



The following rules and regulations are subject to change by the water association commissioners at any time subject to approval by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

1. The Association will impose a penalty of ten percent (10%) on all bills not paid by the 10th of the month.

2. When a customer's meter is found to be inoperative, the Association will use the average of the preceding three (3) months to compute the customer's bill.

3. All water meters will be read on the 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, and 24th of each month, weather permitting.

4. A deposit not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) is required from persons who are renting from members of the Association and interest at the rate of six percent (6%) will be paid on demand on all deposits.

5. All customers will be billed in accordance with the rate of KENTUCKY schedule of the Association.
