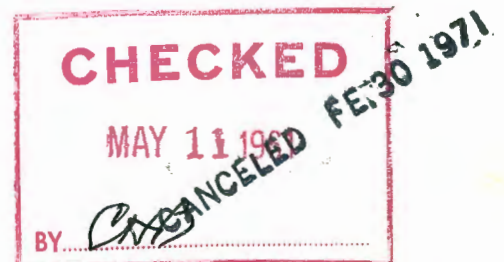

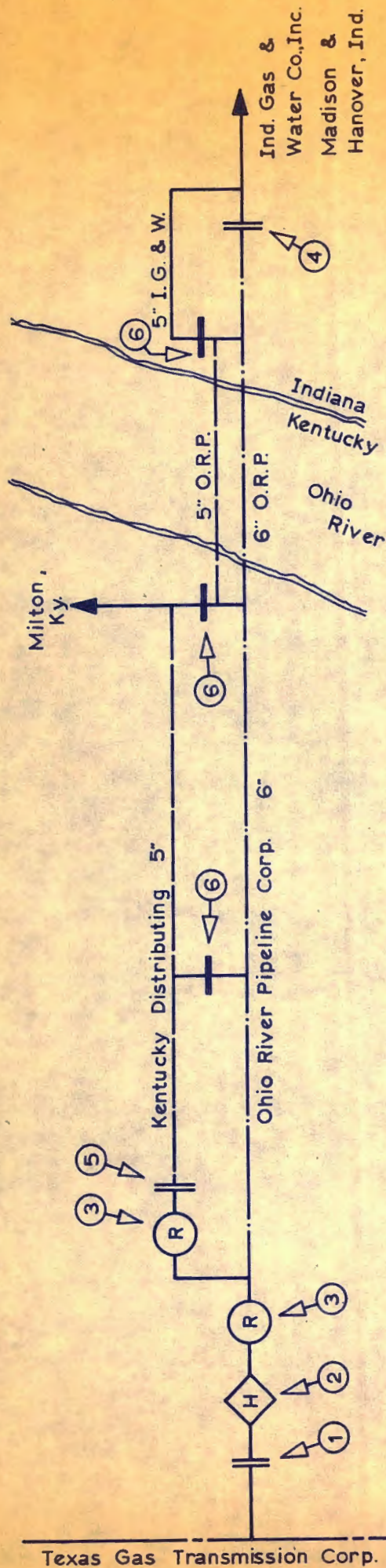

GENERAL NATURAL GAS SERVICE SCHEDULE NG-1

AVAILABILITY

Available in the City of Madison, Indiana and environs for general natural gas service, to residential customers who do not use gas-fired space heating equipment of sufficient capacity to heat all or a major portion of their residence, and to commercial or industrial customers with or without space heating. Any commercial or industrial customer using gas for space heating service shall have the right to contract for such service through separate space heating meter under General Service Schedule G-2. Applicant must be located on the Company's distribution mains or transmission lines.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Natural gas with a heat content of approximately 1,000 BTU per cubic foot.

RATE

GENERAL GAS SERVICE SCHEDULE NG-2
RESIDENTIAL SPACE HEATING. ALSO COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL
SPACE HEATING SEPARATELY METERED IF DESIRED

AVAILABILITY

Available in the City of Madison and environs to residential customers using gas-fired space heating equipment of sufficient capacity to heat all or a major portion of their residence. Gas used for other residential purposes is combined with space heating usage at one billing under this rate. This schedule is also available for gas space heating usage by commercial and industrial customers who elect to take such service through separate space heating meter instead of combining same at one billing with gas used for other than space heating purposes under General Service Schedule NG-1. Applicant must be located on the Company's distribution mains or transmission lines.

