Service to Resort Developments

Developers may obtain primary electric service to groups of lots or complete areas of resort developments under the following conditions.

All facilities and appurtenances will be in accordance with cooperative requirements and prevailing regulations.

DEVELOPER WILL:

1. Pay a per lot contribution-in-aid of construction before construction to desired group of lots.
2. Provide a copy of the recorded plat of the resort subdivision.
3. Clear all right-of-way for said electric lines.
4. Provide necessary easements for said electric lines.
5. Provide lot line markers where electric lines can be installed in the most economical location.
6. Notify cooperative in August or September of each year of any permanent buildings in the subdivision.

TRI-COUNTY ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP WILL:

1. Install primary electric lines in sections as desired by the developer.
2. Retain ownership, maintain and service said electric lines.
3. Refund the per lot contribution-in-aid of construction on which a permanent residence is constructed. This must be a building with a permanent foundation to which state approved sanitary sewer facilities and water system are installed. No refunds are to be made after ten years from the date of this agreement.
4. Refund the money due only in the month of October.

The per lot contribution-in-aid of construction is determined by dividing the total estimated cost by the number of lots to be served.
