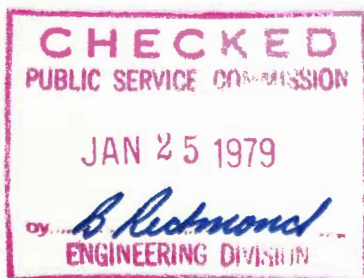

General Service

Applicable within the service area of Lake City Water District. Availability: - To domestic and commercial users Rates: <u>Minimum Charge for First 3,000 Gallons Per Month</u> The customers metered water usage shall be the basis for the computation of the bill for sewage service.

Flat Rate Customers	
City of Grand Rivers (Per Month)	\$700.00
<u>Delayed Payment Charge:</u> Each bill shall become overdue after the 15th day of each month, and a penalty of 10% shall be added to the face amount of the bill. Terms of service is on a monthly basis.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
2. Any resident of Lake City Water District is eligible for sewage service from the District where sewer is available.
3. Sewage Service is disconnected when the customer request his water meter removed or for nonpayment of sewage bill. Also, when the water meter has been disconnected for nonpayment of bill or for violation of the District's rules and regulations.
4. The Water District Commissioners will have full jurisdiction as to how and where sewage lines are laid up to the customers property line, size and kind of line used, and all matters pertaining to the Lake City Water District. No one or two Commissioners may make any decision, as all three must agree before any work can be passed on or started.
5. Sewage lines installed by customers must be so done according to specifications of the Lake City Water District.
6. Any break in sewage lines or damage caused by anyone **PUBLIC OTHER THAN THE** Water District must be reported and Water District reimbursed for such damage.
7. No fill, ditches, banks or any other disturbance **can be started** without notice to the Water District at least one day before starting work after contract is let.
