RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
2. Any resident or business of Hendron Water District is eligible for water service from the District, providing a water main is within 100 feet of his property line.
3. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance.
4. All applications for service to rental property shall be accompanied by a \$20 deposit to assure payment of bill, except applications for service to trailers, which shall be \$25.
5. All applications for service shall be accompanied by a tap-on fee in the following amounts:

- 10. A fee of \$15.00 shall be charged for re-establishing discontinued service.
- 11. No connections to the water pipes of the system shall be made except by or under the supervision of a duly authorized officer, agent or employee of the system.
- 12. If the water service of any customer is disconnected for nonpayment of bills, the District shall require payment of a \$5.00 reconnection fee and payment of all delinquent water bills, including penalties and interest, in full before reconnection is made.
- 13. All customers of the Hendron Water District shall be individually metered.

14. Extension of Main

(T)

A. Normal Extension

An extension of fifty feet or less shall be made by the Hendron Water District to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one year or more and provide a guarantee for such service.

B. Other Extensions

(1) When an extension of the Hendron Water District's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty feet per applicant, the District may require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty feet per customer to be desposited with the District by the applicant or the applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. Cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other cost incurred by the District. Records of cost shall be maintained by the District and made available to the applicant or applicants receiving service.

(2) Each customer receiving service under such extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten years, which for the purpose of this rule shall be the refund period, the Hendron Water District shall refund to the customer of customers who paid for the excessive footage, the cost of fifty feet of

the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom; but, in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the District. After the end of the refund period, (10 years) no refund will be made.

C. Extension to a Real Estate Subdivision.

(1) Applicants Cost of Extension. An applicant desiring an extension to a proposed real estate subdivision may be required to pay the entire cost of the extension. Cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other cost incurred by the District. Records of cost shall be maintained by the District and be made available to the applicant receiving service.

(2) Applicants Reimbursed for Cost of Extension. Each year for a period of not less than 10 years, the Hendron Water District shall refund to the applicant who paid for the extension, a sum equivalent to the cost of 50 feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected during the year but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the District. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension (10 years), no refund will be required to be made.

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D. Construction Procedure.

(1) Extensions by Water District. Water line extensions extended to customers under Item (A) Normal Extensions;

(B) Other Extensions; or (C) Extension to a Real Estate Estate Subdivision, shall be installed by the Water Districts' forces, or by a competent contractor employed by the Water District or by the person or persons desiring service and acceptable to the Water District.

(2) Construction Drawings. Plans and specifications for proposed extensions shall be prepared by the Hendron Water District's authorized engineering representative, shall comply with the District's standards, shall meet the requirements of the Kentucky Department of Health, the Public Service Commission and other applicable federal, state and local regulating agencies.

(3) Real Estate Subdivision Plats. A reproducible plat of a real estate subdivision as recorded in the County Court Clerk's office shall be furnished by the developer for use by the District's Engineer in laying out the proposed water lines.

(4) Utility Easements. Water mains shall generally be laid in a 15 foot permanent easement on private property. A 15 foot temporary construction easement adjacent to the 15 foot permanent easement shall also be required, where practical, from each private property owner. The cost of obtaining easements shall be included in the cost of construction as set forth in Items 14B and 14C above.

(5) Service Lines and Tap-On Fees. Meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter will be installed by the Water District as required to customers adjacent to said main extensions, and the Water District shall be reimbursed for this service by the property owner in the form of a tap-on fee current at the time the service is made not withstanding the following:

a. The District may under certain circumstances alter tap-on fees to exceed the standard tap-on fee in effect

for the purposes of reimbursement to applicants desiring extensions under Item 14B, Other Extensions, and Item 14C, Extensions to a Real Estate Subdivision, if said altered tap-on fees are approved by the State of Kentucky, Public Service Commission.

(6) Potable Water - Maintenance of Lines. After the mains have been installed, tested and chlorinated to the satisfaction of the Health Department, the Hendron Water District shall then accept the responsibility for furnishing potable water to the extension and for maintenance of the lines including meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter.

(7) Rates. Rates for furnishing water shall be the current rates then in effect for the Hendron Water District in the area served as approved by the Public Service Commission.

E. Other Arrangements for Extensions.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit the Hendron Water District from making extensions under different arrangements provided such arrangements have been approved by the State of Kentucky, Public Service Commission.

F. Extensions by the Hendron Water District.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as to prohibit the Hendron Water District from making at its expense, greater extensions than herein prescribed, should its judgement so dictate, provided like free extensions are made to other customers under similar conditions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rules and Regulations, effective November 1, 1969, shall be amended as follows pertaining to multiple services:

The original Item 13 shall be construed to mean and shall be applicable to (a) residential homes, (b) combined residential homes and trailer homes, and (c) trailer homes not otherwise classified as a commercial trailer park.

B. Commercial Trailer Park.

- (1) Definition. A commercial trailer park shall be defined as two (2) or more units occupying a common parcel of land and producing revenue or two (2) or more units designated as a trailer park by the Kentucky Department of Health for reasons of health and public welfare.
- (2) Minimum Bill. Rates set forth herein are based on the capacity of the trailer park whether filled or not. For purposes of determining the park capacity, the park owner shall submit a plat of development to the District. Payment for water purchased shall be 50% of the regular residential minimum times the number of trailer spaces available (includes 50% of residential minimum gallonage times number of spaces available). Balance of usage billed at regular residential rate schedule.
- (3) Meter Size. The utility shall determine the size of meter necessary to provide adequate services and the meter installation shall be paid for by the customer at the prescribed rate in effect. The following schedule of meter sizes and maximum number of trailer spaces shall be adopted as the basis for selection by the Water District under normal conditions.

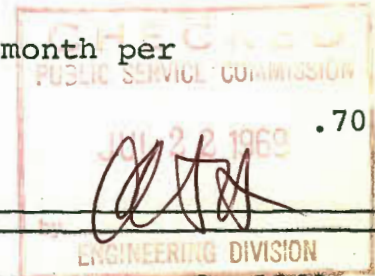
