RULES AND REGULATIONS
I. It shall be the policy of the District to test each water meter at least once every 60 months, or more frequently if required by 807. KAR 5.066E, Section 17. In addition, upon request of any customer, the meter serving such customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within 12 months preceding the requested test; otherwise a charge of $\$ 2.00$ will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy within the limits of $2 \%$.

If a meter is inaccurate in excess of $2 \%$, whether upon periodic testing or upon requested testing, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter, and the adjustments shall be made in the customer's water bills as follows:

1. If the result of such tests shows an average error greater than $2 \%$ fast, the customer's bill for'the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. If the period during which the meter error existed cannot be determined, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one-half (1/2) of the elasped time since the last previous test, but in no event to exceed 12 months; provided however, that if time for the periodic test has overrun to the extent that $1 / 2$ of the time elasped since the last previous test exceeds 12 months thecrefandabha屯 beumadeowormoheh 2 months specified above, plus those months exceeding the periodic test period; provided, further, that such PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION refund may be limited to the 12 month period if failureofkentucky to make the periodic test was due to causes demendothe EFFECTVE control of the District.
