## RULES AND REGULATIONS

## SECTION 8. MINIMUM USAGE OF WATER.

A customer applying and contracting for service and paying the appropriate connection charges guarantees a minimum usage of this service of one year. The appropriate connection charges will be collected "up-front".

SECTION 9. DEPOSITS.

Hickory Water District

A deposit may be required by the District for water service by any applicant desiring service before being entitled to such service. The amount of such deposit shall not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of the applicant where bills are rendered monthly, three-twelfths (3/12) if rendered bimonthly, or four-twelfths (4/12) if rendered quarterly. Such deposit, less any unpaid charges plus interest of 6% per annum, shall be refunded to such customer, his heirs or assigns, whenever such customer notifies the District legally to disconnect or terminate service to such customer.

SECTION 10. OWNERS PAY CONNECTION CHARGES; OCCUPANTS PAY RATES.

Connection charges, where applicable, shall be the personal obligation of the owners of the respective properties. All water charges, other than connection charges, shall be the personal obligation, collectible by law, of the occupant of the lot, property or building receiving the benefits of such use and service so long as the same continues, and the satisfaction of the lot with SSION by any party shall be a discharge of the liability for which the payments is made.
