

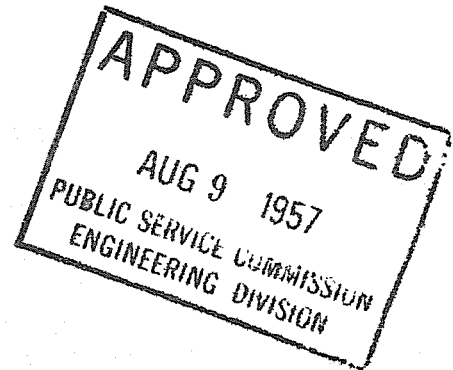

VII. This Cooperative accepts long distance telephone calls, from their members when they are reporting power failures, free of charge. There is a service crew on duty for such, and they are sent promptly, day or night, to restore electric service.

VIII. We have Coop. personnel to figure heat loads, either before or after a house is built, and they make free calls to assist our members with the use of their electric appliances or render what service they can.

POLICIES

- I. All new wiring is inspected by Coop. personnel. A \$3.25 inspection fee is required to pay the expense of the inspector. When a service entrance is changed, such as a third wire added for an electric range in a house, it must also be inspected. There is a \$3.25 inspection fee for this also.
- II. The membership fee shall be \$5.00, the payment of which shall make the member eligible for one service connection. An additional fee of \$5.00 shall be paid for each additional service connection requested by the member. A deposit is required on lighting and power loads and these are based on the electricity consumed.
- III. All meters are checked and calibrated at the time of installation. If a member requests a meter to be tested due to a high bill complaint, a \$2.00 service charge is made. If the meter is found to be registering incorrectly, this \$2.00 charge is refunded and an adjustment is made on the bills as per standard utility practices.
- IV. All meters are read by Coop. personnel once each month.
- V. It is the policy of this Cooperative to send delinquent notices five (5) days after the due date of the bill. If within approximately five (5) days after the delinquent notice was mailed, the bill is not paid our collector calls in person. If our collector is unable to see the member while there, he leaves a note which states, "If your payment is not received in our office by 8:30 A.M. tomorrow, your service will be disconnected". A \$1.00 collection fee is charged for this service. If the bill is not paid, a disconnect notice is then given to the servicemen. If the member is disconnected for nonpayment, a \$1.00 reconnection fee is charged upon payment of the bill and request for reconnection.
- VI. Any member requesting a service to be disconnected and connected within a twelve months period is charged a \$1.00 reconnection fee.

SCHEDULE R-2, Residential Rate

Availability:

This rate shall apply only to electric service in a single private dwelling and its appurtenances, the major use of which is for lighting and household appliances, for the personal comfort and convenience of those residing therein. Private dwellings in which space is occasionally used for the conduct of business by a person residing therein will be served under this rate. Where a portion of a dwelling is used regularly for the conduct of business, the electricity consumed in that portion so used will be separately metered and billed under the General Power Rate; if separate circuits are not provided by the customer, service to the entire premises shall be billed under the General Power Rate. This rate shall not apply to service to institutions such as clubs, fraternities, orphanages or homes; recognized rooming or boarding houses; or the space in an apartment or other residential building primarily devoted to use as an office or studio for professional or other gainful purposes.

Character of Service:

Alternating current, single or three-phase, 60 cycles. Voltage supplied will be at the discretion of Distributor and will be determined by the voltage available from distribution lines in the vicinity and/or other conditions.

