RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of gas utilities which may be adopted by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof which may be made by said Commission.

II.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS
APPLICABLE TO GAS SERVICE

1. RULES AND REGULATIONS ON FILE

A copy of all rates, rules and regulations has been filed with the Public Service Commissions of the State of Indiana and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, for the benefit and information of the public. Extra copies are available at the office of the company and are supplied free of charge to any customer upon application.

2. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

A written application, or contract, may be required by the customer before the Company will supply service, provided, however, that the Company shall have the right to reject any application for any valid reason. The Company may require a long-term contract when unusual construction expense is involved in order to supply the service requested.

3. COMMENCEMENT OF SERVICE

Each customer shall make application to the Company, its representative, or agent before gas service will be connected.

4. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Whenever a Customer desires to have service discontinued he shall notify the Company sufficiently in advance to provide reasonable time to obtain a final meter reading. Any Customer failing to give ample time for preparing final meter reading and billing will be held responsible for the payment of all bills rendered for gas service supplied to such premises.

5. EXTENSION OF MAINS AND FACILITIES

Upon a written request for service by a prospective Customer, or group of prospective Customers residing in an area not already supplied with gas, the Company will extend free of charge its facilities necessary to provide the service requested, provided, however, that (a) the total estimated revenue derived from the prospective Customer, or group of prospective Customers, is equivalent to or in excess of the cost of providing the service, and (b) the patronage demand is of such permanency as to warrant the capital expenditure required.

If the total cost of the facilities for providing gas service, consisting of mains, services, regulator, and meters, is in excess of the free limit the Company may require a cash deposit for the amount above the free limit, and will in such case refund the excess deposit on a basis of the estimated revenue derived from each additional Customer added to the extension.

The obligation of the Company to provide any extension, however, is conditioned upon its ability to obtain all necessary material required for making the extension.

6. SERVICE CONNECTIONS

The Company will supply all service lines including piping, shut-off cocks, curb boxes, regulators, and meters, subject to Rule No. 5 above, free of charge from its mains to the curb or rear lot line. The Company will install for the Customer the additional piping from the curb or rear lot line into the house and to the meter location at regular plumbing rates in effect at the time. Risers in buildings where meters are set above the first floor line shall be furnished and maintained by the Customer.

7. INSIDE PIPING

An applicant for service must, and at his own expense, equip his premises with all necessary piping from the outlet of the meter to all appliance outlets, which piping shall be constructed and maintained in accordance with standard building codes, and rules and regulations of the Company. The Company shall be under no obligation to inspect the piping and equipment of the Customer.

8. LOCATION OF COMPANY'S METERS AND SERVICES

The Customer shall provide free of expense to the Company a suitable location at, or near, the service entrance for the meter and any other necessary equipment which may be required by the Company to provide service.

9. METERS TO BE INSTALLED BY COMPANY

All gas used on the Customer's premises shall be measured by a meter, or meters, installed and maintained by the Company.

If more than one meter is installed for metering different classes of service, a separate bill shall be rendered for each item in accordance with applicable rates.

Where the Customer requires for his convenience that more than one meter be installed for metering the same class of service, a separate bill shall be rendered for each meter in accordance with applicable rates.

10. MONTH

A "Month" shall mean the period between any two consecutive meter readings, such readings being taken as nearly as practicable every thirty (30) days.

11. DEPOSIT

The Company may require from all applicants for gas service a cash deposit equal to the estimated billing for a period of sixty (60) days, as a guarantee against the non-payment of bills for service; provided, however, that if the applicant is the owner of real property and whose credit is approved by the Company, the Company may waive such cash deposit.

12. COMBINED RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL SERVICE

Where both residential and commercial classes of service are supplied through one service and one meter to the same customer on the same premises, the service shall be billed as one customer.

13. COMPANY'S PROPERTY AND THE PROTECTION THEREOF

All meters and other equipment furnished by and at the expense of the Company, which may at any time be located on or in the Customer's premises, shall, unless otherwise expressly provided, be and remain the property of the Company, and the Customer shall protect such property from loss or damage and no one who is not a representative or agent of the Company shall be permitted to remove such property or tamper therewith.

