of electric energy, but should supply fail or be interrupted through act of God, the public enemy, by accident, strikes, labor troubles, by action of the elements, or by any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the cooperative, the cooperative shall not be liable therefor.

6. RELOCATION OF LINES BY REQUEST OF MEMBERS

The cooperative's established lines will not be relocated unless the expense for moving and relocating is paid by the member, except in instances where it would be to the advantage of the cooperative to make such relocation.

7. SERVICES PERFORMED FOR MEMBERS

The cooperative's personnel is prohibited from making repairs or performing services to the members' equipment or property except in cases of emergency or to protect the public or member's person, or property. When such emergency services are performed the member shall be charged for such service at the rate of time and material.

Service Procedures

APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

Each prospective member desiring electric service will be required to sign the cooperative's form "Application for Membership and for Electric Service" before service is supplied by the cooperative and provide the cooperative with necessary easements or right-of-way permits.

9. The cooperative will not connect any service until the required membership fee, plus any required deposits are paid. Requirements are as follows:

- (a) Industrial accounts will be handled on an individual basis.
- (b) Commercial accounts - the consumer will pay a \$25.00 membership fee.
- (c) Farm, Non-farm, & Residential - it will be necessary that all members of this classification pay a \$25.00 membership fee.
- (d) In cases of mobile home trailers, the consumer will in all cases pay a \$25.00 membership fee.

For those mobile home applications requesting service the following policy shall apply:

Availability

This schedule is available to primary aluminum smelters within the service territory of Henderson-Union Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Henderson-Union"). This schedule only covers purchases for primary aluminum reduction and associated administrative facilities. It does not cover purchases for later resale or use in fabrication.

TERMS OF THE RATE

This rate schedule shall take effect at 12:01 a.m., September 1, 1987 and shall terminate at midnight August 31, 1997. The rate schedule shall be subject to two reviews, commencing July 1, 1988 and July 1, 1990, as provided for in the August 10, 1987, Order in Case No. 9885, and such other reviews as may from time to time be established by the Public Service Commission. Upon termination of this rate schedule, the wholesale rates applicable to nonsmelter customers shall apply to the aluminum smelters.

Week, in cents per pound.

2. Changes in Aluminum Price Indicators

In the event that Big Rivers Electric Corporation determines that factors outside its control have rendered Section VI.A.1. unusable as an approximation of the U. S. market price for aluminum, Big Rivers Electric Corporation shall develop and submit to the appropriate regulatory bodies a substitute indicator for determining the Monthly Billing Aluminum Price.

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The energy charge shall be increased or decreased by a fuel adjustment factor as follows:

Fossil fuel consumed in Big Rivers' own plants, and Big Rivers' share of fossil and nuclear fuel consumed in jointly owned or leased plants, plus the cost of fuel which would have been used in plants suffering forced generation and/or transmission outages, but less the cost of fuel related to substitute generation, plus
 - b. The actual identifiable fossil and nuclear fuel cost associated with energy purchased for reasons other than identified in paragraph (c) below, but excluding the cost of fuel related to purchases to substitute the forced outages, plus
 - c. The net energy cost of energy purchases, exclusive of capacity or demand charges (irrespective of the designation assigned to such transaction) when such energy is purchased on an economic dispatch basis. Included therein may be such costs as the charges for economy energy purchases and the charges as a result of scheduled outage, all such kinds of energy being purchased by the buyer to substitute for its own higher cost energy; and less
 - d. The cost of fossil fuel recovered through inter-system

e. All fuel costs shall be based on weighted average inventory costing.

4. Forced outages are all nonscheduled losses of generation or transmission which required (purchase of) substitute power for a continuous period in excess of six (6) hours. Where

forced outages are not as a result of faulty equipment, faulty manufacture, faulty design, faulty installations, faulty operation or faulty maintenance, but are Acts of God, riot, insurrection or acts of the public enemy, then the utility may, upon proper showing, with the approval of the Commission, include the fuel cost of substitute energy in the adjustment.

5. Sales (s) shall be all KWHs sold, excluding inter-system sales. Where, for any reason, billed system sales cannot be coordinated with fuel costs for the billing period, sales may be equated to the sum of (i) generation, (ii) purchases, (iii) interchange in, less (iv) energy associated with pumped storage operations, less (v) inter-system sales referred to in subsection (3) (d) above, less (vi) total system losses. Utility-used energy shall not be excluded in the determination of sales (s).

6. The cost of fossil fuel shall include no items other than the invoice price of fuel less any cash or other discounts. The invoice price of fuel includes the cost of the fuel itself and necessary charges for transportation of the fuel from the point of acquisition to the unloading point, as listed in Account 151 of FERC Uniform System of Accounts for Public Utilities and Licensees.