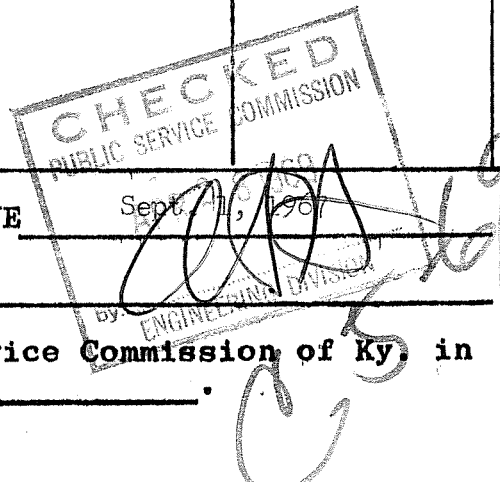

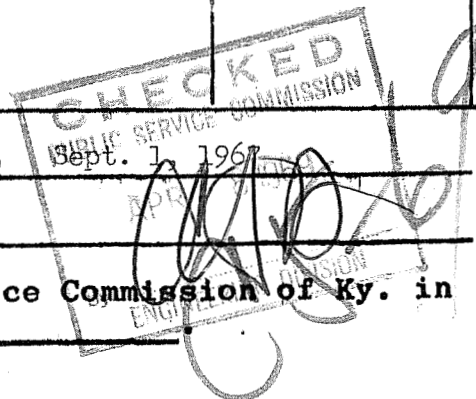

Availability:

Available to commercial, industrial, governmental, and other customers whose requirements are limited to firm power except those to whom service is available under the Residential or Outdoor Lighting Rates.

Character of Service:

Alternating current, single or three-phase, 60 cycles. Power sold under "A" below will be delivered at a voltage available in the vicinity or agreed to by Distributor. Power sold under "B" below will be delivered at a transmission voltage of 161 kv or, if such transmission voltage is not available, at the highest voltage available in the vicinity, unless at the customer's request a lower standard voltage is agreed upon.

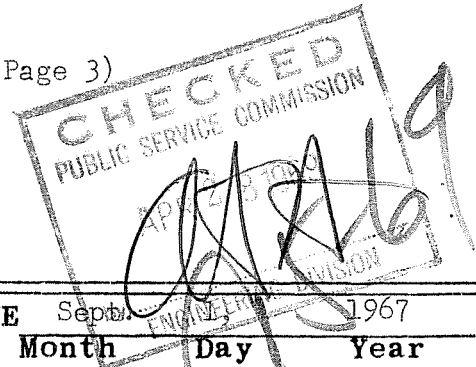

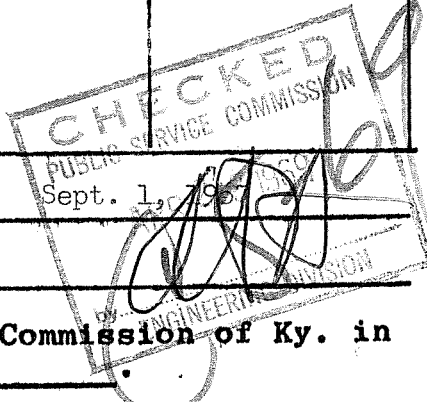

RATE PER UNIT

The rate for the final block of the energy charge will be increased or decreased by 1/8 mill per kwh for each full cent of major fraction thereof that the average cost per million Btu of all coal received by TVA at its steam plants during the last six months ending with June or December exceeds 20 cents or is less than 16 cents respectively.

Minimum Charge:

Minimum Bill and Contract Requirement

The minimum monthly bill shall in no case be less than \$1.00 plus \$0.50 per kwh for the excess over 10 kw of the highest demand during the 12 months ending with the current month. Customers whose demand exceeds 20 kw will be required to execute contracts for a minimum term of one year which may provide for a minimum charge in excess of the foregoing. If the contract demand is 5,000 kw or more, the minimum monthly bill shall not be less than \$1.00 per kw of the contract demand, and the contract will be for an initial term of at least five years.

Terms:

Seasonal Service

Customers who contract for service on a seasonal basis shall pay the above rates plus 10 percent of the bill computed before adjusting for coal costs. For such customers the "Minimum Monthly Bill" provided above shall not apply. Instead, such customers shall pay a minimum monthly bill of \$5.00 so long as service is cut in, shall pay a minimum annual bill of \$6.00 per kw of the maximum demand established, and shall pay in addition the actual cost of cut-ins and cut-outs in excess of one of each per year.

Above rates are net, the gross rates being 10% higher. In the event any bill is not paid within 10 days from date of bill the gross rate shall apply.
