**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL SERVICE**

1. Persons desiring gas service shall file application at our office consisting of the following information.

A. Name and address of the applicant.

B. Type of service desired

2. Cash Deposits.

A. A cash deposit not to exceed one sixth of the <sup>estimated</sup> annual bill is required from all new customers as guaranty to secure payment of bills with the minimum cash deposit being 5.00 Five Dollars.

**CUSTOMER SERVICE LINE**

1. Minimum size of customer service line shall be one inch standard weight black steel pipe for residential service. For commercial service, runs of pipe in excess of one hundred feet, or other unusual situations the gas company shall be consulted for correct sizing of service line.

2. Minimum depth of service line must be not less than eighteen inches and layed on undisturbed or well compacted soil in a separate trench, avoiding sewers, water pipes, and conduits, and shall not run through septic tanks or leaching beds. It shall not be layed on a bench or offset of a deeper trench. The trench shall be graded uniformly to provide a solid and continuous foundation for the pipe and shall be deep enough to provide at least sixteen inches of cover over the service line.

3. No heavy weight or material such as large stones or concrete blocks shall be placed on the customer's service line or in the fill over the service line.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**CUSTOMER SERVICE LINE Cont'd**

4. The service line trench shall not be backfilled until after the line has been inspected and approved by a representative of the gas company.
5. The service line, including labor, material and equipment shall be furnished, installed and maintained by the applicant at his expense and shall remain his property.
6. This company shall provide a main line tap including pipe saddle and first service shut-off valve and shall furnish, install and maintain the necessary meter and regulator.
7. The service line shall be subjected to an air pressure test equivalent to 1.5 times the working pressure but not to exceed 50psig.

**METERS AND REGULATORS**

1. All meters and regulators shall be installed outside with the gas company reserving the right to designate the location.
2. Meters and regulators shall be installed as near as practicable to the point where the service enters the building and shall be so located as to be readily accessible for examination, reading, and replacement.
3. The adopted distribution pressure shall be 10 inches w. c. or 5.9 ounces per square inch.
4. The utility company shall at all reasonable hours have access to meters, regulators, and service connections and other property owned by it and located on customer's premises for the purpose of installation, maintenance, operation or removal of its property.
