office to witness the test. However, the cost of such testing shall be paid by the customer in the event that the accuracy of the meter is within 2% of a true and correct test. The charge for this test shall not exceed \$12.00. In the event the meter accuracy varies more than 2% the cost of the testing shall be borne by the District and a new or reconditioned tested meter will be installed at no cost to the customer. If the meter is more than 2% fast, a refund shall be computed on the basis of the percentage fast that the meter tested for a period not to exceed the previous twelve months.

### SECTION VI - SERVICE INSTALLATIONS

Any property owner or prospective water user desiring water service and the installation of the service branch into the premises shall apply at the District office. The owner or water user shall, in signing the application, agree to be bound by all the provisions of this operating code and as it may be amended from time to time. No service branch shall be installed to serve property which does not abut the street or road of which the service main is located without consideration of the costs involved. Every building wherein water is used shall have a separate service branch and meter provided, however, that any variation in this respect may be authorized by the District. The District reserves the right to specify the size service branch for each installation. When application for a service branch installation is made a tapping fee shall be paid according to the following schedule:
