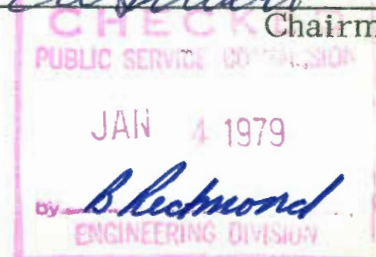

SECTION I

A. Rates for Water

Next - 1,000 gallons	\$3.25 per 1,000 gallons
Next - 3,000 gallons	\$2.90 per 1,000 gallons
Next - 4,000 gallons	\$2.00 per 1,000 gallons
Next - 15,000 gallons	\$1.75 per 1,000 gallons
Next - 25,000 gallons	\$1.50 per 1,000 gallons
All Over - 50,000 gallons	\$1.00 per 1,000 gallons

B. Where multiple service is rendered through one water meter, the minimum charge shall be multiplied by the number of apartments, residents, stores, offices and/or establishments receiving water from such meter. Each multiple service user shall be entitled to 2,000 gallons for a minimum charge. All excess over the minimum shall be billed at the appropriate rate.

Minimum Charge:

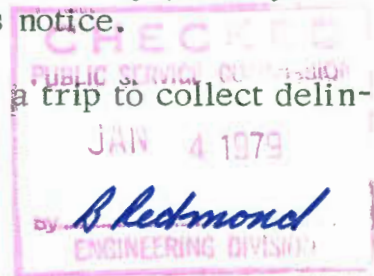
- A. A minimum charge of \$6.65 per month will be made, which entitles the consumer to 2,000 gallons of water or less.

Discount:

- A. No discount is allowed.

Billing:

- (N) A. Owners of real property or occupants of the premises served, and if occupant is not the owner of the real property, then both the occupant and owner of the real property served shall be liable for payment of all water charges.
B. Bills payable within ten (10) days; if not paid, deemed delinquent and penalty of ten percent (10%) added. After twenty (20) days, subject to cutoff after forty-eight (48) hours notice.
(N) C. \$7.50 service charge for employee to make a trip to collect delinquent bill.

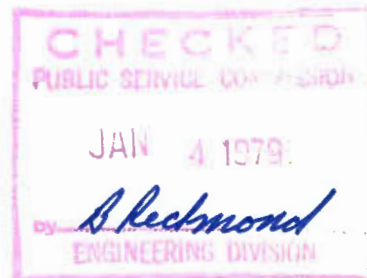

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- (N) A. Each owner of the real property being served, or the occupant of premises thereon, who desires service for said premises, shall file an application on forms provided by the District and pay the connection or service charges applicable for the service requested.
- (N) B. The applicant shall furnish information as follows:
1. Name of occupant;
 2. Mailing address of occupant;
 3. Location of real property being served;
 4. Name and mailing address of owner of real property being served;
 5. Type of service requested and number of units; and,
 6. Such other billing data as may be required on the forms supplied by the District.
- C. All taps and connections to the mains of the District shall be made by and/or under the direction and supervision of District personnel.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

D. Water service may be discontinued by the District for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service and especially for any of the following reasons:

1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
2. Failure to report to the District additions to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
3. Resale of water.
4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep in suitable state of repair.
5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves, or permitting such tampering by others.
6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separated water supply to premises which receive water from the District.
7. Non-payment of bills.

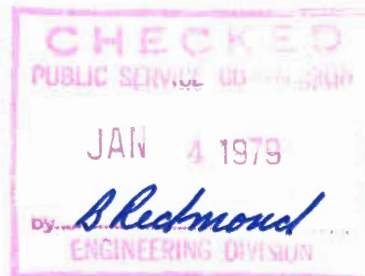

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

E. Any customer desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason shall give notice of discontinuance in writing at the business office of the District; otherwise, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered by the District until said notice is received by the District.

(T) F. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the Application for Water Service unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.

N) G. The rates and charges for water service as herein provided shall be billed to the owners of the real property or occupants of the premises served, and if the occupant of said premises being served is not the owner of the real property, then both the occupant of the premises and the owner of the real property served shall be liable for the payment of all charges for water service billed thereto.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

- (N) H. The water service rates and charges shall be billed monthly, and all bills for such services shall be payable within ten (10) days after rendition. If not paid as aforesaid within such ten-day period, said charges shall be deemed delinquent and a penalty of ten percent (10%) shall be added and shall be collected as a part of the bill. If a bill is not paid within twenty (20) days after rendition, the water district shall give at least forty-eight (48) hours' written notice, mailed to the last-known address of the occupant and to the owner of the real property as shown on the application for service, that water services to the premises shall be discontinued by a certain day for non-payment.
- (N) I. After written notice is given to an occupant or owner as provided for in Section H, above, it becomes necessary for an employee to make a trip to collect the delinquent bill, a charge of \$7.50 for each trip shall be assessed to the occupant or owner, if the bill is paid prior to disconnection.
- (N) J. When the Commission has discovered evidence that by fraudulent or illegal means the occupant or owner has obtained unauthorized service, or has diverted the service for unauthorized use, or has obtained service without same being properly measured, the service may be discontinued without notice. The Commission shall not restore service until the occupant or owner has complied with all rules of the utilities and regulations of the Commission, and the District has been reimbursed for the ~~estimated~~ amount of the service rendered and the cost incurred ~~by reason of the~~ fraudulent use, including the cost of removal and installation of water meters.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

- (N) K. The Commission shall, upon written request of the owner of the real property, direct all bills to the owner of the real property served or to the occupant of the premises. However, the owner of the real property shall be jointly liable for all delinquent bills, penalties, and unpaid charges for water service to the real property served. The District shall not be required to furnish water service to any real property served until all delinquent bills, penalties and unpaid charges are paid in full.
- (T) L. The District reserves the right to request in the future a deposit with the District for the purpose of establishing or maintaining any customer's credit, under regulations established by the Public Service Commission.
- M. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.
- (T) N. Upon written request of any customer, the meter serving said customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within twelve (12) months preceding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$4.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy within the limits of two percent (2%). If a meter is inaccurate in excess of two percent (2%), adjustments shall be made for such periods as set forth pursuant to the current rules and regulations adopted by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

- O. Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months' consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.
- P. The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruptions occur will endeavor to re-establish service with the shortest possible delay. When the service is interrupted all consumers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.
- (T) Q. The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the District may be deemed necessary.
- R. Customers having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the steam line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.

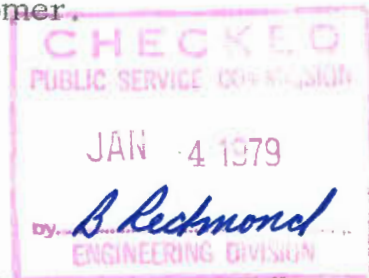

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

- S. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.
- T. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.
- U. The customer's service line shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the District rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.
- V. If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent or employee, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

- W. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell the water to any other person.
- (T) X. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the District a perpetual easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer where ever said easement or right-of-way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish service to the customer. The District shall at all reasonable hours have access to meters, service connections and other property owned by it and located on the customer's premises for the purpose of installation, maintenance, meter reading, operation or removal of its property at the time service is to be terminated.
- (T) Y. Customer complaints may be made in writing to the superintendent of the District. His decision may be appealed by the customer to the Commission within twenty (20) days thereafter.
- (N) Z. In situations wherein the above rules are not applicable, the current rules and regulations governing the service of water utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, shall govern.
