Should such measurements indicate that the power factor of the consumer at the time of his maximum demand is less than 80% the consumer agrees, upon sixty (60) days' written notice to correct such power factor to 80%.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, or by order of the Public Service Commission, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the amount per KWhr. of sales by the Seller equal to the dollar amount of the fuel clause adjustment in the Cooperative's wholesale power cost for the next preceding month.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.00 per horsepower or fraction thereof per month for the first ten (10) horsepower of the connected load and 75¢ per horsepower or fraction thereof per month for all connected load in excess of the ten (10) horsepower. But in no case shall the minimum charge be less than \$25.00 per month.

3. All wiring, pole lines, wires, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, exclusive of the service transformers and protective equipment, is considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.

4. In those cases where additional investment is required for three-phase service, it will be rendered only after the following conditions are met:

- (a) The consumer will give satisfactory assurance by means of a written agreement as to the character, amount, and duration of the business offered.
- (b) The consumer will guarantee a minimum monthly bill for the three-phase service which will be computed on the basis of any additional investment including the additional cost of any transformers and other equipment necessary to make three-phase service available. The minimum bill will be effective for a period of time designated in the written agreement from the date of which service commences under (a) above.
- (c) In no case, however, will the minimum bill for three-phase service be less than the previously specified "Minimum Monthly Charge".

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of thirty (30) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

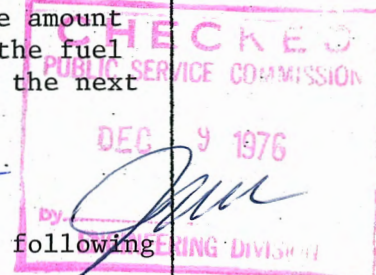
POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as is practicable. Demand charge will be adjusted for average power factors lower than 90.%. Such adjustment will be made by increasing the measured demand 1.% for each 1.% by which the average power factor is less than 90.% lagging.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

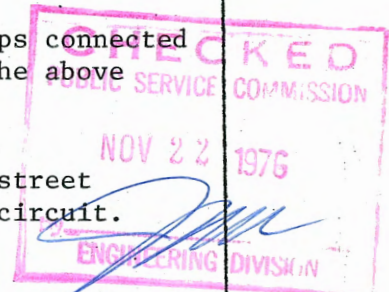

3. Service will be furnished for future additional lamps to existing overhead secondary circuits in accordance with the charges above.

Henderson-Union RECC will extend facilities up to 1000 feet at its regular minimum rate, providing applicant makes improvements and occupies mobile home. Subject to the provision of PSC: 807-KAR 2:050 Electric, Section 10, all applicants for service in excess of 1000 feet, will be required to make a contribution in aid of construction equal to the total estimated cost of installation, exclusive of special equipment, (transformers - meters). (N)

For those mobile home applicants requesting service whereby improvements have not been made or home will not be occupied, the following policy shall apply: (N)

- (1) All extensions of up to 150 feet from the nearest facility shall be made without charge. (N)
- (2) Extensions greater than 150 feet from the nearest facility and up to 300 feet shall be made provided the customer shall pay the utility a "customer advance for construction" of fifty dollars (\$50) in addition to any other charges required by the utility for all customers. This advance shall be refunded at the end of one (1) year if the service to the mobile home continues for that length of time. (N)
- (3) For extensions greater than 300 feet and less than 1,000 feet from the nearest facility, the utility may charge an advance equal to the reasonable costs incurred by it for that portion of the service beyond 300 feet plus fifty dillars (\$50). Beyond 1,000 feet the extension policies set forth in paragraph 1 apply. (N)

- (d) In cases of mobile home trailers, the consumer will in all cases pay a \$5.00 membership fee. If consumer does not own property, a \$5.00 prepayment in addition to the \$5.00 membership fee is required. No connect fee is charged if it is a new connect.

Mobile home owners have the option of being supplied a standard 50 amp. plug-in type service for \$40.00 or a 100 amp. plug-in type service for \$60.00, (I) including material and labor. This is being done in order to facilitate mobile home owners in a quick hook-up, but this will not be done until the \$40 or \$60 is paid. Inspection is required on all wiring done by applicant or his electrician. A regular hook-up can be used in lieu of the quick hook-up.

- (e) Signs - in cases of sign lighting, if it is an established firm, no deposit of any nature will be required except membership fee.

Only one membership shall be required for each service. The membership fee or consumer prepayment shall be refunded if all financial obligations are paid, or shall be applied against any unpaid bills of the member at the time service is discontinued. This will automatically terminate the membership.

10. RIGHT OF ACCESS

The cooperative's identified employee shall have access to member's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of reading meter, testing, repairing, removing, or exchanging any and all equipment belonging to the cooperative.

11. NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice at the office of the cooperative of any interruptions, or irregularities, or unsatisfactory service, and of any defects known to consumer. Cooperative may at any time it deems necessary, suspend supply of electrical energy to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes, or improvements upon any part of its system. Cooperative shall make reasonable notice of such discontinuance to consumer.
