RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following are the rules and regulations of the North Nelson Water District. The schedule of rates prescribed herein will be uniformly charged to all customers of the utility. No one will receive or be entitled to free service by the utility. No employee or individual commissioner of the utility is permitted to make an exception to these rates, rules, or regulations. These rules and regulations are subject to change by the utility at any time, subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission.

A. Service Information.

1. Meters are the property of the utility and are not to be tampered with except by an authorized operator.
2. Meters will be read monthly between the 1st and 20th of each month.
3. Bills are mailed on or about the 25th of each month.
4. Payments are due between the 25th of one month and the 10th of the next month.
5. Payments must be received, not postmarked, before the close of business on the 10th day of the month; otherwise, the unpaid bill will be assessed the late payment penalty listed in the utility's tariff that is approved and on file with the Public Service Commission.
6. Bills not paid by the 20th are deemed delinquent and are subject to loss of service. The utility may terminate service on a delinquent account only after five (5) days' written notice of termination has been given.
7. There can be no more than one house, apartment, or mobile home connected to a single meter.
8. Regardless of who pays the water bill, the person whose name appears on the bill is responsible for the bill until the utility is notified to discontinue service in that name and a final meter reading is taken.
9. The utility is responsible for maintaining the system up to and including the meter. Repairs beyond the meter are the consumer's responsibility.
