WITNESSETH: That whereas, Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., is a Kentucky corporation engaged in the acquisition, treatment and distribution and sale of pure and potable water, and whereas, the City of Eubanks, Kentucky, has established a water distribution system for the purpose of furnishing an adequate supply of pure and potable water for its use in its district and the vicinity and environs thereof; and, whereas, the parties to this agreement have this date entered into a certain contract for the purchase of treated water; and whereas, the present and existing water lines of the Water Company do not extend to the proposed beginning point for the water lines of the City of Eubanks, Kentucky, but that said Water Company does have future plans for the construction of a water line to the point of the beginning of the water distribution system of the City of Eubanks, Kentucky, and whereas, it is necessary that Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., construct and install a water line or lines to said beginning point of the water distribution system of the City of Eubanks, Kentucky, and it is therefore PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY appropriate that this Contract now be consummated; EFFECTIVE

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants and undertakings herein described, the parties hereto covenant and agree, each with the other, as follows:

Section 1. Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., hereby covenants and agrees to construct and install 8 inch water main extension beginning at the existing water main of said Water Company on U. S. Highway #27, North of Somerset, Pulaski County, Kentucky, near the Southern States Coop Store along the right-of-way now owned by said Water Company to the point being known as Station 15.04 on the McKee Road, all as shown and designated on a certain plan for the extension of the water mains of the Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., dated June, 1971, a copy of which is annexed hereto and made a part of this contract in its entirety by reference to the same. Said construction shall be according to the plans and specifications as prepared by Howard K. Bell, Consulting Engineers, Lexington, Kentucky, and said water main shall be 8 inch water main and constructed of cast iron pipe.

Said water main shall be constructed in full compliance with regulations, standards and requirements of the Kentucky State Health Department and other public agencies having regulatory jurisdiction.

It is further agreed and understood that said Water Company will cause said construction to begin and become completed within six months from the date of this Contract.

Section 2. In consideration of the foregoing, the City of Eubanks, Kentucky, promises and agrees to pay unto the said Water Company as contribution toward the cost of construction of said water main by Water Company the sum of \$6,892.52. One-half of said sum of \$6,892.52 shall be paid to Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., on receipt by said Water Company of the materials needed for the construction and the remaining one-half of said sum shall be paid upon completion of said construction by the Water Company.

Section 3. It is further understood and agreed that the total footage for said water main construction shall be 1, 504 feet and running according to the plans hereinbefore specified.

Section 4. It is further agreed and understood that the Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., will own and maintain the water main so constructed.

Section 5. The effectiveness of this contract is subject to the awarding by the City of Eubanks of contracts for the construction of a waterworks distribution system.

The following is an estimate of the construction cost under our contract with Eslinger Contracting Company for an eight inch PVC water line from the system of Kentucky Water Service Company on U. S. Highway Number 27 near the Southern States Coop Building to the junction of U. S. 27 and McKee Road via the route over which Kentucky Water Service Company has already secured easement. A tabulation of bids for our project is enclosed with Eslinger's unit prices shown under "Contractor A".

Eslinger's price for 8 inch PVC Pipe is \$2.63 per lineal foot and 8 inch Gate valves are \$225.00 each. We have no price for 18 inch cover pipe, and boring for the railroad crossing but since the unit price of 15 inch is \$16.00 per foot and 12 inch is \$12.00 per foot, we can estimate that a unit price of \$20.00 per foot could be negotiated with Mr. Eslinger. We also have no unit price for 8 inch mechanical joint cast iron pipe for the railroad crossing, but on the basis of the prices listed on the tabulation of bids for 2 inch, three inch and four inch mechanical joint cast iron pipe in small quantities we can estimate the unit price to be \$6.00 per foot. Fittings and pavement repair are incidental under Eslinger's contract.

Therefore the estimated cost for this line is:

1,404' of 8" PVC Pipe x \$2.63 per foot = \$3,692.52 100' of 8" Mech. Jt. C. I. P. x \$6.00 per foot = \$600.00 85' of 18" Cover Pipe & Boring x \$20.00 per foot = \$1,700.00 4' of 8" Gate Valve & Box x \$225.00 each = \$900.00 Total Estimated Cost
