AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CDO 11.210(1)(2)(3), ORDINANCE NO. 1297, ORDINANCE NO. 1310, RELATING TO WATER RATES AND SEWER SURCHARGE RATES; AND CREATING A NEW SECTION IMPOSING UPON NON-RESIDENT INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS A SURCHARGE UPON THE SEWER SURCHARGE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it necessary and appropriate to make certain adjustments in the water, sewer and surcharge rates charged unto consumers so as to more fairly and equitably distribute the costs of production and operation among consumers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DANVILLE, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: CDO 11.210(1), as amended by Ordinance No. 1310, is amended to read as follows:

"(1) Effective on ~~August 1, 1982~~, August 1, 1985, there is hereby adopted, established and ordained, and there shall be collected a revised schedule of rates and charges for use of the services and facilities rendered by the municipal Waterworks and water Distribution System of Danville, Kentucky, except as otherwise provided by contract, as follows:

SECTION TWO: CDO 11.210(2), as amended by Ordinance No. 1297, is amended to read as follows:

"(2) Effective on ~~August 1, 1981~~, August 1, 1985, there is hereby adopted, established, and ordained, and there shall be collected, a schedule of rates and charges for use of the services and facilities rendered by the municipal Sanitary Sewage Collection Treatment and Disposal Facilities of the City of Danville, Kentucky, as follows:

MONTHLY SEWER SERVICE CHARGE FOR RESIDENTIAL
AND COMMERCIAL CONSUMERS

40% of the monthly water service bill rendered

MONTHLY SEWER SERVICE CHARGE FOR WHOLESALE
AND INDUSTRIAL CONSUMERS

50% ~~80%~~ of the monthly water service bill rendered; or by special agreement with the City in cases where all water used by the consumer is not returned to the sanitary sewer or where liquid sewage wastes are of unusual strength or composition, except that any such user which has an NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit shall be required to pay the sewer surcharge only on that portion of water returned to the sewer system; such user must have a sewage meter or some approved means of measuring the amount returned to the system and the City shall have the right to inspect the meter at all reasonable times, and may require the user to compile and maintain records containing pertinent data and information, which records shall be subject to inspection by the city and provided to the city upon request.

SECTION THREE: CDO 11.210(3) as amended by Ordinance No. 1310, is amended to read as follows:

"(3)(a) There is hereby imposed a non-resident surcharge of thirty (30%) ~~sixty (60%)~~ percent to be added to the total water bill (including the sewer surcharge), but less taxes, of all residential and commercial consumers outside the city limits of Danville, Kentucky, purchasing water from the City of Danville, Kentucky, filtered at the Danville City Water Works. There is hereby imposed a non-resident surcharge of twenty (20%) percent to be added to the total water bill (including the sewer surcharge), but less taxes, of all wholesale consumers outside the city limits

of Danville, Kentucky, purchasing water from the City of Danville, Kentucky, filtered at the Danville City Water Works.

SECTION FOUR: A new section designated as CDO 11.210(3)(b) is created to read as follows:

"(3)(b) There is hereby imposed a non-resident surcharge upon all industrial customers outside the city limits of Danville, Kentucky, purchasing water from the City of Danville filtered at the Danville City Water Works, which surcharge shall be equivalent to sixty (60%) percent of the 80% sewer surcharge imposed by CDO 11.210(2)."

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION SIX: If any section, sentence, clause, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason declared illegal, unconstitutional, or otherwise invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions hereof.
