ORDER

On November 29, 1995, Milford Water Company ("Milford"), owner and operator of a water distribution system in southern Madison County, Kentucky, filed a petition seeking the Public Service Commission's approval of the transfer of ownership and control of its water distribution system to Richmond Water, Gas, and Sewerage Works ("RWGS"). The terms of the proposed transfer were set forth in a Contract of Sale entered into by both parties, a copy of which was attached to the application. The Contract of Sale was executed on behalf of Milford by Lucy A. Martin, President of Milford, as authorized by the unanimous consent of the Board of Directors and the Shareholders of Milford by a joint resolution duly adopted by the Directors and Shareholders at a special meeting on September 26, 1995, and on behalf of RWGS by Ann L. Durham, Mayor of the City of Richmond, as approved and directed by City of Richmond Ordinance No. 95-49, adopted and enacted by the City Commission for the City of Richmond on November 21, 1995, a copy of which was attached to the application.

Milford is a privately owned corporation subject to the Commission's jurisdiction which provides water service to

3. Within 30 days of the date of transfer, Milford shall file with the Commission an annual report for the portion of 1996 in which it operated its water distribution system.

The following rules and regulations are subject to change at anytime by the Water District with approval of the Public Service Commission.

- 1. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 24th of each month.
- 2. Bills will be mailed on the first of each month and will state they are to be paid by the 15th of the month.
- 3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission on the property to be served.
- 4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and may be appealed to the District Commission.
- 5. The principal place of business of the District will be 202 South Third Street, Richmond, Ky.
- 6. Water bills may be paid at 202 South Third Street, Richmond, Kentucky or mailed to P. O. Box 489, Richmond, Kentucky.

Service Charge - A charge of \$10.00 shall be charged for all service turn ons.

Meter Reading Recheck - A charge of \$10.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread.

Returned Check charge - There will be a \$10.00 charge on all customer checks returned to the Company non-paid.

Delinquent Service Charge - There will be a \$15.00 charge to reconnect a meter which has been disconnected due to the customer's non-payment of bill. (This fee includes the expenses incurred in disconnecting the delinquent account)

Meter Installation - There will be a \$425.00 charge for all meter installations.

Meter Drop - There will be a \$65.00 charge for all meter drops. A meter drop is when a new meter is placed into a meter vault installed by a developer. (Only those places where no service has ever existed fall into this category.)

DEPOSITS

The Company may require a minimum cash deposit or other quaranty to secure payment of bills except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The Company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of services classification any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will DEKENTEGIZED to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer. EFFECTIVE

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

- 1. Previous payment history with the Company. Ifputte of company of previous history with the Company, statements from other with the Company, statements from other with the banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
 - 2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.

 3. Length of time the customer has resided or been Portage Commission
- 4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.

5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.

- 6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.
- If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential customer, the Company may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

Water districts should substitute KRS 74.050 and water associations should substitute KRS 273.392 since these statutes govern the rate of interest to be paid by water districts and associations.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the Company will monitor the usage of eac customer according to the following procedure:

- The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month peric will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 month immediately preceding that period.
- If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially th same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to al customers, no further review will be done.
- If the annual usages differ by percent or more and canno be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the Compa will compare the customer's monthly usage records for t. 12-month period with the monthly usage for the same months of t preceding year.
- 4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined fr analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, t Company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing determine whether there have been changes such as differe of household members or work staff, additional different appliances, changes in business volume, or known lea in the customer's service line.
- Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the Company wi test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
- The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, i findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with { KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).
