## RULES AND REGULATIONS

## SERVICE REQUIREMENTS.

- Application. Any person or other entity holding property having reasonable accessibility to the source of and who is in need of having water supplied to his place of occupancy or property may apply for service by U. S. 60 Water District ("District"). All customers shall sign such documents, including the contract for water service, as may be provided and required by the District, provided that no person or entity otherwise eligible shall be permitted to become a customer of the District if the capacity of the District's water system, either in general or as to a particular area or line, is exhausted by the needs of its existing customers.
- A tap-on fee of FOUR HUNDRED Tap-on Fees. В. (\$400.00) DOLLARS shall be made for each new meter installation where a 5/8 by 3/4 inch meter is used regardless of location. A tap-on fee of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS shall be made for each new meter installation where a one inch meter The tap-on fee is used regardless of location. for meters exceeding one inch shall be the actual cost incurred by the District in purchasing and installing that particular new meter.
