ADDENDUM NO. 1

Kentucky Public Service Commission Rule X is modified and supplemented by Warren Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation Operating Policy No. 10, Revised January 1972, as herein stated:

OPERATING POLICY NO. 10

SUBJECT: Area Coverage and Other Conditions for Providing Electric Service

POLICY:

It is the objective of this organization to provide, without contribution, central station service to all standard unserved farms, homes and rural establishments within its service area at its basic minimum established rate schedule.

- A. The basic monthly minimum is \$2.50 for residential and commercial service.
- B. Any extension of Cooperative's facilities to provide permanent service shall require a minimum contract of one year's continuous service, with billing to start within thirty days after service is made available. The reconstruction of any facility where service has previously been retired because of inactive use shall be considered as a new service requiring a minimum contract of one year's continuous service.

Special Classified Service

4-24-73

- A. Electric service for other than standard residential, farm, and small commercial use shall be provided under conditions that will not seriously jeopardize the objective of the Cooperative of providing electric service for normal service usage. Services classified under this application include advertisement signs, barns, water wells, resort cottages (a resort cottage is defined as a residence not lived in as a permanent residence for at least nine months of the year), farms which are not regularly operated as such, and farm installations whose tenure of service may be considered indefinite.

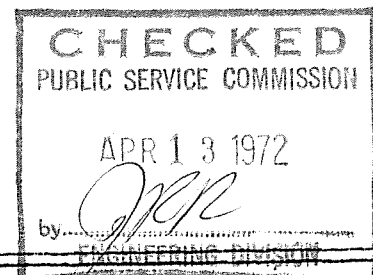

period provided the developer has given written notification of the refund due. After the end of the ten-year period, no refund shall be made.

- C. There shall be no increased minimum based on transformer capacity for single-phase service provided service is for normal loads and normal operation. However, a minimum monthly bill of 75¢ per KVA required transformer capacity may be applied to service of abnormally low annual load factors.
- D. Whenever service is reconnected to a classified service, it may be for a minimum period of twelve months' continuous service at the established minimum per month; or the consumer may elect to pay a \$15 service connection charge in which case the tenure of service may be for a minimum period of thirty days at the established minimum per month.
- E. Mobile Homes and Trailers -- See Policy No. 21.

The customer's bill for energy each month will be increased or decreased by 0.10 mill per kwh for each 0.10 mill or major fraction thereof by which TVA's fossil and nuclear fuel expense per kwh sold by TVA as determined by TVA from its records exceeded or was less than 1.45 mills, respectively, during the most recently completed fiscal year ending with June. Each adjustment made pursuant to this paragraph shall be effective for 12 consecutive monthly billings beginning with the first bill rendered from meter readings taken after August 1 of the calendar year in which each fiscal year ends, notwithstanding anything herein which might be construed to the contrary.

*For athletic field lighting, the energy charge is subject to Distributor's applicable surcharge.
