RULES AND REGULATIONS

Electric service is billed on the basis of energy charge and fuel cost adjustment. Member consumers living in certain counties may also pay a school tax or special assessment tax imposed by their local governments. N

A locked entrance, dog, or other problem may prevent the meter reader from reading the meter at times. The reading would then be estimated, based on the electricity previously used. When the reading is estimated, it will be noted on the bill. After the next actual reading, the bill will be adjusted automatically if the estimate was too high or too low. N

All electric statements are due when received and are delinquent after fifteen (15) days from the date of the statement. Failure to receive an electrical statement will not release the member from payment obligation.

5. COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 5.011, SECTION 9 (1)

Should it become necessary for the Cooperative to send a service representative to the member's premises for collecting a delinquent account, a charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be applied to the member's account for the extra service rendered, due and payable at time such delinquent account is collected. If service is disconnected for non-payment, an additional charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be added for reconnected service during regular working hours. If member requests reconnection after regular working hours, the charge will be forty dollars (\$40.00).

6. METER TAMPERING

If a meter or other property belonging to the cooperative is tampered or interfered with, the consumer being supplied through such equipment will be notified, and an investigation will be made. The consumer will be advised of the findings and will be given an opportunity for denial. If the investigation proves guilt, the consumer being supplied may be billed an amount which the cooperative may estimate is due for service rendered but not N

RULES AND REGULATIONS

16. DEPOSIT

The Cooperative may require a deposit not exceeding one-twelfth (1/12) of the estimated annual bill to secure payment of bills, except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. All deposits shall be based on actual usage of the customer at the same or similar premises for the most recent 12 month period, if such information is available. If usage information is not available, the deposit will be based on the average bills of similar customers and premises in the system. The deposit amount shall not exceed 1/12 of the customer's actual or estimated annual bill. Service may be refused or disconnected for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived for customers or previous customers who have established a satisfactory credit history, and required deposits will be returned after one year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The cooperative may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential
