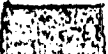

A. CONTINUOUSLY ENERGIZED SERVICE

The monthly kilowatt hour usage shall be subject to an adjustment per Kwh determined in accordance with the "Fuel Cost Adjustment" set forth in Sheet No. 38 of the Company's Electric Tariff, K.P.S.C. No. 3 or any revision thereof.

The Power Company shall deliver electrical energy for the operation of the flood pumps to the customer-owned substation of the 2nd Street-NWC Main Dayton Flood Pumping Station in the form of three phase, sixty hertz alternating current at approximately 12,470 volts. This service shall be energized at all times but is to be used only for the operation, testing and maintenance of the flood pumping units.

The City of Dayton shall operate the pumps for the purpose of testing only between the hours of 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. and from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. of the following day. These hours may be changed at the request of The Union Light, Heat & Power Company.

Electrical energy for the operation of the auxiliary equipment incident to the operation of the 2nd Street NWC Main-Dayton Flood Pumping Station shall be delivered by the Company to the City's service entrance on meter pole. Such service will be supplied 120/208 volt, three phase, furnished from the Power Company's overhead distribution circuit and will be billed on the Distribution Voltage Rate in effect from time to time.

The term of this contract shall be for one year, terminal thereafter on 120 days written notice by the City or the Company.
