RULES	AND	REGULATIONS

This schedule of rules and regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving electric service from the Cooperative and applies to all service received from the Cooperative whether the service received is based upon a contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. No employee or individual director of the Cooperative is premitted to make an exception to rates or rules and regulations, which are on file at the Cooperative's offices and may be obtained there. All rules and regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations.

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Revisions

These rules and regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from time to time by Board of Directors. Such changes, when effective, shall have the same force as the present rules and regulations.

Service Area

The Cooperative furnishes all electric power supplied in Hancock County; all of the rural power in Daviess County with the exception of rural line which is owned and operated by the City of Owensboro; portions of the rural areas of McLean, Ohio. Hopkins, Henderson and Webster Counties.

The Cooperative's service area is bounded on the north by the Ohio River and the City of Owensboro; on the east by the Meade County R.E.C.C.; on the south at the Muhlenburg County Line and by the Kentucky Utilities Company, the Pennyrile R.E.C.C. and the Warren County R.E.C.C.; on the West by the Henderson-Union R.E.C.C.

Availability

Electric service is available to any domestic, commercial or industrial consumer within the system area provided the investment cost is consistent with good business practice.

In cases of farm service, the Cooperative will extend service at its regular minimum rate so long as the average revenues over the entire system will justify same, this practice being in accord with the area coverage principles recommended by REA and endorsed by the Board of Directors of the Cooperative.

In cases of commercial and/ or industrial consumers where excessive investments D to serve are required, a contract is negotiated for the minimum charge which mission based on longevity of the contract and the amount of investment required to serve.

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The consumer is not limited to service except as agreed upon by the consumer at the time service is rendered. For example, if a consumer requests service for 100 KW, facilities are provided for same, ascertaining that it will not affect service to other areas as a result of the load. If in the event a consumer requests twice this capacity, the Cooperative would request ample time to make a study of its facilities to determine that it could competently serve the additional load. As for limiting service on off-peak loads, it is requested, but not demanded, that oil companies using electric motors for pumping wells stagger their pumping hours where their total connected load exceeds 15KW for a single phase circuit.

All of the system's primary and distribution voltages on three phase lines is 12.5 KV Wye; secondary voltage on three phase lines are 120/240, 120/208, 240/480 and 277/480. Single phase lines are 7.2 KV; secondary voltages are 120/240 and 240/480.

Exceptional Cases

The usual supply of electric service shall be subject to the provisions of this tariff; but where special service-supply conditions or problems arise for which provision is not otherwise made, the Cooperative may modify or adapt its supply terms to meet the peculiar requirements of such cases.

Power failure

The Cooperative is responsible for power failure only when in control of the Cooperative employees. No member is paid damages for equipment unless such damage is specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the Cooperative or its employees.

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Cooperative's Right to Discontinue Service Without Notice

The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue the supply of electric service to any consumer or consumers without notice for any of the following reasons:

a. For fraudulent representation as to the use of electric service.

- b. For and disapproval of Consumer's equipment or installation on account of defects or hazardous conditions.
- c. For repairs or emergency operations.
- d. For unavoidable shortage or interruptions in the system's source of supply. PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION
- e. Whenever such action is necessary to protect Cooperative from fraud or abuse.

f. Upon cancellation of contract.

Consumer's Responsibility

Consumer's Liability

Consumer assumes full responsibility for service upon consumer's premises at and from the point of delivery thereof, and for wires, apparatus, devices and appurtenances thereon used in connection with service. Consumer shall indemnify, save harmless and defend the Cooperative against all claims, demands, cost or expense for loss, damage or injury to persons or property in any manner directly or indirectly arising from, connected with, or growing out of the transmission or use of current by consumer at or on consumer's side of point of delivery.

Protection of Consumer

Consumer shall protect the equipment of the Cooperative on his premises and shall not interfere with or alter or permit interference with or alteration of Cooperative's meters or other property except by duly authorized representatives of the Cooperative.

Any loss or damage to the property of the Cooperative due to, or caused by, or arising from, carelessness, neglect or misuse by consumer or other unauthorized persons, the cost of the necessary replacement and repairs shall be paid for by consumer.

