- 1. Water bills shall become delinquent on the date indicated on the bill, which is 21 days after the billing date; at which time, a 10 percent penalty is added and shown on the bill as the gross amount due.
- 2. Following the delinquency of a bill, a reminder notice will be mailed to the customer showing the gross amount as being due. Twenty days prior to the next billing date, a ten-day cutoff notice will be issued.
- 3. Any water user who has been delinquent or has refused to pay past bills may be required to place a cash deposit with the District in the sum equal to the estimated charge for water for a three-month period.
- 4. In the event that the water service is disconnected for nonpayment of bills or failure to comply with the District Rules and Regulations, a sum of \$5.00 will be added to the bill and the customer will be required to pay the full amount due plus a \$5.00 reconnection fee before the water service will be restored to said customer. The customer shall be required to again deposit \$15.00 cash which is the same as a new customer.

SECTION IV - ADJUSTMENT OF WATER BILLS

1. No reduction in water charges or billing shall be made for leakage except in cases where it shall occur upon an investigation that the leakage is underground and not subject to detection by ordinary methods and where the owner and other occupants of the premises are free from negligence in causing or failing to report the leakage or in cases during periods of emergency where and by reason of shortages of material or manpower, immediate repairs are not available. No reduction for leakage shall be permitted in an amount to exceed 50 percent of the estimated leakage.

- Water bills shall become delinquent on the date indicated on the bill, which is twenty one (21) days after the billing date; at which time a ten (10) percent penalty is added and shown on the bill as the gross amount due.
- Following the delinquency of a bill, a reminder notice will be mailed to the customer showing the gross amount as being due. Twenty (20) days prior to the next billing date, a ten (10) day cutoff notice will be issued.
- 3. Any water user who has been delinquent or has refused to pay past bills may be required to place a cash deposit with the District in the sum equal to the estimated charge for water for a three (3) month period.
- 4. In the event that the water service is disconnected for non-payment of bills, or failure to comply with the District Rules and Regulations, a sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) will be added to the bill and the sustomer will be required to pay the full amount due plus Five Dollars (\$5.00) reconnection fee before the water service will be restored to said customer. The customer shall be required to again deposit Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) cash the same as a new customer.

SECTION IV - ADJUSTMENT OF WATER BILLS

1. No reduction in water charges or billing shall be made for leakage except in cases where it shall occur on an investigation that the leakage is underground and not subject to detection by ordinary methods and where the owner and other occupants of the permises are free from negligence in causing or failing to report the leakage, or in cases during periods of emergency where and by reason of shortages of material or manpower immediate repairs are not available. No reduction for leakage shall be permitted in an amount to exceed fifty (50) percent of the estimated leakage.

office to witness the test. However, the cost of such testing shall be paid by the customer in the event that the accuracy of the meter is within 2% of a true and correct test. In the event the meter accuracy varies more than 2% the cost of the testing shall be borne by the District and a new or reconditioned tested meter will be installed at no cost to the customer. If the meter is more than 2% fast, a refund shall be computed on the basis of the percentage fast that the meter tested for a period not to exceed the previous twelve months.

SECTION VI - SERVICE INSTALLATION'S

Any property owner or prospective water user desiring water service and the installation of the service branch into the premises shall apply at the District office. The owner or wter user shall, in signing the application, agree to be bound by all the provisions of this operating code and as it may be amended from time to time. No service branch shall be installed to serve property which does not abut the street or road of which the service main is located without specific approval of the District. Every building wherein water is used shall have a separate service branch and meter provided, however, that any variation in this respect may be authorized by the District. The District reserves the right to specify the size service branch for each installation. When application for a service branch installation is made a tapping fee shall be paid according to the following schedule:

All service installation over 1 inch will be charged actual material costs (times 1.1 to cover handling) plus actual payroll cover equipment costs.

- Upon request from a customer for an enlargement of a service, the service shall be considered as new and price of a new service installation will be applicable for a 1" service or larger.
- 4. After the tapping fee has been paid the District shall tap the main and run the service connection branch from the main to a location behind the curb or a point to be determined by the Kenton County Water District and an adequate service cut off will be placed at that point.
- 5. The portion of the service branch from the service cut off to the building shall be installed by the owner or water user at no cost to the District. All service branches shall be subject to inspection and approval by the Water District before water service will be turned on for use.
- 6. The Water District shall retain possession of, and maintain the service line from the main to the service cut off.
- 7. The property owner shall be responsible for maintenance and repair of the service line from the service cut off to and throughout the premises. Failure to repair a leak or leaks when notified of the same within the time allowance on the notice, shall be sufficient cause to justify discontinuance of water service.
- 8. In cases where the property owner desires a water pressure other than that pressure provided by the Water District mains in the surrounding area, it shall be the responsibility of the property owner to install the necessary devices to provide the desired pressure.
- 9. In cases where the service has been installed, the customer shall pay the minimum rate specified herein.
