**CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE**

**Rural and Urban Extension Plans**

**RATE PER UNIT**

**I. For Residential and Small Commercial Applicants**

A. Extensions and services will be constructed when funds, equipment, system capacity and personnel are available, to serve any applicant in above category anywhere within the electric system's service area subject to the following limitations:

1. Transformer and low voltage circuit capacity shall be limited to a maximum of 3 Kva per applicant.
2. Total average monthly revenue guarantee per mile of line required for any project shall not be less than \$18.00.
3. Individual extension mileage shall be limited to an average of 0.25 per mile per applicant.
4. Minimum Monthly Revenue Guarantee per applicant shall be not less than \$1.50 for 36 months or until average monthly revenue for entire system (Ky. and Tenn.) from above class of consumers shall exceed \$60.00 per mile of line in service whichever is later. (See definitions.)
5. All right-of-way shall be donated or furnished by consumer or by the property owners at no cost to Jellico Electric System.
6. Premise to be served must be of such nature as to be considered requiring permanent electric service.

B. Extensions and services for above class of applicants not qualifying under A above shall be constructed under the following conditions when funds, equipment, system capacity and personnel are available.

1. Where more than 3 Kva of transformer and low voltage circuit capacity is required per applicant such applicant shall be required to pay a monthly minimum bill above that specified in A above of \$0.50 per Kva of additional capacity required so long as the service is in use.

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2. Where the individual extension mileage exceeds 0.25 mi. per applicant the applicant or applicants shall contribute the difference between the total estimated cost of the extension and the estimated cost of 0.25 miles per applicant to be served from the extension. After actual cost of the extension is determined the contribution shall be adjusted to actual costs per above. Refunds shall be made to customers who have made contributions for construction as follows:

For each additional customer served from an extension for which a contribution was required the average miles of line per customer shall be re-determined and excess contribution if any, refunded to contributors in proportion to amount previously contributed.

3. Minimum Average Monthly Revenue Guarantee per mile and per applicant shall be as in A above except as amended by B-1 above.

4. For premise not meeting requirements of A-6 above applicant shall advance estimated amount of labor and transportation for installing and removing service if extension does not exceed 0.25 mi., said amount to be refunded at rate of 20% of annual billing.

**11. For Large Commercial and Industrial Applicants**

A. Extensions and Services will be constructed to serve such applicants anywhere within the Electric System's Service Area when equipment, personnel and system capacity are available subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant will be required to contract for service for a minimum period of one year except in cases of carnivals, road shows and other similar temporary installations which will be required to contract for service for a minimum period of one month.

Standard Street Lighting Rate - Schedule B-5.1

**RATE  
PER UNIT**

Applicable:

All territories served.

Availability of Service:

Available for street-lighting systems, including lighting, signal systems, and roadway and park lighting, for a term of not less than one year.

Type of Service:

Alternating current, either series or multiple system or in combination at option of Distributor, 120/240 volts.

Rates:

Energy charge: 4-5-6

First 250 kwh used per month @ .....	3¢ per kwh
Next 750 kwh used per month @ .....	2¢ per kwh
Next 1000 kwh used per month @ .....	1¢ per kwh
Excess over 2,000 kwh used per month @ .....	0.8¢ per kwh

Investment charge:

The annual investment charge (for the cost of operation, maintenance, taxes, and depreciation, and for return on investment) shall be 12 percent of the investment in the street-lighting system, determined as set forth below. Such charges shall be adjusted under the circumstances set forth below. This charge will be computed on July 1 of each year and one-twelfth of the total annual charge so computed will be billed customer monthly.

Method of Determining Distributor's Investment:

(1) The investment in property and equipment used as a basis for the investment charge contained in this schedule shall consist of the cost of such property and equipment, including the full amount shown in the Plant Account entitled "Street Lighting and Signal System." If any part of the street-lighting system has not been built at the expense of the Distributor, a deduction shall be made from the annual investment charge in the amount of 6 percent

(6%) of the investment in such part.

(2) If the cost of part of the street-lighting system operated by the electric department of Distributor is carried on the books of other municipalities or agencies or other municipal departments of Distributor, retirements and additions to such property will be made by the electricity department and charged to the department upon the books of which the cost of the property is reflected, or to the other agency owning such property. The investment charge applicable to this portion of the system will be 2 percent per year.

Delayed Payment Charge:

In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within 10 days from date of bill, the charge will be increased 10 percent (10%).

Special Rules:

(a) Distributor shall keep a record of the number and type of lamp replacement and customer shall be billed monthly for the replacements during the month at actual cost to Distributor, including appropriate overheads.

(b) Distributor shall at the request of the customer relocate or change existing equipment. Customer shall reimburse Distributor for such changes at actual cost, including appropriate overheads.

Metering:

(a) All energy consumed under this schedule shall be metered excepting installations where, in the opinion of Distributor, metering would be impracticable.

(b) When the consumption is metered, the meters shall be installed in or connected to the lighting circuit and the billing shall include the energy delivered to and consumed in all circuits and equipment used exclusively for street-lighting purposes. If more than one meter is used, the readings shall be consolidated for billing purposes.