Tampering

If the meters or other property belonging to the Cooperative are tampered or interferred with, the consumer being supplied through such equipment shall pay the amount which the Cooperative may estimate is due for service rendered but not registered on the Cooperative's meter, and for such replacements and repairs as are necessary, as well as for costs of inspection, investigation and protective installations.

Notice of Trouble

Consumer shall give immediate notice at the office of the Cooperative of any interruptions, or irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

Cooperative may at any time it deems necessary, suspend supply of electrical energy to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improved D ments upon any part of its system.

Cooperative shall make reasonable notice of such discontinuance to consumer. 9 1964

Resale of Service

GREEN RIVER RURAL EL

All purchased electric service on the premises of the consumer shall be supplied exclusively by the Cooperative, and the consumer shall not, directly or indirectly, sell, sublet, assign and otherwise dispose of, electric service, or any part thereof, without consent of the Cooperative.

Line Relocations

When necessary to move or relocate Cooperative's facilities for widening of Highways, rural or local roads, telephone lines, as well as for individuals and incorporates, any relocation or removal that involves a cost of more than \$25.00 shall be paid by said party or parties. An estimate of the cost is prepared and agreed upon between the Cooperative and authorized official or representative of party or parties desiring work to be done. With the exception of county road work in Cooperative service area, cost is based on labor, transportation, overhead and net material. The material cost is deleted from billing of county road work in Cooperative's service area.

This does not pertain to poles or other fixtures located on county or state rightsof-way, but only to such routes as are located on private property and on rightsof-way for which the Cooperative has legal instruments that they have procured for the purpose of constructing and operating its facilities.

Three-Phase Service

Consumers are required to negotiate a contract for all three phase service except as otherwise provided herein. Term of contract is determined by amount of investment required and usually ranges from one to five years.

Consumers classified as Commercial and Industrial receiving three phase service are billed on rates provided in IP Schedules as filed with the Public Service Commission.

Consumers classified as Farm, Non-Farm and Residential receiving three-phase service are billed on Farm, Non-Farm and Residential rate. However, the consumer will sign a contract providing necessary surety that they will purchase an annual amount of electricity equal to three percent per month of investment incurred in extending this service, this guaranteed usage of power to extend for a period of three years, after which the Cooperative's regular monthly minimum will apply. The member's present annual consumption may be applied against this requirement provided all consumption is measured through one meter. It should be noted that members commission using motors of less than 72 h.p. for chores are encouraged to use single phase service because the Cooperative's lines are adequate and the Board feels the the 1964 long run the member would be better off.

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Consumers classified as Schools, Churches, and Public Buildings receiving threephase service are billed on Schools, Churches and Community Halls rate.

Primary Metering

Green River Rural .

At any time the Cooperative finds it is more desirable, it may at its own option and expense install primary metering equipment. The consumer will own and operate all facilities past the metering point

Underground Service

Consumers desiring underground service from existing overhead service shall bear all cost in excess of normal cost of service.

Yard Light Service

Consumers desiring service for yard lighting are provided the unit on pole at a location suitable to both parties. This is not metered and consumer is charged rate as set forth in rate for "Mercury Vapor Lamps". The consumer signs an agreement to pay specified rate for a minimum period of one year. This agreement further specifies that the Cooperative will maintain the unit and replace lamp for a fee of \$10.00. Copy of agreement is included in rules and regulations.

Temporary Services

Single phase commercial accounts of temporary nature, including oil fields, coal mines, etc., require consumer to provide a non-refundable cash contribution toward construction, which is payable before construction begins. This contribution provides for investment cost on the following basis:

Cost of Construction and Subsequent Retirement Labor, overhead and cost of materials, plus one-half of construction labor and overhead for removal cost.

Less twenty percent of material estimated reusable upon retirement.

- 2. Transformers will be furnished by the Cooperative except where requirements are contrary to standard voltage, and in these cases the transformer cost will be considered as materials as referred to above.
- 3. Cooperative will retain ownership of these facilities and provide meressary K E D operations and maintenance of same. PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

No minimum is required other than that provided for in single phase commercial, 9 1964 rate. Copy of Agreement for Purchase of Power is included in rules and regula tions.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

For temporary seasonal farm loads to serve barns, farm wells, ponds, lakes etc., the consumer agrees in application for service to pay the minimum of \$1.25 per month for a continuous period of five years from date of installation.

