## 16. DEPOSIT

The Cooperative may require a deposit not exceeding onetwelfth (1/12) of the estimated annual bill to secure payment of bills, except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. All deposits shall be based on actual usage of the customer at the same or similar premises for the most recent 12 month period, if such information is available. If usage information is not available, the deposit will be based on the average bills of similar customers and premises in the system. deposit amount shall not exceed 1/12 of the customer's actual or estimated annual bill. Service may be refused or disconnected for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived for customers or previous customers who have established a satisfactory credit history, and required deposits will be returned after one year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The cooperative may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based of KENTUCKY customer's actual usage.