RIDER ACS

SUMMER AIR CONDITIONING SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available in the cities of Madison and Hanover, Indiana, and in all other communities and unincorporated areas supplied with gas service by the Company, where standard tariff rates are effective for the application of this rider to those customers who take summer air conditioning service under the terms of this rider. T

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to gas service for the operation of Summer Air Conditioning equipment during the five monthly billing periods of each year beginning with the period covered by the regular June meter reading and ending with the period covered by the regular October meter reading, provided customer's building or premises is air conditioned by the utilization of gas as the principal energy supply. T

RATE

For "Summer Air Conditioning Consumption" determined in the manner hereinafter prescribed, the rate shall be 55¢ net per 1,000 cubic feet. All monthly consumption other than "Summer Air Conditioning Consumption" shall be billed at the regular charges applicable to such other service set forth in the standard gas tariff supplemented by this rider. T

MINIMUM CHARGE

Minimum charge shall be that stated in the standard gas tariff supplemented by this rider, except that if gas is used exclusively for summer air conditioning with no other service, the minimum charge shall be \$1.50 net per month. T

COLLECTION CHARGE

The collection charge shall be the same as stated in the standard gas tariff supplemented by this rider. T

RECONNECTION CHARGE

The reconnection charge shall be the same as provided in the standard gas tariff supplemented by this rider. T

DETERMINATION OF SUMMER AIR CONDITIONING CONSUMPTION

The Summer Air Conditioning Consumption shall be determined as follows: N

Residential Service

For each of the aforesaid five monthly billing periods all gas consumption in excess of 5,000 cubic feet per single family dwelling unit shall be taken as the Summer Air Conditioning Consumption.

Commercial and Industrial Service

(1) Where the only gas usage during the aforesaid five monthly billing periods is considered to be for summer air conditioning purposes, (this being the case when gas is used only for summer air conditioning or only for space heating and summer air conditioning), the consumption recorded on customer's regular meter during such five periods shall all be taken as the Summer Air Conditioning Consumption.

SUMMER AIR CONDITIONING SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available in the City of Madison, Indiana; Hanover, Indiana; and Milton, Kentucky; also in the communities and unincorporated areas adjacent to and covered by the franchise area, where standard tariff rates are effective for the application of this rider to those customers who take air conditioning service under the terms of this rider.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to gas service for the operation of Summer Air Conditioning equipment during the period from customer's meter reading beginning on or after May 15th to the meter readings on or after September 15th, but not later than September 25th, provided customer's building or premises is air conditioned by the utilization of gas as the principal energy supply.

RATE

All at 55¢ per 1,000 cu. ft.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum as stated in the standard tariff rate on which this rider is applicable, except if used exclusively for air conditioning with no other service, the minimum charge shall be \$1.50 per month.

COLLECTION CHARGE

The collection charge shall be the same as stated in the standard tariff rate on which this rider is applicable.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

The reconnection charge shall be the same as provided on the standard tariff rate to which this rider is applicable.

SUMMER AIR CONDITIONING SERVICE (Continued)

Commercial and Industrial Service (Continued)

(2) Where gas is used during the aforesaid five monthly billing periods for purposes other than space heating and summer air conditioning and where summer air conditioning usage during such periods can be isolated from such other gas usage in such a way as to permit separate metering of summer air conditioning usage, the Summer Air Conditioning Consumption will be determined by separate metering. During the remaining seven monthly billing periods of the year the readings of such separate meter will be combined with those of the meter supplying customer's other gas service for billing at the standard gas tariff applicable thereto.

(3) Where it is not possible or economically feasible to determine the Summer Air Conditioning Consumption by metering as provided in Paragraphs (1) and (2) above, the Summer Air Conditioning Consumption during each of the aforesaid five monthly billing periods shall be taken as 4,500 cubic feet for each ton of installed cooling capacity, but not more than the total consumption recorded by the meter during such billing period. For this purpose the capacity of air conditioning equipment will be determined by American Refrigeration Institute ratings.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This rate shall not be available for summer air conditioning equipment used only occasionally or sporadically, it being contemplated that equipment served hereunder will operate for not less than 800 hours in a normal summer.