Seasonal Loads

GREEN RIVER RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

Seasonal service shall be defined as service to anyone or any establishment which is of a temporary nature. A service charge will be made in the amount of \$2.50 for disconnecting and \$2.50 for reconnecting such service.

Summer cottages where a consumer desires service connected through the summer months and disconnected through the winter months is considered a seasonal load.

Any connect or disconnect which might apply for a period of less than one year is considered seasonal.

Electric Motors

Single phase motors larger than $7\frac{1}{2}$ horse power will not be permitted except by written permission from the Cooperative. When use of same is permitted, same shall be installed to use reduce voltage starting equipment.

Arc Welding Installations

Single phase high reactance arc welder installations being a source of trouble from a voltage regulation standpoint as well as general hindrance to good radio reception, necessitates the Cooperative, in best interest of the membership, to request arc welding equipment be operated from motor-generators only. Where the load exceed $7\frac{1}{2}$ h.p., these should be operated on either "V" phase or three phase connections.

Reconnecting and Disconnecting Existing Services

Upon request for service to be reconnected or disconnected, the Cooperative advises the consumer that the reconnection or disconnection will be made within 48 hours. Service will not be furnished to former consumers until any indebtedness to the system for previous service has been satisfied.

Separate Meter For Each Service

The Cooperative will normally furnish a single meter at the point of connection to the Consumer's premises. Any consumer desiring service at two on more separately metered points of connection to the system, shall be billed separately at eachission such point and the registrations of such meters shall not be added for billing purposes.

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effect. The Cooperative charges a \$2.00 meter test fee for consumers requesting a special test if the meter proves to be within two percent accuracy. The consumer signs a card agreeing on this charge before meter is removed for test. No other charges are made for meter-testing.

Meter Sockets

This will hold true in all cases Each consumer pays for his own meter socket. with the exception of cases where the Cooperative meters the primary side of a service.

In cases of single or three phase loads which are of such magnitude that current transformers are necessary, it will be the consumer's responsibility to furnish current transformers plus meter enclosure as recommended by Cooperative.

Contractors or prospective consumers may purchase their meter socket from the Cooperative at cost, plus a nominal handling charge, and the Cooperative will require minimum specifications on these sockets other than specifying manufacturer.

The contractor or member will pay for a socket if purchased from Cooperative when paying an inspection fee.

Inspection Fees and Wiring Inspections

The Consumer is charged \$3.50 for wiring inspection for all single phase and three phase installations with the exception of oil well installations, for which \$5.00 is charged. This exception is made due to the nature of the locations and time element involved in getting service to the location.

All wiring installations are inspected and approved according to National Electric Code before service is connected.

Application for Membership

- 3. The undersigned grants to the Corporation the necessary rights, privileges and easements to construct, operate, replace, repair and perpetually maintain on the property owned or occupied by the undersigned, and in or upon all roads, streets or highways abutting said property, its line or lines for the transmission or distribution of electric energy and will execute and deliver to the Corporation any conveyance, grant or instrument which the Corporation shall deem necessary or convenient for said purposes or any of them. All service lines supplying the undersigned with electric energy and all switches, meters and other appliances and equipment constructed or installed by the Corporation on said property, except so much thereof, if any, as shall be paid for by the undersigned, shall at all times be the sole property of the Corporation; and the Corporation shall have the right of access to said property to repair and service, and upon the discontinuance of service for any reason, to remove same.
- 4. The undersigned shall have all rights, and privileges granted to members under the Articles of Incorporation and bylaws of the Corporation or any amendments thereto and will comply with and be bound by such Articles of Incorporation and bylaws and all rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
- 5. The acceptance of this application by the Corporation shall constitute an agreement between the Corporation and the undersigned upon the terms here-inabove set forth.

