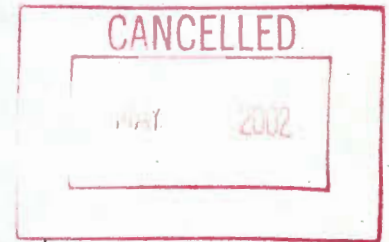

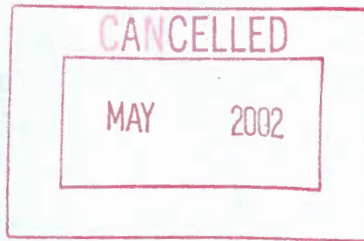

PLEASANT HILL WATER DISTRICT

Resolution of the Pleasant Hill Water District of Pulaski County, Kentucky, Establishing Rates and charges for the use of and the services rendered by the District Waterworks System, and providing for the collection of such rates and charges.

WHEREAS, the Commission of the Pleasant Hill Water District, of Pulaski County, Kentucky, has heretofore determined that the promotion and preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of said District and of all of its citizens and inhabitants require the construction and installation of a new District waterworks system, and

WHEREAS, the District is by concurrent proceedings providing for the issuance of its Waterworks Revenue Bonds for the purpose of defraying the costs (not otherwise provided) of constructing said system in the manner provided by KRS Chapters 74 and 106, and

WHEREAS, in and by said statutes it is required that rates or charges for services of the District waterworks system by prescribed and maintained so as to provide for the payment of interest upon and principal of said Bonds as the same become due, and also to pay operating and maintenance costs, as well as to create a depreciation fund, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary at this time that a schedule of rates for water service be prescribed and that provision be made for the collection thereof,

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE PLEASANT HILL WATER DISTRICT OF PULASKI COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. WATER CONNECTION CHARGES

Waterworks connection charges are hereby established and shall be exacted for each connection with the municipal waterworks system, with different charges being made for different size water connection, and with lower connection charges being made for those properties owned by persons applying for connections and paying the applicable charges prior to the date on which construction of the new waterworks system commences.

Section 2. BASIS MONTHLY WATER RATES

There shall be and there are hereby established from and after the effective date of this Resolution, basis monthly rates or charges for the water supplied by the waterworks system of the District as follows:

A. Minimum Water Rate

The minimum water bill shall be \$7.~~00~~<sup>24</sup> per month, and each water customer shall be entitled to 2,000 gallons (or less) of water in each month for such minimum charge.

B. Meter Rates for Water Usage in Addition to Minimum Charge

Subject to the minimum water rate specified above, the following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons or less of water consumption per month to customers of all sizes connections:

Section 3. METER DEPOSITS

In addition to connection charges as aforesaid, all customers shall pay a meter deposits of 2/12 of the customer's estimated annual bill to the District for water service before such customers shall be entitled to such service. Such deposit, *plus 6 percent per annum interest Ch.* less any unpaid charges, shall be refunded to such customer, his heirs or assigns, whenever such customer notifies the District legally to disconnect or terminate service to such customer.

Section 4. BILLING; COLLECTION ; PENALTIES

The rates or charges aforesaid shall be billed monthly, on statements which shall be issued on or about the first of each month, and all bills which shall be issued on or about the first or each month, and all bills for such service shall be considered due and payable ten days after the date of issue. If a bill is not paid within ten days after such date of issue, such bill shall be considered delinquent, and there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the charges (other than sales tax) shown on the face amount of such delinquent bill. The District *will* ~~may~~ serve a customer written notice of his delinquency. If such bill is not paid within ten days after the mailing of such notice, the District ~~may~~ disconnect the water service of such customer without further notice. **PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY EFFECTIVE JUL 30 1982** water service is disconnected by the District by reason of delinquency in the payment of any water bill, reconnection of such service shall not be made until the user pays all charges and

If any deadline date falls on a Sunday or legal holiday, such deadline shall not expire until the next secular day thereafter. *All discontinuance of service is subject to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.*  
Section 5. CODE OF BY-LAWS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE

The Commission has concurrently herewith adopted a detailed Code of By-Laws prescribing rules and regulation for the operation of the waterworks system of the District. Such Code is incorporated in the Rate Resolution by reference and is made a part hereof. Copies of said Code of By-Laws are on file at the office of the Secretary of the District, where same may be examined by any interested party.

