### 5. RELOCATION OF LINES BY REQUEST OF MEMBERS

In the event the Cooperative is asked to move an existing line, poles, guys and/or anchors for the construction of buildings or other reasons no charge will be made if an additional meter is installed on the new building; if for any other reason, the member shall pay the total cost.

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B. Service Procedures

# 6. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

Each prospective member desiring electric service will be required to sign the Cooperative's form, "Application for Membership and for Electric Service", before service is supplied by the Cooperative and provide the Cooperative with necessary easements or right-of-way permits.

### 7. MEMBERSHIP FEE

The fee for membership in the Corporation shall be \$25 for all new memberships after April 30, 1977. All memberships can be transferred from one location to another by the member. The membership fee will be refunded when all bills are paid or applied to any unpaid bills of the member at the time service is discontinued, which will automatically terminate the membership.

### 8. RIGHT OF ACCESS

The Cooperative's identified employees shall have access to member's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of reading meter, testing, repairing, removing, or exchanging any and all equipment belonging to the Cooperative. The members of the Cooperative shall grant to it, easement over land owned by them for the distribution lines of the Cooperative, without charge to the Cooperative.

### 9. MEMBER'S DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Any member desiring service discontinued or changed from one location to another shall give the Cooperative notice in person or in writing provided such notice does not violate contractual obligations.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

Cooperative will charge an advance payment equal to the reasonable costs incurred by it for that portion of the service beyond 1,000 feet.

(a) This advance payment shall be refunded over a 10-year period only if additional connections are made on this line. Refunds will be prorated based on the amortization of the customer's investment over a 10-year period.

If the service is discontinued for a period of 60 days, the remainder of the advance payment shall be forfeited.

# 15. METER TESTS

All new meters shall be checked for accuracy before installation. The Cooperative will at its own expense, make periodical tests and inspections of its meters in order to maintain a high standard of accuracy and to conform with the regulations of the Public Service Commission. The Cooperative will make additional tests of meters at the request of the member provided the member does not request such test more than once in twelve (12) months and upon payment of a fee of Four Dollars (\$4.00) paid in advance. When the test made at the member's request shows that the meter is accurate within 2% slow or fast, no adjustment will be made to the member's bill and the fee paid will be forfeited to cover the cost of requested test. When the test shows the meter to be in excess of 2% fast or slow, an adjustment shall be made to the member's bill for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months and the cost of testing the meter found to be inaccurate will be borne by the Cooperative and the Four Dollars (\$4.00) fee paid by the member will be refunded.

#### 16. FAILURE OF METER TO REGISTER

In the event a member's meter should fail to register, the member shall be billed from the date of such failure at the average consumption of the member based on the three (3) month period immediately preceding the failure.

#### 17. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY COOPERATIVE

The Cooperative may refuse to connect or discontinue service to a member for the violation of any of its rules and regulations. The Cooperative may discontinue service to a member for the theft of current or the appearance of current-theft devices on the premises of the member. The discontinuance of service by the Cooperative for any cause stated in this rule does not release the member of his obligation of all bills due.

## 21. BILLING AND COLLECTION POLICY

Members will receive statements for electric service on the first day of each month for service rendered for a thirty-day period ending the fifth of the preceding month. All statements are due and payable upon receipt and shall be paid at the office of the Cooperative within ten (10) days from the first of the month. Failure to receive electrical statement will not release the member from payment obligation. Should the statement not be paid, within the limits prescribed by the Kentucky Energy Regulatory Commission, service may be discontinued.

A \$10,00 fee will be charged for the purpose of collecting a delinquent account in conformance with the rules set by the Energy Regulatory Commission.

No consumer is to be reconnected at any location without first having paid all previous indebtedness to the Cooperative.

### METER READING 22.

Each member receiving service will be required to supply the Cooperative with the reading of each meter on the form as furnished by the Cooperative, on such date as designated by the Cooperative. Readings not received on time will be estimated. On the third consecutive estimate, an employee of the Cooperative will read the meter and \$ 10.00 service charge may be added to esuch member's account.

### 23. UNPAID CHECKS FROM CONSUMERS

When a check received in payment of a consumer's account is returned unpaid by the bank for any reason, the Cooperative will notify such consumer by letter stating the amount of the check and the reason for its return. Returned checks will be considered same as a delinquent account.

In the event a consumer pays by check which is returned by the bank, for each additional returned check within each twelve(12)-month period, an added charge of \$5.00 will be made to cover collection costs. If it becomes necessary to make a collection trip, an additional \$10.00 charge will be made.

When the test is made at the member's request shows that the meter is accurate, within 2% slow or fast, no adjustment will be made to the member's bill and the fee paid will be forfeited to help cover cost of the requested test. When the test shows the meter to be in excess of 2% slow or fast appropriate adjustments will be made to the member's bill. Refunds will be made in accordance with Energy Regulatory Commission's Rules and Regulations (807 KAR 50:015 Section 9 (5). If the test shows the meter to be more than 2% fast the \$10.00 fee paid by the member shall be refunded.

## 18. FAILURE OF METER TO REGISTER

In the event a member's meter should fail to register, the member shall be billed from the date of such failure at the average consumption of the member based on the three-month period immediately preceding the failure.

# 19. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY COOPERATIVE

The cooperative may refuse to connect or discontinue service to a member for the violation of any of its rules and regulations. The cooperative may discontinue service to a member for the theft of current or the appearance of a current-theft device on the premises of the member. The discontinuance of service by the cooperative for any cause stated in this rule does not release the member of his obligation of all bills due.

### 20. THREE PHASE SERVICE

Consumers are required to negotiate a contract for all three-phase service except as otherwise provided herein. Term of contract is determined by amount of investment required.