Membership Fees and Consumer Deposits

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The Cooperative will not connect service until required membership fees and/or deposits are paid. Requirements are as follows:

- A. Industrial accounts will be handled on an individual basis.
- B. Commercial Accounts where the operator of any commercial business owns the E D property in which he operates the only consideration will be a \$5,00 Membercommission ship fee. However, if it is a rental proposition or lease, the commercial consumer will pay a \$5,00 membership fee plus a \$25,000 deposit.
- C. Farm, Non-Farm and Residential control be necessary that all members of this classification pay a \$5.00 membership fee. If in the event the property is

- owned by the person desiring service no further deposit will be required. In the event the person occupying the premises is a renter, a \$5.00 deposit will be required in addition to the membership fee.
- D. In case of trailers and other itinerant consumers, the consumer will in all cases make a \$10.00 deposit in addition to membership fee. The consumer will defray the cost of the labor plus cost of retirement in extending service to them. This does not apply for temporary service where a dwelling is being erected, nor for a mobile home where consumer has purchased land and made improvements.
- E. Signs in cases of sign lighting, if it is an established firm, no deposit of any nature will be required except membership fee.

Only one membership fee shall be required for each property owner. The membership fee or consumer deposit shall be refunded if all financial obligations are paid, or shall be applied against any unpaid bills of the member at the time service is discontinued. This will automatically terminate the membership.

Classification of Consumers

Classification of Consumers for accounting purposes are in accordance with prescribed REA Manual of Accounts.

Meter-Reading, Billing and Collecting

All meters with demand devices are read by Cooperative. Other meters are read by Cooperative on a staggered time basis. Cooperative provides space on billing statement for consumer to record meter-reading at other times. The meter-reading is returned to Cooperative at time payment is made and reading is used for next billing.

Billing is prepared on basis of rates approved by Board of Directors and Public Service Commission.

Due to use of rate deck with IEM accounting machine, the Cooperative has since May, 1963 used the following method for billing kilowatt hours used for single phase billing where no demand charge is in effect: To 500 kilowatt hours used E D monthly, prevailing rate is figured on each number of kilowatt hours. SEAftherOMMISSION 500, rate is figured on every ten kilowatt hours; for example: any consumer using from 770 to 779 kilowatt hours is billed on 775 rate base. If the billing is for a period less than half a month for minimum users, the first month's billing is carried forward and billed on next month. In the event payment for electric service has not been paid by due date, the consumer will be mailed a notice of the Cooperative's intention to discontinue electric service unless the account is paid by a specified date, seven days hence. If the account is not paid by this specified date, a representative of the Cooperative will visit the consumer's premises to discontinue the electric service. If the consumer desires to pay the account to the employee at that time, he will be charged the amount due for electric service plus a \$2.50 service charge. In the event service is disconnected, an additional \$2.50 service charge will be made for reconnection. The amount due, plus \$5.00 will have to be paid before service is reconnected.

Failure to receive bill does not relieve consumer from his obligation to pay bill by due date.

Budget Billing

Consumers using electricity for home heating have an opportunity to sign agreement with the Cooperative for spreading billing evenly over a 12 month period. The billing is based on an estimated consumption made by a Cooperative representative. At the *C* end of the 12 month period the difference between payments and actual use is adjusted by adding or crediting the difference on the regular electric service bill. Copy of agreement is made a part of rules and regulations.

Assignment

Subject to the Rules and Regulations, all contracts made by the Cooperative shall be binding upon, and oblige, and inure to the benefit of, the successors and assigns, heirs, executors, and administrators, of the parties thereto.

No Prejudice of Rights

Failure by the Cooperative to enforce any of the terms of this tariff shall not be deemed as a waiver of the right to do so.

- 1. Cooperative will furnish and install at no expense to the member a yard lighting unit on a thirty foot pole at a location suitable to both parties; will make all necessary electrical connections and will furnish electricity for same which shall be controlled by a photo cell to energize the unit.
- 2. Cooperative will maintain the unit and will replace the lamp at a flat fee of \$10.00 each. (Lamp replacement will be made free unless bulb is broken. In which case consumer will pay \$10.00)
- 3. The member hereby agrees to furnish the location for the unit; to permit any tree trimming required for the conductors or unit installation and will pay for the foregoing service at the rate of \$36.00 per year; to be paid at rate of \$3.00 per month, which will be added to monthly electric bill.
- 4. The member further agrees that the unit, together with the poles and conductors may be removed at any time by the Cooperative upon failure to pay the charges set forth herein.
- 5. Further, the member agrees to protect the unit from damage so far as said member is able.
- 6. It is mutually agreed that the unit as installed remains the property of the Cooperative and will be removed at the request of the member. The minimum such period shall be one year for which member agrees to pay as set forth herein. Date ______ Green River Rubau Electri
