I. Service Classification. There shall be no distinction of this category.

II. Service application.

Name of issuing Corporation

Kirksville Water Association, Inc.

- A. Any bona fide occupant of a single family dwelling; or to each residential unit in an auto court, duplex or multiple dwelling building; or person holding property who has reasonable acessibility to the source of and who is in reasonable need of having water supplied to his place of occupancy or property may be a member of this Company by obtaining a membership certificate from the Company. Persons who receive the approval of the Board of Directors may be admitted to membership pon subscribing for a membership certificate and by signing such agreements for the purchase of water as may be provided and required by the Company, provided that no person otherwise eligible shall be permitted to subscribe for or require a membership of the Company if the capacity of the Company's water system is exhausted by the needs of its existing members, unless the Company is ordered to do so, pursuant to KRS 278.280.
- B. The Company may reject any application for membership when the Applicant is delinquent in payment of bills for service previously supplied at any location.
- C. Violation of any of the provisions of these rules, by-laws, or any other regulations of the Company, and the Company may remove the meter and discontinue service. Where the meter is thereafter reinstalled, the member shall first pay to the Company a reinstallation charge of \$15.00. Members receiving service as a part of an extension of service are required to contract for service for one year. Such members shall pay for service according to the rates in effect, or the minimum monthly rate, whichever is greater, whether or not the member uses the service.
 D. The individual in whose name the membership certificate is prepared shall be responsible for all bills incurred. Customers shall be responsible for their own bills. Customers shall pay the applicable deposit before meter is turned on.
- III. Initial or minimum charges.
 - A. The flat, minimum monthly rate, as set up in the water rate schedule for the year, will be payable irrespective of whether any water is used by the member during any month. Member shall not be charged for any month where service has been discontinued.

- B. In the event the Company may be required to remove the meter for non-payment of bills, the Company when service is again restored will make a charge for such reinstallation equal to the outstanding bills unpaid. of #/5.00.
- C. The tap fee of \$300.00 minimum dollars shall be made for each new meter installation where a 5/8 X 3/4 inch meter is used regardless of location. Each meter requires a separate meter reading sheet, and each meter reading sheet will cover a separate and individual account.
- D. Water furnished for a given lot or farmstead shall be used on that lot only. Each member's service must be separately metered at a single delivery and metering point. All commercial use, including storerooms and stalls for business purposes shall be metered separately from any residential use, and vice versa.
- E. In addition to the collection of regular rates, the Company may collect from the member a proportionate share of any privilege, sales, or use tax or impositions, based on gross revenue received by the Company.
- IV. Company's Responsibility.
 - A. The Company will install, maintain and operate a main distribution pipeline or lines from the source of water supply, and service lines from the main distribution line or lines to the property line of each member of the Company at which points, designated as delivery points, meters to be purchased, installed owned and maintained by the Company, shall be placed. The cost of the service line or lines from the main distribuition line or lines of the Company to the property line of each member shall be paid by the Company. The Company will also purchase and install a cut-off valve in each service line from its main distribution line or lines, such cut-off valve to be owned and maintained by the Company and to be installed on same portion of the service line owned by the Company. The Company shall have the sole and exclusive right to use of such cut-off valve to turn it on and off.
 - B. Each member shall be entitled to not to exceed one (1) service line from the Company's water system unless otherwise approved by the Board of Directors and provided that the member shall be required to pay the prevalent tap fee for each service line. No new service line or change in an existing service line may be made which will interfere with an existing service line or the delivery of water therein. Each service line shall connect

with the company's water system at the nearest available place to the place of desired use by the member if the Company's water system shall be of sufficient capacity to permit the delivery of water through a service line at that place without interfering with the delivery of water through a prior service line. If the company's water system shall be inadequate to permit the delivery of water through a service line installed at such place without interfering with the delivery of water through a prior service line, then such service line shall be installed at such place as may be designated by the company. Each member will be required to dig or have dug a ditch, to purchase and install, and to maintain such portion of the service line or lines from the property line of the member to his own dwelling; or other place of use on his premises at his own expense, provided that the Company may if the Board of Directors so elect, purchase the pipe for and install such portion of such service line or lines, the cost of which will, however, be paid by the individual members.

- C. The Company will cause an initial inspection to be made of the member's piping or apparatus to ensure compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.
- v. Company's Liability.

- The Company reserves the right to refuse service unless the member's lines Α. or piping are installed in such manner as to prevent cross-connections or back-flow.
- Β. The Company shall not be liable for damage of any kind whatsoever resulting from water or the use of water on the member's premises, unless such damage results directly from negligence on the part of the Company. The Company shall not be responsible for any damage done or by resulting from any defects in piping, fixtures, or appliances on the member's premises. The Company shall not be responsible for negligence of the third persons, or forces beyond the control of the Company resulting in any interruption of service.
- C. Under normal conditions, the members will be notified of any anticipated interruptions of service.

