RULES AND REGULATIONS

- P. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the consumer, member of his household, and employees only. The consumer shall not sell or give away the water to any other person.
- Q. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system whose decision may be appealed to the Board of Commissioners of the District within ten (10) days; otherwise, the operator's decision will be final.
- R. The water bills shall be paid at Rt. 7 Box 50, Mayfield, KY 42066.
- S. Customers that have water leaks will be given an adjustment, provided the leak is verified by customer.

The adjustment will be made as follows: Customer will be charged for the average usage and the balance will be charged at the Water District's cost with the difference credited to the customers account.

Only one leak adjustment per year for a customer.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

WATER EXTENSION POLICY

All Developers must submit project development plans to Consumers Water District for review and approval. The District shall determine the total cost of the proposed water main extension or project and study the feasibility of the project. After approval by the District, construction may begin when the Developer submits the total cost of the project to the District. The District will then construct the project as proposed.

A ten (10) year refund period shall begin to the Developer when the Developer submits the full payment of the project to the District. This payment date will be considered the official starting and anniversary date of the project. All refunds to the Developer will be made yearly on the anniversary date of the project. To determine refunds, total cost of the project will be divided by total length of said main extension to determine the cost per foot of said extension. At each anniversary date, the cost of 100 feet of the main extension will be paid to the Developer for each meter that is installed and being used on said main extension (all persons desiring water will be responsible for the meter tap-on fee). Refunds shall continue each year until reimbursement is paid in full (no interest) or 10 years have elapsed, whichever occurs first. No refunds will be made after 10 years from the time the project began. If this policy is not satisfactory or acceptable, special consideration or exception may be made to said policy by Consumer Water District at its discretion.