14. ACCESS TO PREMISES

The properly authorized agents of the Company shall have the right to enter upon the premises of the Customer at all reasonable times for the purpose of reading, inspecting, testing, repairing, or replacing the meter or meters, or other equipment used in connection with its service, and for removing same upon the termination of contract or discontinuance of service for any reason.

15. FAILURE OF METER

Whenever it is discovered that a meter is not recording within the limits of accuracy as prescribed in the rules of the Public Service Commission of Indiana or the Common wealth of Kentucky, adjustment shall be made in accordance with such rules.

GENERAL NATURAL GAS SERVICE SCHEDULE NO-1

AVAILABILITY

Available in Carroll and Trimble Counties, Kentucky, and environs for general natural gas service to residential customers who do not use gas-fired space heating equipment of sufficient capacity to heat all or a major portion of their residence, and to commercial and industrial customers with or without space heating. Any commercial or industrial customer using gas for space heating service shall have the right to contract for such service through separate space heating meter under General Service Schedule G-2. Applicant must be located on the Company's distribution mains or transmission lines.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Natural gas with a heat content of approximately 1,000 Btu per cubic foot.

RATE

First	300 cubic feet or less per month		\$1.00
Next	2,200 cubic feet per month	@20¢ per 100 cu. ft.	
Next	2,500 cubic feet per month	@15¢ per 100 cu. ft.	
Next	5,000 cubic feet per month	@10¢ per 100 cu. ft.	
Next	10,000 cubic feet per month	@ 9¢ per 100 cu. ft.	
Over	20,000 cubic feet per month	@ 8¢ per 100 cu. ft.	

MINIMUM CHARGE

\$1.00 per meter per month.

COLLECTION CHARGE

On the first \$10.00 or less of net billing - 5%
On all in excess of \$10.00 - 3%

Bills shall be rendered and due monthly. If paid within 15 days from the due date thereof, as stated in the bill, the net amount shall be paid. If not paid within 15 days from the due date, the gross bill, which includes the collection charge, is the amount to be paid.

CONNECTION CHARGE

When the service is turned off for non-payment of bill, or whenever for any reason beyond the control of the Company a re-establishment of service is required by any one customer more often than once in a twelve month period, a charge of \$1.00 will be made.

"GENERAL GAS SERVICE SCHEDULE NG-2"
(INCLUDING RESIDENTIAL SPACE HEATING AND SEPARATELY
METERED COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL SPACE HEATING)

AVAILABILITY

Available in Carroll and Trimble Counties, Kentucky, and environs to residential customers using gas-fired space heating equipment of sufficient capacity to heat all or a major portion of their residence. Gas used for other residential purposes is combined with space heating usage at one billing under this rate. This schedule is also available for gas space heating usage by commercial and industrial customers who elect to take such service through separate space heating meter instead of combining same at one billing with gas used for other than space heating purposes under General Service Schedule NG-1. Applicant must be located on the Company's distribution mains or transmission lines.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Natural gas with a heat content of approximately 1,000 BTU per cubic foot.

RATE

First	600 cubic feet or less per month	1.50
Next	1,400 cubic feet per month @ 18¢ per 100 cu. ft.	
Over	2,000 cubic feet per month @ 8¢ per 100 cu. ft.	

MINIMUM CHARGE

\$1.50 per meter per month.

COLLECTION CHARGE

On the first \$10.00 or less of net billing - 5%
On all in excess of \$10.00 - 3%

Bills shall be rendered and due monthly. If paid within 15 days from the due date thereof, as stated in the bill, the net amount shall be paid. If not paid within 15 days from the due date, the gross bill, which included the collection charge, is the amount to be paid.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

When the service is turned off for non-payment of bill, or whenever for any reason beyond the control of the Company a re-establishment of service is required by any one customer more often than once in a twelve month period, a charge of \$1.00 will be made.
