## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

The following are the rules and regulations of the <u>North Nelson Water District</u>. The schedule of rates prescribed herein will be uniformly charged to all customers of the utility. No one will receive or be entitled to free service by the utility. No employee or individual commissioner of the utility is permitted to make an exception to these rates, rules, or regulations. These rules and regulations are subject to change by the utility at any time, subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission.

## A. <u>Service Information</u>.

- 1. Meters are the property of the utility and are not to be tampered with except by an authorized operator.
- 2. Meters will be read monthly between the  $1^{st}$  and  $20^{th}$  of each month.
- 3. Bills are mailed on or about the  $25^{th}$  of each month.
- 4. Payments are due between the  $25^{th}$  of one month and the  $10^{th}$  of the next month.
- 5. Payments must be received, or postmarked, before the close of business on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month; otherwise, the unpaid bill will be assessed the late payment penalty listed in the utility's tariff that is approved and on file with the Public Service Commission.
- 6. Bills not paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> are deemed delinquent and are subject to loss of service. The utility may terminate service on a delinquent account only after five (5) days' written notice of termination has been given.
- 7. There can be no more than one house, apartment, or mobile home connected to a single meter.
- 8. Regardless of who pays the water bill, the person whose name appears on the bill is responsible for the bill until the utility is notified to discontinue service in that name and a final meter reading is taken.
- 9. The utility is responsible for maintaining the system up to and including the meter. Repairs beyond the meter are the consumer's responsibility.

- 11. Complaints should be directed to the manager at (502) 348-8342.

## B. Extension Policy.

The utility shall determine the total cost of the proposed water main extension (exclusive of the meter connections) and the total length of the extension. The utility shall pay that portion of the cost of the water main extension equal to fifty (50) feet for each applicant for service. That part of the cost not covered by the utility's portion shall be contributed equally by those applicants desiring service on the main extension. Each applicant will also be required to pay the utility's approved connection/tap-on fee for a meter connection to the main extension.

For a period of five years after the original construction of the main extension, each additional customer directly connected to each particular extension will be required to contribute to the cost of that water main extension based on a recomputation of both the utility's portion of the total cost and each customer's contribution as set out above. The utility must refund to those customers that have previously contributed to the cost of each main extension itself that amount necessary to reduce their contribution to the currently calculated amount for each customer connected to that extension. All customers directly connected to each main extension for a five-year period after it is placed in service are to contribute equally to the cost of construction of the water main extension itself. In addition, customers must pay the approved connection / tap-on fee applicable at the time of their application for the meter connection. The connection / tap-on fee is not part of the refundable cost of the extension and may be changed during the refund period. After the five-year refund period expires, any additional customer applying for service on each main extension must be connected for the amount of the approved connection / tap-on fee only. Also, after the five-year period expires, the utility will be required to make refunds for an additional five-year period in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066 Section 12(b).

## **HIGHWAY 48 WATER MAIN EXTENSION POLICY**

1. <u>APPLICABILITY</u>. These rules are applicable to the water main extension which the North Nelson Water District (the "District") proposes to construct along Kentucky Highway 48 (High Grove Road) from Fairfield to High Grove and any main extensions that are constructed along any side roads extending from Highway 48. The side roads include the following: Gordon Drive, Gordon Court, Dotson Court, Whitesides Road, Hibbs Lane, King Road, Snider Lane, Hickman Lane, Roby Lane and Love Lane. Collectively, these water main extensions shall be referred to as the "Project". The area served by these water main extensions shall be referred to as the "Project Area."

2. <u>COMPLETION DATE</u>. The term "Completion Date" shall refer to the date that a particular water main extension located within the Project Area has been placed into service and water service has been made available to customers. The District shall keep a record of the Completion Date for each water main extension constructed within the Project Area and shall notify the customers.

<u>CUSTOMER CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROJECT</u>. For a period of 10 years after the Completion Date, each customer directly connecting to a water main installed as part of the Project shall make a \$2,500 contribution in aid of construction to the District. This contribution can either be packenaucking sum or it will be financed by the District at an interest rate of 6% payable in 120 equal monthly installments of \$27.76 each.

