T) (b) Any Customer who has failed to pay all charges for services rendered within the specified payment period shall be deemed to have impaired his credit standing and may be required, upon five (5) days' written notice, to make a cash deposit as hereinbefore specified. Upon failure to make such cash deposit after ten (10) days' written notice for the premises supplied, service in the name of such Customer may be discontinued forthwith.
- (c) (c) The Customer's deposit must be kept intact, and the Company shall not be required to apply it to payment of current water bills or any other charge whatsoever; however, the deposit and any accumulated interest thereon may be applied to any unpaid final bill of such Customer.
- (C) (d) The Company will pay interest on all such unrefunded deposits at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum. Interest will not be paid after discontinuance of service to the Customer if the Company has made reasonable effort to return the deposit to the Customer. Reasonable effort will have been made by the Company by mailing the deposit to the Customer at his last known address. Interest will accrue from date of deposit, and any interest accumulated, but not previously paid, will be payable upon return of the deposit. Interest will be paid annually and compounded annually if a deposit is held for more than one year.
- (C) (e) Service deposits may be refunded to the depositor at the Company's discretion.
- (f) The Company will issue a certificate of deposit to every Customer from whom a deposit is received and will provide reasonable ways and means whereby a Customer shall not be deprived of the return of his deposit because he may be unable to produce the original certificate of deposit.
