

- (4) A notarized statement by an officer of USA FIBER is attached hereto as Exhibit B, stating that USA FIBER has not provided or collected for intrastate service in Kentucky prior to filing this notice of intent.
- (5) A statement that USA FIBER does not seek to provide operator assisted services to traffic aggregators as defined in Administrative Case No. 330 is also included in the notarized statement attached hereto as Exhibit B.

USA FIBER will only be offering dark fiber services and will not initially be filing tariffs with the Kentucky Public Service Commission. However, USA FIBER expects to offer tariffed services in the future and will file tariffs well in advance of any such offerings consistent with all Commission requirements.