Section 6. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, provision, paragraph or section of this Resolution be ruled void and unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder hereof is intended to be adopted and shall be in full force and effect notwithstanding.

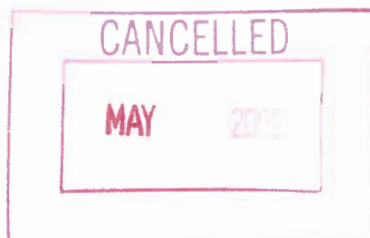

WATER LOSS ADJUSTMENT POLICY

IN THE EVENT OF WATER LOSS, WHICH THE SYSTEM DEEMS IS BEYOND THE REASONABLE CONTROL OF THE CONSUMER, THERE BILL MAY BE ADJUSTED AS FOLLOWS:

- A. WATER LOSS WILL BE ADJUSTED USING THE FOLLOWING FORMULA:
1. THE AVERAGE USAGE OF THE CONSUMER FOR THE PREVIOUS TWELVE MONTHS SHALL BE DETERMINED, AND THE EXCESS OF THE CURRENT PERIOD SHALL BE CHARGED AT THE CURRENT WHOLESALE RATE, WITH THE DIFFERENCE CREDITED TO THE CONSUMERS ACCOUNT.
  2. IF A TWELVE MONTH HISTORY IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR THE CONSUMER, THE AVERAGE USAGE WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE AVERAGE USAGE OF ALL CONSUMERS IN THE SAME CLASS AND THEN CALCULATED AS ABOVE.
- B. SUCH AN ADJUSTMENT WILL ONLY BE MADE ONE (1) TIME IN A GIVEN TWELVE MONTH PERIOD. IF MORE THAN ONE BREAK OCCURS WITHIN THE SAME PERIOD, ANY ADDITIONAL ADJUSTMENT MUST BE APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WATER SYSTEM.
- C. IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR A WATER LOSS ADJUSTMENT THE CONSUMER MUST MEET ONE OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
1. IF REPAIR WORK IS PERFORMED FOR HIRE, A COPY OF THE BILLING INVOICE MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE BILLING OFFICE.
  2. IF REPAIR WORK IS PERFORMED BY THE HOMEOWNER, A COPY OF RECEIPTS FOR PURCHASED PARTS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED AT OFFICE.
  3. VERIFICATION BY SYSTEM AUTHORIZED FIELD REPRESENTATIVE THAT HE HAS MET WITH CONSUMER AND CAN VERIFY A LINE LOSS.

## CONTRACT FOR WATER SERVICES

This contract witnesseth that for and in consideration of the effort of the above named water system, to secure financing for construction of this system and continued maintenance of system, the above applicant petitions to connect to the water system.

\* If a membership fee is charged, this application shall serve as a Certificate of Membership. If a deposit is charged, this application shall serve as a Certificate of Deposit.

The applicant hereby agrees to connect to the System. If it is a new connection, it is understood and agreed that at such a time as the connection is constructed, the applicant agrees to connect to the System immediately. If for any reason the connection is not made immediately, the applicant understands that a minimum charge will still be due and payable to the system for the connection. Failure to pay such charges and/or connect with the system will void this contract. Should the applicant desire to connect with the System in the future, all fees and connection charges will be due again IN FULL and any and all amounts previously billed.

The applicant agrees to install and maintain a service line that will meet with the Systems' suggested guidelines. The applicant also agrees that no other residence will be connected to their service line. A separate meter must be installed for each residence. The applicant also agrees not to resell or give away water purchased from this System.

A separate contract may be required for trailer parks/commercial.

The applicants rights hereunder are subject to such further rules and regulations as the System may prescribe. The System may terminate service to any customers who is in violation of any Rule or Regulation of the System.

The System may terminate service to any customer who is past due with their bill unless an agreement for partial payment is reached with the appropriate representative at the billing office. Deposits to insure payment of monthly water bills and penalties on delinquent water accounts shall be as the System may prescribe.

The applicant agrees to permit the System to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on customer's property, and to be designated by the System for each connection with right of ingress and egress for these purposes over customer's property, and to grant an easement for installation of water lines when required.

Non-payment by the due may subject the account to be assessed a penalty. Non-payment by the disconnect date will result in the service being shut off. If service is discontinued because of non-payment, the entire amount due for the account plus all pertinent Service Charges, minimum bills, penalties, etc., must be paid before service will be restored.
