RULES AND REGULATIONS

5. RELOCATION OF LINES BY REQUEST OF MEMBERS

In the event the Cooperative is asked to move an existing line for the construction of buildings or other reasons, the member shall be billed for construction and retirement costs involved.

B. Service Procedures

6. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

Each prospective member desiring electric service will be required to sign the Cooperative's form, "Application for Membership and for Electric Service," before service is supplied by the Cooperative and provide the Cooperative with necessary easements or right-of-way permits.

7. MEMBERSHIP FEE


The membership fee in the Corporation shall be \$5.00. One membership must be held for each service connection. An additional fee of \$5.00 shall be paid for each additional connection requested by the member. The membership fee will be refunded if all bills are paid or applied against any unpaid bills of the member at the time service is discontinued, which will automatically terminate the membership. Service covered by each membership shall be metered and billed separately.

8. RIGHT OF ACCESS

The Cooperative's identified employees shall have access to member's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of reading meter, testing, repairing, removing, or exchanging any and all equipment belonging to the Cooperative. The members of the Cooperative shall grant to it, easement over land owned by them for the distribution lines of the Cooperative, without charge to the Cooperative.

9. MEMBER'S DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Any member desiring service discontinued or changed from one location to another shall give the Cooperative notice in person or in writing provided such notice does not violate contractual obligations.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

10. RECONNECTION CHARGES

The Cooperative will make only one service connection without charge for the same consumer at the same location. After the original no-charge connection is made, subsequent reconnections will carry a \$5.00 reconnection charge. In the event a reconnection would be made after working hours the charge therefor will be \$10.00.

11. RESALE OF POWER BY MEMBERS

All purchased electric service used on the premises of the member shall be supplied exclusively by the Cooperative and the member shall not directly or indirectly sell, sublet, or otherwise dispose of the electric service or any part thereof.

12. SERVICE CALLS

If a member or customer makes a request for a service call from the Cooperative to do special work on their premises or equipment other than the Cooperative's property, a minimum charge of \$5.00, plus 10¢ a mile, plus the hourly rate of employees applicable at time such request is made (regular or overtime), and be it further known that the Cooperative is not liable or responsible in any way for work done on member or customer's premises for said service calls.

13. UNDERGROUND SERVICE

Underground service to new homes will be furnished by the Cooperative upon request provided the owner, at his expense, opens and closes the trench from the pole to the point of meter location in accordance with the specifications hereinafter set out. Underground services to existing homes will be installed under the provisions of this policy.

14. EXTENSIONS FOR SEASONAL LOADS

It is the desire and intention of the Cooperative to make service available to all persons and property within the Cooperative's operating area consistent with sound economy and good management. Extensions will be built to barns, to field water systems and to other seasonal loads only on a five-year contract which shall be signed by the owner of the property. The maximum distance of the extension will be 1,000 feet for the regular existing monthly minimum.

For extensions greater than 1,000 feet from the nearest facility, the

D. Consumer Equipment

18. POINT OF DELIVERY

The point of delivery is the point as designated by the Cooperative on member's premises where current is to be delivered to building or premises, namely the weatherhead. All wiring and equipment beyond this point of delivery shall be supplied and maintained by the member. The consumer shall pay for additional installation in advance. The member will, however, notify the Cooperative of any proposed changes in his equipment or wiring which will materially increase or decrease his load so the Cooperative may check its equipment to make certain it will accommodate the consumer's load requirement.

19. CONSUMER'S WIRING

All wiring of the member must conform to Cooperative's requirements and accepted modern standards. The member agrees to construct its facilities in accordance with specifications at least equal to those prescribed by the National Electrical Safety Code and the National Electric Code. The Cooperative, however, assumes no responsibility in respect to the type, standard of construction, protective equipment or the condition of the member's property, and will not be liable for any loss or injury to persons or property occurring on the premises or property of the member. The member agrees to operate and maintain its facilities so as not to interfere with the service of the Cooperative to its other members. The member will have complete responsibility for all construction, operation, and maintenance beyond the meter and will save the Cooperative harmless against liability for injury or damages resulting in any manner from construction, location, operation, or maintenance of the member's facilities.

20. INSPECTIONS

Cooperative shall have the right to inspect, but shall not be obligated, any installation before electricity is introduced or at any later time, and reserves the right to reject any wiring or appliances not in accordance with Cooperative's standards but such inspection or failure to inspect or reject shall not render Cooperative liable or responsible for any loss or damage resulting from defects in the installation, wiring, or appliances, or from violation of Cooperative's rules or from accidents which may occur upon member or customer's premises.

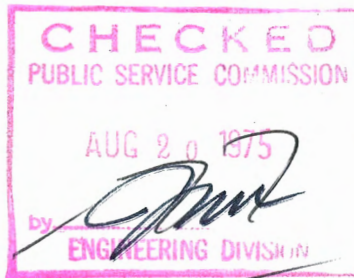

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Power factor may be measured at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the per cent power factor.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges:

- (a) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
- (b) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA per month of contract capacity.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE:

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month. *ES*

All wiring, pole, lines, and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

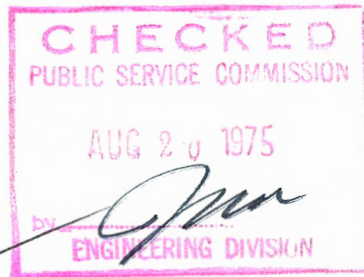
2. Lighting. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate.

3. Primary Service. If service is furnished at 7200/12470 volts or above, a discount of 5% shall apply to the Demand and Energy charges.
