1. Rules and Regulations

A) Mallard Point Disposal System (MPDS), being a pressure sewer system, requires each homeowner to provide for themselves and maintain in good order and in perpetuity, a pump and grinder lift station as is so designated by the utility's engineering firm who designed and warrants the collection system of the utility. Such system requires a Meyers WGL20-21 or WGL20H-21 complete with a 6' tall, 30 in diameter basin, and an electronic central panel known in its complete form as a "Mallard Point Unit".

All discharged lines and connections from this unit once installed shall be pressure PVC and once connected to the utility "Tap" the utility shall be notified so that an inspection may be made by the utility prior to covering with soil and service being rendered by the utility.

Failure to do so can result in the requirement of that individual future customer being required to fully expose all lines and apparatus prior to service being rendered to that specific location.

B) MPDS is responsible for any leak or malfunction from and including, the customers tap, located at the front of their property, at their connection box, forward throughout the utility system.

C) The customer is responsible for their own connection lines and apparatus including all maintenance from their home to the utilities tap point.

Failure to properly maintain said system can result in the utility taking said property "offline" until such apparatus is again in working order.

D) Banned substances: No stringent cleaning agents, acids, degreasers, petroleum products of any kind, heavy metals and or type of industrial waste or discharge may be introduced into the system.

Any customer or individual found to have violated this section will be responsible for the cost of such actions as may be determined by the utility, the courts of jurisdiction, and the regulatory bodies of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

E) Termination of service for non payment. Service may be terminated by the utility for non payment after a period of 30 days delinquent.

As MPDS is a pressure system, each residential connection has a "valve" allowing the flow from the customer into the utilities collection system.

Once non-payment has been determined, the utility at its discretion may "shut off" service to the delinquent customer by closing this "valve" and placing a "sewer dummy," (900 lb weight) over the connection box so that the customer cannot restore his or her service by simply turning their valve back on.