4. **DISTRICT CONTRIBUTION.** The District shall contribute \$1,000 per initial applicant. The District shall not be reimbursed for this contribution. In addition, the District shall advance the balance of the funds necessary to complete the Project. The funds advanced by the District shall be subject to reimbursement as additional customers connect to the water main extensions.

**PAYMENT OF CUSTOMER CONTRIBUTION.** An applicant for service has the option of paying the \$2,500 contribution in aid of construction in a lump sum or signing a Promissory Note prior to receiving water service. A copy of the Promissory Note is attached hereto and incorporated here by reference.

a. <u>Monthly Payments</u>. The unpaid principal balance owed by the customer shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum and shall be paid in 120 equal monthly installments of \$27.76 each.

**b.** <u>Prepayment Privilege</u>. The customer shall in SERVICE COMMISSION prepay all, or any part, of the Promissory Note without prepayayment penalty.

c. <u>Termination of Water Service</u>. The District shall show the monthly debt installment payment as a separate line item on the customer's monthly water bill. The debt payment shall be due on the same date that the water bill is due. Payment of the amount due for both water service and debt payment shall be a condition of continued water service. The District shall have the right to terminate a customer's water service if that customer fails to timely pay the monthly debt installment payment.

d. <u>No Transfer of Promissory Notes</u>. In the event a customer sells or otherwise transfers his property before his Promissory Note has been paid in full, then the entire remaining unpaid balance shall become due and payable at the time of sale or transfer. The Promissory Note is not assumable by the new purchaser. The new purchaser shall not be required to pay any additional contribution in aid of construction unless the new purchaser desires an additional meter. **OF KENTUCKY**

**NO REFUNDS.** Each customer recognizes and acknowledges that additional persons will probably connect to the water main extensions located within the Project Area within 10 years after the Completion Date. Each of these subsequent customers shall make a \$2,500 contribution in aid of construction. No customer shall be entitled to any refund or rebate as these additional customers connect to the water mains. Because of the substantial, initial contribution made by the District and its advancement of the balance of the funds necessary to complete the Project, the District shall not be required to refund any applicants for service the cost of 50 feet of the water main extension for each additional customer that directly connects to the water main extensions during the 10 years following the Completion Date as Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11 requires.

SEPARATE ACCOUNT. All contributions in aid of construction paid by customers within the Project Area, including both lump sum and monthly installment payments, shall be deposited by the District into a separate account and accounted for separately from other District funds. The funds in this account shall be used to reimburse the District for all Broj services to in the second of the initial contribution made by the District.

- 8. <u>SUBSEQUENT CUSTOMERS</u>. All customers, including initial applicants and those persons directly connecting to the water main extension for a period of 10 years after the Completion Date, shall pay the same \$2,500 contribution in aid of construction. There shall be no reduction in the amount of the contribution in aid of construction as additional customers connect to the water main extensions.
- 9. <u>MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF CONTRIBUTIONS</u>. The maximum amount of contributions in aid of construction collected by the District shall not exceed the amount of the Project costs advanced by the District. (The initial District contribution of \$1,000 per initial applicant shall be excluded in computing the amount advanced by the District). The District shall cease collecting contributions in aid of construction once the cumulative total contributions reach the amount advanced by the District.
- 10. <u>TAP FEE</u>. To receive water service, a customer must also pay the meter connection fee (tap fee) and the customer deposit set forth in the District's filed rate schedule.

## C. Water Loss Adjustment Policy.

In the event of water loss, which the system deems is beyond the reasonable control of the consumer, their bill may be adjusted as follows:

- 1. Water loss will be adjusted using the following formula:
  - a) The average usage of the consumer for the previous twelve months shall be determined, and the excess of the current period shall be charged at the current wholesale rate, with the difference credited to the customer's account.
  - b) If a twelve month history is not available for the consumer, the average usage will be determined by the average usage of all customers in the same class and then calculated as above.
- 2. Such an adjustment will only be made one (1) time in a given twelve month period. If more than one break occurs within the same period, any additional adjustment must be approved by the governing body of the water system.
- 3. In order to qualify for a water loss adjustment, the consumer must meet one or all of the following:
  - a) If repair work is performed for hire, a copy of the billing invoice must be submitted at the billing office.
  - b) If repair work is performed by the homeowner, a copy of the receipt for purchased parts should be submitted at the office.
  - c) Verification by system authorized field representative that he has met with consumer and can verify a line loss.

