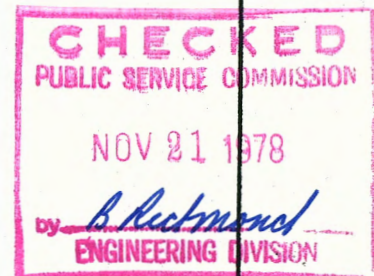

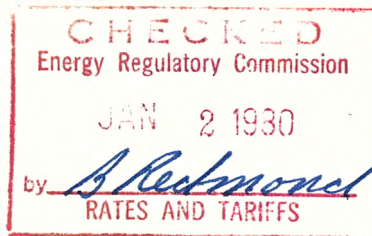

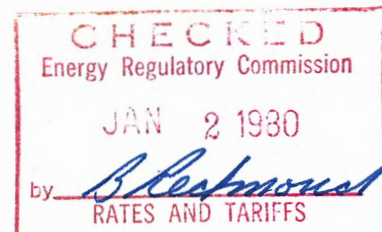

I In the event payment for electric service has not been received by subsequent month due date, the consumer will be mailed a notice of the Corporation's intention to discontinue electric service unless the account is paid by a specified date, seven days hence. If the account is not paid by this specified date, a representative of the Corporation will visit consumer's premises to discontinue electric service. If the consumer desires to pay the account to the employee at that time, he will be charged the amount due for electric service plus a \$5 service charge. In the event service is disconnected, an additional \$5 service charge will be made for reconnection. The amount due, plus \$10 will have to be paid before service is reconnected.

Failure to receive bill does not relieve consumer from his obligation to pay bill by due date.

BUDGET BILLING

Consumers using electricity for home heating have an opportunity to sign agreement with the Corporation for spreading billing evenly over a 12-month period. The billing is based on an estimated consumption made by a Corporation representative. At the end of the 12-month period the difference between payments and actual use is adjusted by adding or crediting the difference on the regular electric service bill. Copy of agreement is made a part of Rules and Regulations.

ASSIGNMENT

Subject to the Rules and Regulations, all contracts made by the Corporation shall be binding upon, and oblige and inure to the benefit of, the successors and assigns, heirs, executors and administrators of the parties thereto.

NO PREJUDICE OF RIGHTS

Failure by the Corporation to enforce any of the terms of this tariff shall not be deemed as a waiver of the right to do so.

TAXES

Pursuant to the authority vested in KRS-139.210, there shall be added to the bill of all applicable subscribers the Kentucky Veterans Bonus Sales and Use Tax imposed by KRS-139.200. The Utility Gross Receipts License Tax for schools authorized by KRS-160.613 shall be added to all applicable subscriber bills in accordance with KRS-160.617, which authorizes a rate increase for the school tax.
