RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Bills for service will be rendered monthly, the term "month" shall mean the period between consecutive meter readings which shall be taken, as nearly as possible, every thirty (30) days.
2. Bills are rendered on or about the 10th day following the billing period for service furnished during the previous month and are due within thirty (30) days of the date of invoice.
3. Service shall be provided to persons who qualify pursuant to KRS 278.475 upon Eastern American Energy Corporation's receipt of a signed Farm Tap Service Application and Agreement, receipt of any applicable fees and compliance with the applicable statutes and regulations.
4. A charge of \$150.00 shall be charged for each new service tap, including saddle and first shutoff valve that Eastern American Energy Corporation must furnish and install.
5. A reconnection charge of \$25.00 shall be paid before service is restored following disconnection of service for non-payment of bills.
6. A service charge of \$25.00 will be imposed on any customer whose check is returned from the bank due to insufficient funds. Such accounts will be considered in arrears, subject to penalty and possible termination after notice pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section II.
7. Service will not be discontinued for non-payment of bills without first having made a reasonable effort to induce the customer to pay the balance due. At least forty-eight (48) hours written notice of cut-off will be given the customer but the cut-off shall not be effected before fifteen (15) days after the mailing date of the original bill.
8. For matters not addressed herein, the applicable rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission shall apply.

Deposits

1. The Company requires a cash deposit to secure payment of bills, an equal amount for each class of customers, not to exceed 2/12 of the average annual bill when billed monthly, 3/12 when billed every 2 months, and 4/12 when billed every 3 months.
2. Deposit amount(s) shall be as follows:

Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) but not to exceed 2/12 of average estimated annual bill.

3. Service will be refused or discontinued if payment of deposit is not made.
4. Deposits may be waived for a customer showing satisfactory credit or payment history with the following criteria being considered: (a) Previous history with the Company. If the customer has no previous history with the Company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc., may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit; (b) Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit; (c) Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area; (d) Whether the customer owns the property to be served; (e) Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.
5. Interest will accrue on all deposits at the rate prescribed by law beginning on the date of the deposit. Interest accrued will be refunded to the customer or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis. If interest is paid or credited to the customer's bill prior to twelve (12) months from the date of deposit or the last interest payment date, the payment or credit shall be on a prorated basis.
6. Deposits will be refunded to customers:
 upon termination of service.
 after _____ months if customer has established a satisfactory payment history or upon termination of service.