## D. Deposits.

The utility may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the required deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit. The deposit amount shall be a calculated deposit based on 2/12ths of the customer's actual or estimated average annual bill.

The deposit may be waived upon a customers' showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The utility may increase or decrease the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for residential customers or ten (10) percent for a non-residential customer, the utility may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation. Upon termination of the service, any deposit and interest owed to the customer will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

### E. Special Non-recurring Charges.

- 1. The utility will collect for special nonrecurring charges to recover customer-specific costs incurred which would otherwise result in monetary loss to the utility or increased rates to other customers to whom no benefits accrue from the service provided or action taken. The utility may establish or change any special nonrecurring charge by applying for Public Service Commission approval of such charge in accordance with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10.
- 2. Special nonrecurring charges will be applied uniformly throughout the area served by the utility. Such charges will relate directly to the service performed or action taken and only yield enough revenue to pay the expenses incurred in rendering the service.
- 3. The utility will assess a charge for the following non-recurring services:
  - a) <u>Connection/Turn-on Charge</u>: Will be assessed for new service turn-ons, seasonal turn-ons, temporary service, or transfer of service. The charge will not be made for initial installation of service where a meter connection/tap-on charge is applicable.
  - b) <u>Field Collection Charge</u>: Will be assessed when a utility representative visits the premises of the service connection to terminate service, and the customer is on-site and pays the bill to avoid termination of service. This fee may only be charged once per billing period.
  - c) <u>Late Payment Penalty</u>: Will be assessed on the delinquent amount of the bill, less taxes. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006 Section 8(3)(h), a penalty may be assessed only once on any bill for rendered services.
  - d) <u>Meter Relocation Charge</u>: Will be assessed when a customer or other authorized person requests that a meter be relocated, changed, or modified. Those requesting a change must reimburse the utility for the actual costs

g) <u>Reconnection Charge</u>: Will be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of service or for violation of Utility or Public Service Commission rules and regulations and will include the cost of the service trip for both the disconnection and the reconnection.

h) <u>Reconnection Charge (After Hours</u>): Will be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of service or for violation of Utility or Public Service Commission rules and regulations and will include the cost of the service trip for both the disconnection and the reconnection.

i) <u>Returned Check Charge</u>: Will be assessed when a customer's check is returned, either due to insufficient funds or other reason due to customer fault.

j) Service Call/Investigation Charge: Will be assessed when a customer requests the onsite presence of utility personnel to investigate a service problem and the problem is a result of the customer's own plumbing facilities, beyond the utility's delivery point, or facilities beyond the utility's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.

F. Monitoring of Customer Usage.

At least once annually the utility will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

- 1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent twelve (12) month period will be compared with the annual usage for the twelve (12) months immediately preceding that period.
- 2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if the difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions common to all customers, no further review will be done.
- 3. If the annual usages differ by 200% or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the utility will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the twelve (12) month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
- 4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the utility will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as different number of household members or work staff, additional or different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leaks in the customer's service line.
- 5. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the utility will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than two (2) percent fast of slow.
- 6. The utility will notify the customer of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006 Section 10 (4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the utility will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to its attention as a result of its on-going meter reading, billing processes, or customer inquiry.

## FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ('User') may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the following calendar month.

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_ for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.

# PROMISSORY NOTE HIGHWAY 48 PROJECT

The undersigned (the "CUSTOMER"), as a contribution in aid of construction, hereby promises to pay to the order of the North Nelson Water District (the "DISTRICT"), the sum of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00), plus interest thereon at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum, with said sum being due and payable in 120 equal monthly installments of \$27.76 each which represents payment on both the principal and interest. The first monthly installment shall commence 30 days after the DISTRICT has completed construction of the water transmission lines and other improvements necessary to serve the CUSTOMER (the "PROJECT") and water service has been made available to the CUSTOMER (the "COMPLETION DATE"). Thereafter, the CUSTOMER must make a like installment payment of \$27.76 per month on or before the 10th day of each and every month thereafter until the Promissory Note has been paid in full.