If the Company is called upon to provide additional meters, each place of B. metering will be considered as a separate and individual account.

SHEET NO

- The Member shall provide a place of metering, which is unobstructed and C. accessible at all times.
- D. The Member shall furnish and maintain a private cut-off valve on the member's side of the meter. The Company is to provide a like valve on the Company's side of such meter.
- Ε. The member's piping and apparatus shall be installed and maintained by the member at the member's expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the Company rules and regulations and in full compliance with sanitary regulations of the State Board of Health.
- The Member shall guarantee proper protection for the Company's property F. placed on the member's premises and shall permit access to it only by authorized representatives of the Company.
- In the event that any loss or damage to the property of the Company or any G. accident or injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful act of the member, his agent or employees, the Company reserves the right to seek the recovery of the necessary repairs or replacements through a court of competent jurisdiction. Nothing stated in these rules and regulations shall be deemed a waiver of this right.
- H. Water furnished by the Company shall be used for domestic consumption by the member, members of his household, and employees only. The member shall not sell water to any other person or permit any other person to use said water. Water shall not be used for irrigation, fire protection, or other purposes, except that when water is available in sufficient quantity without interfering with the regular domestic consumption, then the water may be used for such other purposes. Disregard for this rule shall be sufficient cause for refusal or discontinuance of service.

VII. Extensions to Mains and Services.

The Company will supply service for temporary purposes, provided that the Α. Company has water available in excess of the Company's regular needs, and provided the Company has available material and equipment necessary to supply said service. Each applicant for such service must pay in advance to the Company the Company's estimate of cost of labor and materials, less

- B. An extension of fifty (50) feet or less shall be made by the Company to its existing distribution main without charge to a member who shall apply for and contract to use service for one (1) year or more.
- C1. When an extension of the Company's main to serve a member amounts to more than fifty (50) feet per member, the company shall require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty (50) feet per member to be deposited with the utility by the member, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension.
- C2. Each member receiving service under such extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of this rule shall be the refund period, the Company shall refund to the member who paid for the excessive footage the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension in place for each additional member connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the utility. After the end of the refund period, no refund will be required to be made.
- D. Member applicant desiring an extension to a proposed real estate sub-division may be required to pay the entire cost of the extension. Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years the Company shall refund to the member who paid for the extension of a sum equivalent to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected during the year but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the Company. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension no refund will be required to be made.
- VIII. Access to Premises.
 - A. Duly authorized agents of the Company shall have access, at all reasonable hours, to the premises of the member for the purpose of installing or removing Company property, inspecting piping, reading or testing meters or for any other purpose in connection with the Company's service and facilities.

- A. Not less than one week's notice must be given in person or in writing to the Company to discontinue service or to change occupancy.

 - E. Bills are due when rendered and become delinquent ten (10) days after due date.
 - F. Delinquent notices will be mailed to the member ten (10) days after the regular monthly billing date, and if payment is not made within thirty (30) days after due date, written notice of intention to disconnect services will be mailed to last known address. Notice to disconnect shall be given at least 48 hours before disconnection.
 - G. Failure to receive bills or notices shall not prevent such bills from becoming delinquent nor relieve the member from payment.
- XI. Suspension of Service.

- B. Upon discontinuance of service for non-payment of bills, the deposit will be applied by the Company toward settlement of the account.
- C. Service discontinued for non-payment of bills will be restored only after bills are paid in full, and a reconnection fee of \$15.00 (fifteen dollars) will be paid for each meter reconnected.
- D. The Company reserves the right to discontinue its service for the following additional reasons:
 - 1. Without notice, for consumer's fraudulent or illegal use of service.
 - 2. For consumer's non-payment of bills. However, the Company shall first make all reasonable effort to induce consumer to pay the bill, and thereafter, consumer shall be given at least 48 hours written notice, mailed to his last known address. In no event shall service be cut off before the 20th day after the date on which the original bill was mailed to consumer. In the event consumer submits a written certificate of a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer to the Company, stating that discontinuance of service will aggrivate an existing illness or infirmity on the effective premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until 10 days elapse from the date of the Company's written notice, whichever occurs first.

XII. Complaints - Adjustment.

- A. If the member believes his bill to be in error, he shall present his claim, in person or in writing, to the Board of Directors before the bill becomes delinquent. Such claim, if made after the bill has become delinquent, shall not be effective in preventing discontinuance of service, as heretofore provided. The member may pay such bill under a protest and said payment shall not prejudice his claim.
- B. The Company will make special meter readings at the request of the member for a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00), provided, however, that if such special reading discloses that the meter was overread, no charge will be made.
- C. Meters will be tested at the request of the member, for a fee of \$15.00. Provided however if test discloses that meter was in error no charge will be made.
