10. RECONNECTION CHARGES

The Cooperative will make only one service connection without charge for the same consumer at the same location. After the original no-charge connection is made, subsequent reconnections will carry a \$5.00 reconnection charge. In the event a reconnection would be made after working hours the charge therefor will be \$10.00.

11. RESALE OF POWER BY MEMBERS

All purchased electric service used on the premises of the member shall be supplied exclusively by the Cooperative and the member shall not directly or indirectly sell, sublet, or otherwise dispose of the electric service or any part thereof.

12. SERVICE CALLS

If a member or customer makes a request for a service call from the Cooperative to do special work on their premises or equipment other than the Cooperative's property, a minimum charge of \$5.00, plus 10¢ per mile, plus the hourly rate of employees applicable at time such request is made (regular or overtime), and be it further known that the Cooperative is not liable or responsible in any way for work done on member or customer's premises for said service calls.

13. UNDERGROUND SERVICE

Underground service to new homes will be furnished by the Cooperative upon request provided the owner, at his expense, opens and closes the trench from the pole to the point of meter location in accordance with the specifications hereinafter set out. Underground services to existing homes will be installed under the provisions of this policy.

14. MEMBER SERVICE EXTENSIONS

It is the desire and intention of the Cooperative to make service available to all persons and property within the Cooperative's operating area consistent with sound economy and good management. In some instances members have requested service to barns and field water systems which in most cases is a seasonal load and extension may run 2500 feet or more. To make this type of extension feasible extensions will be built to barns and field water systems only on a five-year contract which shall be signed by the owner of the property. The maximum distance of the extension will be 500 feet for the regular existing monthly minimum and extensions in excess of 500 feet

shall have the monthly minimum increased at the rate of fifteen cents (15¢) per 100 feet. Members who pay a higher minimum will be entitled to use the corresponding number of kilowatt hours in accordance with the Farm and Home Service Rate.

C. Meters

15. METER TESTS

All new meters shall be checked for accuracy before installation. The Cooperative will, at its own expense, make periodical tests and inspections of its meters in order to maintain a high standard of accuracy and to conform with the regulations of the Public Service Commission. The Cooperative will make additional tests of meters at the request of the member provided the member does not request such test more than once in twelve (12) months and upon payment of a fee of Four Dollars (\$4.00) paid in advance. When the test made at the member's request shows that the meter is accurate within 2% slow or fast, no adjustment will be made to the member's bill and the fee paid will be forfeited to cover cost of requested test. When the test shows the meter to be in excess of 2% fast or slow, an adjustment shall be made to the member's bill for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months and the cost of testing the meter found to be inaccurate will be borne by the Cooperative and the Four Dollars (\$4.00) fee paid by the member will be refunded.

16. FAILURE OF METER TO REGISTER

Name of Officer

In the event a member's meter should fail to register, the member shall be billed from the date of such failure at the average consumption of the member based on the three (3) month period immediately preceding the failure.

17. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY COOPERATIVE

The Cooperative may refuse to connect or discontinue service to a member for the violation of any of its rules and regulations. The Cooperative may discontinue service to a member for the theft of current or the appearance of current-theft devices on the premises of the member. The discontinuance of service by the Cooperative for any cause stated in this rule does not release the member of his obligation of all bills due.