# THE CUSTOMER HAS THE RIGHT TO PREPAY ALL, OR ANY PART, OF THE PROMISSORY NOTE WITHOUT PREPAYMENT PENALTY.

This Promissory Note does not bear any interest until the COMPLETION DATE. Thereafter, it bears interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum.

SALE OF PROPERTY. In the event the CUSTOMER sells his property before the Promissory Note has been paid in full, then the entire remaining unpaid balance shall be due and payable at the time of sale. The Promissory Note is not assumable by the new purchaser. The new purchaser of the property will not be required to pay any additional contribution in aid of construction unless the new purchaser needs more than one (1) meter.

<u>WATER SERVICE NOT AVAILABLE.</u> If the PROJECT is not completed, or if water service is not made available to the CUSTOMER, then this Promissory Note shall be declared null and void, marked "CANCELLED", and returned to the CUSTOMER.

DEFAULT. In the event the CUSTOMER fails to make any installment payment on or before the time specified herein, or within fifteen (15) days thereafter, with time being of the essence hereof, the DISTRICT may, without notice or demand, declare the entire unpaid balance immediately due and payable. If the CUSTOMER does not pay the remaining unpaid balance, plus accrued interest, by the tenth (10th) day of the following month, then he shall forfeit all payments previously made on this Promisser's Statues commission of KENTUCKY

Any person who subsequently purchases the property after the default and applies for water service to the property may be required to pay the DISTRICT a contribution in aid of construction of \$2,500.

<u>ATTORNEY FEES.</u> In the event it becomes necessary for the DISTRICT to enforce collection of this Promissory Note by legal action, then the DISTRICT shall be entitled to recover the then unpaid amount of this Promissory Note, plus accrued interest, Court costs, and reasonable attorney fees.

<u>NO REFUND.</u> The CUSTOMER recognizes and acknowledges that additional persons will probably connect to the water lines after the PROJECT is completed. The CUSTOMER will not be entitled to any refund or rebate as these other persons make \$2,500. contributions in aid of construction.

<u>PSC APPROVAL</u>. The terms and conditions contained in this Promissory Note are subject to approval by the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the "PSC").

The SUPPLIER shall determine the location of the water meter on the property and such location will not be more than fifty (50) feet from the main.

The SUPPLIER shall purchase and install the water meter and other appurtenances thereto and has the exclusive right to use said water meter and/or other appurtenances.

The SUPPLIER shall serve each individual residence or place of use with a separate meter, except for special circumstances, which require approval of the SUPPLIER's Board of Commissioners.

**SECTION 4.** The SUPPLIER shall determine the allocation of water to the USER in the event of a water shortage, and may shut off water to the USER if such event occurs. The SUPPLIER may shut off water to the USER if the USER allows a connection or extension to be made to his service line for the purpose of supplying water to another party. In the event the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all of the needs of the USERS, or in the event there is a shortage of water, the SUPPLIER must first satisfy all of the needs of all of the USERS for domestic purposes before supplying any water for livestock purposes and must satisfy all of the needs of all of the USERS for domestic and livestock purposes before supplying any water for garden or other purposes.

**SECTION 5**. The USER agrees that no present or future source of water will be connected to any water lines served by the SUPPLIER's water lines and USER shall disconnect from his/her present water supply, well, or other source, prior to connecting to and switching to the SUPPLIER's system and shall eliminate present or future cross-connections in his/her system.

**SECTION 6**. The USER hereby grants the SUPPLIER a perpetual easement over, under, and across USER's land to install, construct, maintain, repair, replace, and remove meters, water lines, and appurtenant facilities. In addition, the USER also hereby grants the SUPPLIER the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of reading, repairing, and replacing USER's meter, and for the purpose of connecting and disconnecting USER's water service.

**SECTION 7.** For new connections, the USER agrees to pay to the SUPPLIER the meter connection/tap-on fee of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_as set out in the SUPPLIER's approved tariff. If the meter to be installed is more than fifty (50) feet from the main, then the USER also agrees to pay for the additional materials and labor costs associated with the longer connection.

For new connections, it is understood and agreed that the USER will pay for service beginning on the date the meter setting is in place, regardless of whether the USER meter has been installed, whether the USER is connected to the system, or whether the USER is utilizing any water from the system. The amount charged will depend upon any usage, but at no time be less than the minimum bill for the USER's appropriate customer classification.
